Littell made six appearances for the Twins, allowing seven runs and 12 hits on 0. innings pitched...the wins have recalled right-handed pitcher Sean in two games for the Twins this season, allowing one run on four hits in 3.0 innings....additionally, to make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Homer Bailey 0 the 45-day Injured List...Bailey made one start for the Twins in late July, allowing two runs on our hits in 5.0 innings pitched against the St. Louis Cardinals.
