QUOTABLE:

August 20 - Manager Rocco Baldelli, on Berríos' bounceback start vs. Milwaukee: "He was absolutely at the top of his game in pretty much every way. When he's really crisp with his fastball, the fastball and fastball life [are] excellent. His ability to command both sides of the plate were, from where I'm standing, excellent. He was able to really implement some of those breaking balls with a little more downward action; he commanded it really well. The changeup was good. We can dissect it all the way around. It was a tremendous night for him. We've seen this guy many times over. That's the guy we remember, and it doesn't get any better than what we saw."

August 20 - José Berríos on what was working for him against the Brewers: "Honestly, I throw my fastball up so I command it pretty well. My changeup - I threw a few good ones, but the curveball-slider, it was working really well, because, today during the day, I said, 'I'm going to bring all my energy, no matter what, on every pitch, even if I only throw three innings, I'm going to put my 100 percent into every pitch.' That's why I pitched the way I pitched - with that conviction on every pitch. It paid off tonight."

August 20 - Catcher Ryan Jeffers on Berríos' execution vs. Milwaukee: "His stuff was really crisp tonight. It's easy to call a game when the guy is throwing what you want, where you want it. All of his stuff was working, and you could tell by the at-bats the Brewers were taking. He was keeping them off balance and knew what his stuff was doing."
