MILWAUKEE'S BEST: The Twins are 234-225 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of $68-56$ in Interleague Play...Twins are $3-1$ vs. the Brewers this season.
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting . 364 (24-for-66) in 17 career games vs. MILL...has hit safely in 10 straight vs. the Brewers and 15 of 17 in career.
$\Phi$ Eddie Rosario has hit safely in 22 of 27 career games vs. Milwaukee...he has five home runs and 11 RBI in his last seven games vs. the Brewers.
RISP-Y BUSINESS: The Twins have been among baseball's best-hitting teams in the clutch this season, leading the majors with a . 993 OPS with RISP...Minnesota also ranks second in the majors (1st in the AL) with a .321 batting average ( 45 -for-150), first with a .443 on-base percentage and fourth (2nd AL) with a .550 slugging percentage with RISP.
$\Phi$ Nelson Cruz leads the AL in average (.550) and OPS (1.690) with RISP, going 11 -for-20 with one double, three home runs and 17 RBI.
$\Phi$ Max Kepler is hitting . 462 ( 6 -for-13) with two doubles, one homer, nine RBl and a 1.402 OPS with RISP, while Eddie Rosario is 7 -for- 17
(.412) with three doubles, one homer, 12 RBI and a 1.330 OPS.
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco, who drove in the 12th-inning winner last night, is 6 -for-19 (.316) with nine RBI.
PITCHING TO (SOFT) CONTACT: A season after compiling a franchise-record 1,463 strikeouts, Twins pitchers are fanning 8.94 batters per 9.0 innings in 2020 ( 6 th-best in the American League)...Minnesota has also been among the game's best staffs at inducing soft contact leadin the majors with an average exit velocity of just 87.1 MPH , while topping the AL (3rd in MLB) with just $32.9 \%$ of batted balls being "hard hit" nark in the AL and second-best in the majors...not surprisingly, the Twins lead the AL and rank third in all of baseball with a .256 opponent batting average on balls in play.

MORE PITCHING INFO: The Twins 3.22 ERA through 24 games is seventh best in Twins history in that span, and the lowest since the 1972 Twins had a 1.93 ERA through the first 24 games (team record)...Twins also have the fourth lowest team WHIP in Twins history through 24 games (1.10), trailing only 1972 (0.99), 1968 (1.01) and 1965 (1.09).

- Enters his 16th major league season and 19th in professional baseball...the Twins are his 11th different organization, at both the major and minor league levels: Chicago-NL (2002-08), Baltimore (2009), Boston (2010-12, '15), St. Louis (2010), Cleveland (2013), Los Angeles-AL (2014), New York-AL (2016) and Los Angeles-NL (2016-19).
- Since 2016 (min. 400.0 IP ), ranks third in baseball in opponent batting average (.208), seventh in ERA (2.97), seventh in WHIP (1.08) and 12th in strikeouts-per-9.0 IP (10.56). - He's fifth among active pitchers (min. 3250 opponent AB) with a 280 opponent batting average on balls in play (BABIP).
- Surpassed 900.0 career innings pitched in the first inning on May 22 at Tampa Bay....also
struck out his 100th career batter on September 24 at San Diego
- Made his major league debut on June 15,2005 with Chicago-NL against the Florida - Marlins, allowing two runs on three hits and striking out two batters in 1.0 inning of relief. - Selected by Chicago-NL in the fourth round (12th overall) of the 202 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Michigan, where he pitched for three seasons from
2000-2002

LAST TIME OUT: Hill dominated in his last start on July 29 vs. St. Louis, yielding just three base runners ( $2 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{BB}$ ) in 5.0 efficient innings of work...struck out two batters in a Twins 3-0 shutout victory, as Minnesota completed a two-game sweep of the Cardinals... Hill became the first 40-yearold lefty starter to win for the Twins since Terry Mulholland on September 12, 2004, at age 41.187, and just the third lefty age 40 or older to record a victory for the Twins (also, Hall of Famer Steve Carlton)...also became the first 40-year-0ld starter in Twins/Senators history to throw at lea innings and allow two-or-fewer hits since Connie Marrero for the Senators, at age 40.001
on Aprill was placed on the 10 -day Injured
Hill was placed on the 10-day Injured List on August 1 (retro to July 31) with left shoulder fatigue...entered 2020 recovering from left elbow surgery last October and was originally expected to be ready by mid-year, but the season's pause due to the COVID-19 pandemic
enabled him to complete his recovery in time for the start of the regular season.
HOLD MY BREW: Tonight marks Hill's 10th career appearance and ninth start against Milwaukee, going 3-1 with a 3.35 ERA ( 51.0 IP, 19 ER), 18 walks, 56 strikeouts and a . 211 opponent batting average (39-for-185) in his previous outings...last faced the Brewers on August 1 , 2018, earning the win in a quality start ( $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 6 \mathrm{H}, 2 \mathrm{R} / 1 \mathrm{ER}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 4 \mathrm{~K}$ )...six of Rich's eight starts contrary the Brewers have been quality, as well...there was a nearly 10 -year gap between his sixth and seventh appearances against Milwaukee, facing them on August 28, 2007 and then not again until June 3, 2017.

CROSSING LEAGUE LINES: 2020 marks Hill's first stint in the American League since 2016, when he was the Oakland Athletics' Opening Day starter before he was traded to Los Ange-les-NL...began his career in the Senior Circuit, but has made more career appearances in the Junior Circuit, appearing 152 times in an AL uniform compared to 133 times in an NL one.
$\Phi$ Rich is $4-4$ lifetime with a $5.11 \mathrm{ERA}(88.0 \mathrm{IP}, 50 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in 28 games ( 16 GS ) in Interleague play...
he's fared best as the home pitcher in IL scenarios, going 1-1 with a 3.58 ERA ( 32.2 IP, 13 ER).
FIVE-YEAR STRONG: Since 2015, Hill ranks among the major league pitching leaders in a number of different categories (min. 400.0 IP ), including:


OVER THE HILL: Hill is in his 16th major league season and his 19th overall in professional baseball...he and Nelson Cruz became the first 40-year-olds to both make the Opening Day roster in Twins history, and are just the fourth pair of 40-year-olds to play for the Twins at the same time, joining Pat Borders and Terry Mulholland in 2004, and Clark Griffith and Jack Ryan from 1912-13
$\Phi$ Entering this year, the last MLB team to have multiple 40 -year-olds play for it in a single season was the 2017 Atlanta Braves, which featured Bartolo Colon (age 44) and R.A. Dickey (age 42)...the last AL team was the 2016 Boston Red Sox, with David Ortiz (age 40) and Koji Uehara (age 41).

NL CENTRAL FOCUS: Hill began his career in the NL Central division with the Chicago Cubs, and will be making his 51st career appearance and 44th start against the division tonight... is 19-7 lifetime with a 3.33 ERA ( 254.0 IP, 94 ER), 101 walks and 256 strikeouts...his 19 wins over the NL Central are his most against any division in his career, and his 43 starts are his second most, behind 50 starts vs. the NL West.

RICH'S PITCHES: The wiley veteran Hill threw seven different offerings to hitters last season, according to Baseball Savant...his four seamer and curve were his typical weapons of choice, throwing them 51.9 percent of the time and 41.4 percent, respectively...Hill also threw in 17 eephus pitches, 16 to righty batters and just one to a lefty...Hill's repertoire over the years has evolved with his pitching style and age, though Baseball Savant's pitch tracking ability only on his sinker more often, throwing it as much as 42.2 percent of the time in $2012 \ldots$ however, he threw the pitch just seven times in 2019.
