THE TWINS: Opened their season-long 10-game roadtrip by taking two of three games in Kansas City over the weekend, winning the final two contests...have now won three of four, seven of their
last 10 and are $9-4$ since a season-high four-game losing streak from August $6-9$,..the Twins will play a three-game series against Cleveland here at Progressive Field tonight-Wednesday, then go play a thire-g-game series against C-ieveland here at Progressive Field tonight-Wednesday, then go $\Phi$ Tonight marks the haltway point of the Twins' 2020 schedule, as they play their 30 th of 60 games. $\Phi$ Twins enter tonight's contest a season-high nine games above $.500(19-10)$, while they are tied with Tampa Bay for the second-most wins and second-highest winning percentage (.655) in the American League (0akland is tops at 20-9, .690).
TWINS ESCAPE KC WITH A "W": The Twins improved to $4-0$ in rubber games and $8-1-1$ in series this season after outlasting the Royals, $5-4$, yesterday at Kauffman Stadium to win the three-game weekend series..the Twins started the game 3 -for- 5 with RISP to build a $4-0$ lead in the third, then overcame a spate of stranded runners ( 0 -for-12 with RISP after that), as Nelson Cruz' solo homer in the ninth proved the difference...Minnesota pounded out 13 hits, including two apiece from Cruz and
Marwin Gonzalez (two-run double) and three-hit efforts from Misuel Sano (two doubles) and Eddie Marwin Gonzalez (two-run double) and three-hit efforts from Miguel Sano (two doubles) and Eddie
Rosario Matt Wisler worked 20 scoreless innings (1 H 1 BB , 2 S ) as the 0 pener in a bullpen game while Tyyler Clippard was credited with both a win (his first with the Twins) and a hold after pitching a perfect eighth inning (2 SO) )...Taylor Rogers earned the save despite allowing a run in the ninth. $\Phi$ Clippard, who took a line drive off the right elbow during his outing, has a win to go along with the bruise...he now has picked up a victory in nine different ML uniforms, with his 54 career wins spread between Washington (34), New York-AL (6), New York-NL (4), Toronto (4), Arizona (2), Chicago-AL (1), Cleveland (1), Oakland (1) and the Twins (1).
CRUZIN' DOWN CENTRAL: In his 78 games against the AL Central since joining the Twins in 2019 , Nelson Cruz is hitting .364 ( 106 -for-291) with 34 home runs, 92 RBI, a 444 on-base percentage, a .777 slugging percentage and a 1220 OPS...he leads all players vs, the division in homers, RBI,
OBP slugging and OPS (min 200 200 ) Tim Anderson of the White Sox (.382) in batting average...additionally, Cruz is 32 -for-66 (.485) with a 1.448 OPS with RISP over that span.
$\Phi$ In 16 intradivisional games this season, Cruz is 22 -for- 54 (407) with nine home runs 18 RBI, a . 484 on-base percentage, a a 963 s slugging mark and a 1.447 OPS....with RISP, he's hitting .545 ( 6 -for-11) with a 2.097 OPS.
NELLYVILLE: Nelson Cruz has 10 home runs on the season (tied for 2nd in the AL) and has now hit 51 since joining the Twins in 2019, tied for the sixth-most in baseball in that span....he now has 411 Career homers, good for 55th place on baseball's all-time list (one shy of Alfonso Soriano of r 54th):

A SANÓ STORM OF EXTRA-BASE HITS: Miguel Sanó has a career-best streak of seven-consecutive games with at least one extra-base hit, tied with six others for the longest in baseball this season and best by a Twins player since 2018 (Eddie Rosario between May 1-7 and Eduardo Escobar Hall of Famers - Harmon Killebrew (April 30-May 8, 1970) and Tony Oliva (June 22-28, 1969) for the second-longest streak in Minnesota history (Brian Dozier owns the record at 11-consecutive games, between June 18-30, 2016).
$\Phi$ During the streak, Sanó is hitting . 462 (12-for-26) with eight doubles, one home run, five RBI, a .553 on-base percentage (four walks), an . 885 slugging percentage and a 1.418 OPS...he has an incredible . 733 batting average on balls in play during that span.
$\boldsymbol{A}$ After missing most of summer camp, Sanó started the season 5 -for-45 (.111) with two
doubles, three home runs, 23 strikeouts (with only 2 walks), a . 149 on-base percenta doubles, three home runs, 23 strikeouts (with only 2 walks), a 149 on-base percentage, a
.356 slugging percentage and a 504 OPS. in 12 games since he is $15-$ for- 38 ( 395 ) with eight doubles, two home runs, 10 walks (against 18 strikeouts), a .521 OBP, a .763 slugging elght
mark, a 1.284 OPS and a .722 BABIP.
क Per Baseball Savant, Sanó now leads all of baseball with an average exit velocity of 97.8 MPH... 15 of his 20 hits this season have gone for extra bases ( 10 2B, 5 HR ).
TWINS-TRIBE: The Twins and Cleveland will play their second of three series in 2020 with this three-game set at Progressive Field...the Twins took three of four at Target Field from July 30-August 2, winning the last three games... after this set wraps up Wednesday evening, the teams will meet just once more - a three-game series september 11-13 in Minneapolis.
$\Phi$ The Twins went 5-4 at Progressive Field in 2019, winning both series in Cleveland after the All-Star Break...Twins won two-of-three games July 12-14, then swept a Saturday, September 14 doubleheader to win a three-game weekend set.
$\Phi$ Pitching dominated the clubs' first meeting of 2020, with Twins hurlers allowing just four earned runs in 36.0 innings ( 1.00 ERA ) and olding Indians hitters to a 133 average (16-for-120) and a . 399 OPS (2 2B and 1 HR)...the Twins hit . 214 (25-for-117) with 10 runs scored, five doubles and six home runs in the four-game set at Target Field.
$\Phi$ Eddie Rosario is hitting. 30 (100-for-330 with 10 doubles, 21 home runs, 45 RBI and a .904 OPS in 87 career games vs. Cleveland. the hits, home runs and RBD (tied with Chicago-AL) are his personal most vs. any opponent, while his 100 hits vs. the Indians are the most basebal since 2015 ...he is a lifetime . 365 hitter ( 58 -for-159) in 42 games here at Progressive Field, with 11 doubles, 11 homers,

玉 Max Kepler has 15 career home runs vs. the Tribe, his most against any opponent... 11 of those roundtrippers have come at Progressive Field, including a pair of three-homer games (August 1, 2016 and June 6, 2019).
STRENGTH VS. STRENGTH: This Twins-Tribe series also pits the American League's top pitching staffs in 2020...the Twins' 3.48 team ERA, 224 opponent batting average, 674 opponent OPS and 1.15 WHIP are all second in the AL, only to Cleveland's 2.88, 212, 639 and 1.03 marks respectively...however, the Twins have the edge in the Baseball Savant advanced metrics of average exit velocity (AL-best 87.1 MPH, compared to CLE's 88.6 ) and hard-hit percentage (AL-leading $33.7 \%$, while the Indians are $36.3 \%$ ), the Fangraphs measure of soft contact percentage

ON THE UPSWING: The Twins have recorded double-digit hits in four of their last five games, hitting . 295 (52-for-176) with 17 extra-base hits (11 2B, $13 \mathrm{~B}, 5 \mathrm{HR}$ ), a 372 on-base percentage, a 455 slugging mark and an . 826 OPS ...prior to this stretch, the Twins had just four double-digit hit games in their first 24 contests, in which they collectively hit . 234 (181-for-774) with a .315 OBP , a . 408 slugging mark and a .7230 OSS . (. 315 to . 325 ), their slugging mark by nine (. 408 to .417) and their OPS by 19 (from .723 to .742).

क However, the Twins have not picked up their scoring in the last five games ( 24 runs scored) as opposed to the first 24 games (116), averaging an identical 4.8 runs per game...ironically, as the Twins' overall hitting has improved, they've struggled with RISP...after hitting .314 (44-for-140)
with RISP over the first 24 contests, they are 13-for-53 (.245) in their last five - dropping their season mark 19 points (from .314 to .295).

A NIGHT TO REMEMBER：In his last start，on August 18 at Milwaukee，Maeda held the Brewers hitless through 8.0 innings．．．as the first batter in the ninth inning，Eric Sogard ended the bid with a single to right－centerfield．．．Maeda＇s efforts ultimately hit the ledger as a no－decision，though，when the Brewers plated three runs in the ninth and sent the game into extra innings at a 3－3 tie．．．the Twins walked off as winners in the 12th inning on a Jorge Polanco grounder that scored Byron Buxton from third．．．Buxton started the inning at second base on initial placement，per MLB＇s new extra－inning rules．．．despite the absence of an extra win on his record，Maeda stepped off the rubber that night with a litany of accomplishments：
$\Phi$ Set a Twins record with eight consecutive strikeouts，spanning from innings three to five．．．fell one strikeout short of the AL record（9，many，last：Tyler Alexander for DET， $8 / 2 / 20$ ）and two short of the MLB record（10，Tom Seaver for NYM，4／22／70）．
$\boldsymbol{\Phi}$ Became the third pitcher in Twins／Senators history to strike out 12－or－more hitters and allow one－or－fewer hits（Eric Milton，9／11／99 vs．ANA；Walter Johnson，5／23／24 vs．CWS）
$\Phi$ Marked the longest no－hit bid of his career，and the third time he＇s pitched at least 8.0 innings in a game．．．also became one of 13 pitchers in MLB this season to pitch at least 8.0 innings in a single matchup．

MAEDA VS．CLEVELAND：Maeda today faces Cleveland for the second time in his career after previously dueling the Indians on August 1．．．it was his first quality start of the season，and has since thrown four in a row．．．received the win after he worked 6.0 shutout innings，allowing just one hit and one walk with six strikeouts．．．the final score was 3－0－one of the Twins＇two shutouts on the season（also $7 / 29$ vs．STL）．．．the start completed his tour around the AL Central，as he has now faced each team （including the Twins）at least once．．．he＇s 5－1 all－time against the division with a 2.53 ERA（32．0 IP， 9 ER），seven walks and 31 strikeouts．．．his AL Central ERA is his best against any single division．

MAEDA AMONG THE BEST：Maeda ranks near the top of several MLB categories among qualified pitchers，including WHIP（2nd，0．63）and opponent batting average（2nd，．128）．．．furthermore，here is how Maeda stacks up against MLB pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched this season：
