THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-1 through five games on their eight-game homestand, going 2-0 vs. St. Louis and 2-1 vs. Cleveland...today they will play the series finale with Cleveland...tomorrow night they will begin a "two-and-two" by hosting Derek Shelton and the Pittsburgh Pirates at Target Field Monday night and Tuesday afternoon.

☞ The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the third of three vs. Houston in the middle of an eight-game homestand.

THREE BOMBA NIGHT: Twins beat the Indians last night by a score of 3-0, hitting three solo home runs off Cleveland starter Carlos Carrasco...the three home runs were hit by Miguel Sanó (twice) and Eddie Rosario in the third, fourth and fifth innings...Kenta Maeda (2-0) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one hit and six strikeouts...the bullpen of Trevor May, Cody Stashak and Taylor Rogers combined for 3.0 innings pitched as Rogers earned his third save.

☞ **THE LOVE 'SHAK:** Stashak entered the game last night in the eighth inning and struck out Sandy León to give him 30 for his career...he then eventually walked César Hernández two batters later for the second walk he's ever issued...according to *Elias*, it marked the most K's for a pitcher before his second career walk since the mound was moved to its current distance in 1893.

DOUBLE YOUR BOMBAS: Miguel Sanó gave the Twins their second player with a multi-homer game in 2020...last season the Twins had a player with a multi-homer game on 33 different occasions, the most in baseball, ahead of New York-AL (28), Toronto (24) and Houston (24)...33 also marked a Major League Baseball record and was 16 more than the next best Twins team, the previous record being 17, done in 1986.

ROTATIONAL PULL: Twins starting pitchers have gone 5-2, 2.77 ERA (39.0 IP, 12 ER) with four home runs allowed, 12 walks, 32 strikeouts and a .191 opponent batting average...since José Berríos allowed five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings to the White Sox on Opening Day, they have combined to post a 1.80 ERA (35.0 IP, 7 ER) with a .163 opponent batting average...here is how they have fared their last full time through the rotation:

TWINS-TRIBE: Twins and Cleveland are playing each other today for the fourth of 10 times in 2020...after today three more games will be played at Progressive Field from August 24-26 followed by three more at Target Field from September 11-13.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .306 (100-for-327) with 16 doubles, four triples, 21 home runs, 45 RBI and a .912 OPS in 86 career games vs. the Tribe...the hits and home runs are both his personal most vs. any opponent...100 hits vs. the Indians are the most in baseball since 2015.

2020 VISION: Twins have homered in seven of eight games this season (shutout Thursday vs. Bieber)...they have hit 15 bombas this season, tied for most in baseball with Detroit, Chicago-NL and Los Angeles-NL

'PEN PALS: Twins bullpen has allowed a 3.41 ERA (29.0 IP, 11 ER) with 12 walks, 36 strikeouts, an opponent batting average of .234 and 11.2 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched...aside from their outing on Saturday, July 25 at Chicago-AL in which the 'pen allowed nine runs on 11 hits and five home runs in 4.0 innings pitched, they have allowed two runs on 14 hits in 25.0 innings with 28 strikeouts.

SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES': Twins are looking for their third straight series victory today after taking two of three in Chicago last weekend, then two of two over the Cardinals earlier this week...the last time the Twins won their first three series of a season came in 2010, taking three of four at Los Angeles-AL, two of three at Chicago-AL and two of three vs. Boston...that season, the Twins went on to finish with a record of 94-68 and the fourth best record in baseball...last season the Twins went 31-15-6 in series play...they went 3-3 in series play vs. Cleveland last season.

ST. PAUL PLAYER POOL PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Typically every Sunday during the regular season the Twins name a minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...with no minor league season in 2020, the Twins will name a St. Paul Player Pool Player and Pitcher of the Week each Sunday...this week Royce Lewis and Jorge Alcala are the player and pitcher...Lewis practiced all week at CHS Field and went 29-for-42 (.690) in batting practice with ghost fielders...he also took "tons" of ground balls...Jorge Alcala won this week's award after throwing "wonderful" bullpens and even earned his way onto the 30-man roster yesterday from the Taxi Squad.

- ☞ Pen went 5-6, 3.55 ERA (76.0 IP, 30 ER) w/ 23 walks, 12 holds, 6 saves & 82 strikeouts in 19 G vs. CLE last season...went 2-3, 4.10 ERA (41.2 IP, 19 ER) w/ 17 walks, 3 holds, 3 saves & 44 strikeouts in 10 G at home in 2019.
- ☞ Pen went 34-22, 4.17 ERA (573.2 IP, 266 ER), with 50 saves, 185 walks and 619 strikeouts in 2019...the 50 saves were tied for second most in baseball...the 619 strikeouts were the most in club history...their 3.24 strikeouts-per-walk ratio also set a club record...69.4 save percentage was seventh best in MLB and sixth in AL in 2019.

- ☞ Due to start today's series finale as the Opener, his first start in a Twins uniform...served as Cleveland's Opener thrice in 2019, posting 8.44 ERA (5.1 IP, 5 ER) but holding opponents to a .200 (4-for-20) batting average...also appeared as Opener once for Toronto in 2018, allowing 2 ER in 1.0 IP on Aug. 2 at SEA.
- ☞ Originally began MLB career as SP with NYY and WAS, going 4-2, 5.79 ERA (37.1 IP, 24 ER) in 1st 8 career MLB G in 2007-08...however, just 12 of 743 (0.02%) of his career MLB G have come as SP...from professional debut in 2003 to MLB debut year of 2007, 104 of 113 minor league appearances (92%) came as a starter.
- ☞ Played for CLE in 2019 (53 games, 1-0, 2.90 ERA (62.0 IP, 20 ER) w/ 15 walks & 64 strikeouts)...career 1-0, 0.87 ERA (10.1 IP, 1 ER), 3 holds, 5 BB, 16 K in 12 G vs CLE.
