THE TWINS: The Twins completed their seven-game homestand with a record of 5-2, going 3-1 vs. Kansas City and 2-1 vs. Milwaukee...tonight they will begin a 10 -game road trip with three games over the weekend in Kansas City, three in Cleveland from Monday-Wednesday, then Detroit for four from August 27-30...Twins are 12-3 at home and 5-6 on the road this season.
$\Phi$ The Twins are currently $43.3 \%$ through their 2020 schedule, playing 26 of their 60 games.
SEVENTH HEAVEN: The Twins beat the Brewers last night at Target Field by a score of 7-1, winning their seventh series of the season (7-1-1)...José Berríos (2-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits - tied for second most this season...they also went 5 -for- 11 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base...six of the Twins runs were scored in the sixth, seventh and eighth innings... five different Twins had multiple hits - the most in 2020 .
$\Phi$ Ryan Jeffers made his major league debut, starting behind the plate, going 2 -for- 3 , with an RBI-single in his first major league at-bat.
TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins are playing their final series with three vs. the Royals this season with three games this weekend...they are $3-4$ against $K C$ this season, getting swept in three August $7-9$ at Kansas City and winning three of four games last weekend at Target Field...the Twins need to sweep these three games to win the season series over the Royals.

- The Twins hit. 208 (21-for-101) with 3.3 runs-per-game and 27 strikeouts in their three game series at Kauffman Stadium earlier this month...during their four-game series at Target field last homestand, they hit .231 (25-for-108) with 3.5 runs-per-game five home runs and 12 walks. $\Phi$ Ionight's starter Jake Odorizzi made his major league debut with the Royals in 2012 wearing. IP. 4 ER) with four walks and four strikeouts....his major league debut came on September 23, 2012 at Kauffman Stadium, allowing three runs on six hits in 5.1 innings pitched as the Royals lost $15-4$ to Cleveland... Odo was traded to the Tampa Bay Rays on December 9, 2012 , along with INF Patrick Leonard, LHP Mike Montgomery and OF/1B Wil Myers for a player to be alomed later (INF Elliot Johnson), RHP Wade Davis and RHP James Shields.
$\Phi$ Odorizzi was named Pitcher of the Year for Triple-A Omaha in 2012 and started for Team USA in the Futures Game when Kauffman Stadium hosted the All-Star Game that season.
$\Phi$ Miguel Sanó made his major league debut at Kauffman Stadium July 2,2015, going 1-for-4 with two strikeouts, recording his first major league hit with an infield single off Greg Holland in the ninth inning of a Twins $2-0$ victory.
$\Phi$ Luis Arraez is hitting. 365 ( 19 -for-52) with six walks and a .4310 BP in 14 career games vs, the Royals, hitting safely in 11 of 14 .

ROYALS, REDUX: The Twins are 1-1 in Odorizzi's first two efforts vs. KC, as he has worked himself back into form after missing Minnesota's first 14 games of the season due to injury
$\Phi$ Jake started the first game of last Saturday's doubleheader at Target Field, a 4-2 Twins win... was perfect through 3.2 innings, with six strikeouts, before Salvador Perez' single...started the fifth with a one-hit shutout, yielded a leadoff double to Ryan McBroom and a two-run homer to the next batter (Maikel Franco), and departed the 7-inning game with a 3-2 lead
$\Phi$ Odo made his delayed season debut August 8 here at Kauffman Stadium and allowed two runs on four hits in 3.0 innings (KC won, 9-6)...surrendered a solo HR to Jorge Soler in the third.

MORE ROYALLY IMPORTANT INFO: Odorizzi made his major league debut for Kansas City on September 23, 2012 and his first two career starts occurred in a Royals uniform...Jake was named Pitcher of the Year for Triple-A Omaha in 2012 and started for Team USA in the Futures Game when Kauffman Stadium hosted the All-Star Game that season....was traded to the Tampa Bay Rays on December 9, 2012 as part of a seven-player deal...he's 3-5 lif
