THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 4-2 through six games on their seven-game homestand, taking three of four from Kansas City and splitting the first two with the Brewers the last two nights... tonight they will wrap the homestand and series with the third of three with Milwaukee...after tonight's game, they will travel to Kansas City to begin a 10-game road trip...they will play the Royals for three over the weekend, then three in Cleveland from Monday-Wednesday, then Detroit for four from August 27-30.

☞ The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins on an off-day in the middle of a 10-game homestand...Twins are currently 42% through their 2020 schedule.

BREWERS EVEN SERIES IN MINNEAPOLIS: The Twins lost to the Brewers last night by a score of 9-3, their second biggest margin of loss this season (10-3 at CWS on July 25)...Rich Hill (1-1) returned from the 10-day Injured List and made his second start of the season, allowing four runs on four hits in 2.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits, two apiece from Miguel Sanó, Ildemaro Vargas and Marwin Gonzalez, who hit his third home run of the season.

NOTE: Twins pitching staff has the best home ERA in baseball (2.38) and the second-best home opponent batting average (.192), behind San Diego (.182).

ADDITIONALLY: Since the start of last season, the Twins are 57-38 at Target Field, the seventh most home wins in baseball in that span.

GETTIN' MIGGY WITH IT: Miguel Sanó is hitting .455 (5-for-11) with four doubles, three runs scored and a 1.273 OPS in his last three games...additionally, he is hitting .348 (8-for-23) with four doubles, one home run, two RBI, six walks, a .483 on-base percentage and a 1.135 OPS in his last eight games after beginning the season hitting .111 (5-for-45) with 23 strikeouts and a .149 OBP in his first 13.

FLURRY OF ROSTER MOVES: The Twins announced today that they have selected the contract of catcher Ryan Jeffers, while recalling outfielder LaMonte Wade Jr. and right-handed pitcher Zack Littell from the club's Alternate Training Site...in corresponding moves, the Twins have placed outfielder Byron Buxton (left shoulder inflammation) and catcher Mitch Garver (low-grade right intercostal strain) on the 10-day Injured List, and have optioned left-handed pitcher Lewis Thorpe... Jeffers, ranked as the Twins' No. 6 prospect by MLB.com entering the 2020 season, will be looking to make his major league debut...originally selected by Minnesota in the second round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft (59th pick overall), the 23-year-old hit .296 (180-for-609) with 33 doubles, 21 home runs, 82 RBI and an .836 OPS in 167 games over his first two minor league seasons... Littell, who was optioned yesterday when Rich Hill was activated from the Injured List, has four relief appearances with the Twins this season...Buxton has appeared in 21 games for the Twins, hitting .221 (15-for-68) with one double, five home runs and 12 RBI. Garver, who exited last night's game vs. Milwaukee, is hitting .154 (8-for-52) with one home run and two RBI in 17 games... Thorpe pitched 4.0 relief innings last night against the Brewers, allowing four runs on six hits (two homers). He is 0-1 with a 6.14 ERA (14.2 IP, 10 ER) in six games (one start) overall in 2020.

WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: The Twins are 8-3 this season in Interleague Play, going 2-0 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Pittsburgh and 3-2 vs. Milwaukee... Twins have a .727 IL winning percentage, best in the AL and fifth best in baseball...additionally, the eight wins lead baseball.

☞ Remaining IL schedule (9 games): one vs. Milwaukee tonight...two at St. Louis September 8 (DH)...three at Wrigley Field September 18-20...three at home vs. Cincinnati September 25-27.

MILWAUKEE'S BEST: The Twins are 234-226 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and have a record against them of 68-57 in Interleague Play...Twins are 3-2 vs. the Brewers this season.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .338 (24-for-71) in 18 career games vs. MIL...has hit safely in 15 of 18 in career vs. the Brewers.

☞ Eddie Rosario has hit safely in 23 of 28 career games vs. Milwaukee...he has five home runs and 12 RBI in his last eight games vs. the Brewers.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: A win tonight would make the Twins 7-1-1 in series play this season and would give them their third consecutive series win after taking two of three in Milwaukee and three of four vs. Kansas City...last season the Twins went 31-15-6 in series play...last time they won both of their series' vs. Milwaukee in one season was in 2017 when they swept two sets of two games.

FAST STARTS: The Twins have scored in the first inning in nine of their 24 games this season, and in the second inning nine times as well...they have a run differential of +15 (22-7) in the first inning and +10 (21-11) in the second inning.

☞ 22 first-inning runs this season are the most in baseball, ahead of New York-AL's second-place total of 19...in the first frame, the Twins are first in MLB in RBI (22), tied for second in hits (26), third in batting average (.268), fourth in slugging percentage (.505) and tied for fourth in total bases (49).

☞ Twins are also league-best with 21 second-inning runs, ahead of second-place Houston (20)...in the second inning, Minnesota is first in hits (31), third in batting average (.298) and fifth in total bases (48) and on-base percentage (.368)...combined with their first-inning run production, the Twins have scored 43 runs in the first two innings, which accounts for 36.1 percent of their total runs (119).

PREVENT DEFENSE: Even after surrendering nine runs last night, Twins pitchers have allowed just 86 this season - good for second-best in the American League and tied for fourth-fewest in baseball...Minnesota's +33 run differential is tied with the New York Yankees for best in the AL and second-best in the majors (behind LAD's 61)...the Twins rank third in the AL (4th in MLB) with a 3.46 team ERA (218.1 IP, 84 ER).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1997, the Twins traded outfielder Roberto Kelly to Seattle for a player to be named later...the deal was finished on October 9, sending Joe Mays to the Twins...Mays eventually became an All-Star in 2001, going 17-13 with a 3.16 ERA in 34 starts.

LAST TIME OUT: In his previous start, Berríos pitched the second game of a doubleheader at Target Field against Kansas City...he worked through 4.0 innings, allowing four earned runs on five hits and was charged with the loss in a Twins defeat, 2-4...punched out a season-high seven batters, the second most by a Twins starting pitcher this season...also walked a season-high four batters...entering 2020, had pitched at least 6.0 innings in nine consecutive starts against the Royals, including eight quality starts, but has yet to do either this season.

BERRÍOS VS. MILWAUKEE: Berríos has faced Milwaukee just once in his professional career, contributing a quality start with 7.0 IP and three earned runs on July 4, 2018 at Miller Park...ultimately tabbed with the loss, though, as the Twins' offense scored two runs in a 2-3 setback...all three of the Brewers' runs came on solo shots (Travis Shaw, Brad Miller, Nate Orf), tying the most Berríos has let up in a single start...Eduardo Escobar also had a solo homer for the Twins...Berríos has made at least one start against each NL Central team (6 total starts), going 2-3 with a 5.17 ERA (31.1 IP, 18 ER), 15 walks and 25 strikeouts against the division.

MAKING A TARGET RUN AT HISTORY: In 51 career games at Target Field, Berríos is 26-16 with a 3.71 ERA (303.1 IP, 125 ER), compared to his 18-21 record and 4.92 ERA (310.2 IP, 170 ER) in games on the road...his 26 career Target Field wins are second only to Kyle Gibson since the ballpark's inception in 2010...below is a chart of all-time wins at Target Field:

A TALE OF TWO HANDEDNESSES: This season, Berríos has seen a stark difference in his effectiveness with regard to left-handed and right-handed batters...lefties are hitting .156 (7-for-45), with a .291 OBP and .669 OPS...righties are hitting .400 (20-for-50), with a .446 OBP and 1.026 OPS.

CAREER NOTES

- Selected to the 2019 MLB All-Star Game, pitching a scoreless third inning.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL, yielding one earned run across 4.0 innings pitched, with six strikeouts and three walks.
- Teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 Ks on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
- Named to 2018 AL All-Star team, threw 1.0 scoreless inning in the All-Star Game.
- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
