LAST TIME OUT：In his previous start，on August 20，Berríos was the winner after he pitched 6.0 scoreless innings against Milwaukee at Target Field in a 7－1 victory．．．．he walked one batter，allowed just one hit and struck out nine Brewers en route to his second quality start of 2020．．．logged his highest strikeout total since he punched out nine batters at Kansas City on September 27， 2019 in his final regular season start．．．．additionally，he held Milwaukee hitless through 4.1 innings．．．first hit allowed was an Eric Sogard single in the fifth inning．．．marked the first time in his career he＇s pitched at least 6.0 innings and allowed one or fewer hits．

BERRÍOS AND CLEVELAND：Berríos has made 12 starts against Cleveland in his career，and owns a 5－3 record all－time with a 3.90 ERA（ 67.0 IP， 29 ER）， 22 walks and 64 strikeouts．．．six of those nods were quality starts，and the Twins are 5－1 in such contests．．．is 3－0 in his career at Progressive Field with a 3.77 ERA（ $28.2 \mathrm{IP}, 12 \mathrm{ER}$ ）， 11 walks and 26 strikeouts．．．also holding Cleveland hitters to a .179 （19－for－106）opponent batting average in games played in Ohio．．．Berríos made his MLB debut in Cleveland on August 1， 2016 and contributed the first of his aforementioned career quality starts， tossing 6.0 innings while allowing three runs with no walks and five strikeouts．．．went 5.0 innings in his only 2020 start vs．the Indians（7／30）and allowed two earned runs．．．both runs came on a two－run homer by Francisco Lindor in the third inning．

A TALE OF TWO HANDEDNESSES：In his last start，Berríos proved effective against both left－handed hitters and right－handed hitters，as he allowed just one hit．．．this season，though，Berríos has seen a stark difference in his efficiency with regard to the two orientations．．．lefties are hitting ． 148 （8－for－54）， with a ． 266 0BP and .599 OPS．．．righties are hitting .333 （20－for－60），with a .388 0BP and .871 OPS．

SAME MAKEUP，DIFFERENT RESULTS：Berríos has gotten off to a slower start in his first six starts of 2020 compared to his first half dozen in 2019．．．last season，he went 4－1 in his first six starts（ 5 QS），with a 2．97 ERA（39．1 IP， 13 ER），eight walks， 41 strikeouts，a 208 opponent batting average （30－for－144）and a ． 654 opponent OPS．．．conversely，in his first six starts this season，Berríos is 2－3 （2 QS）with a 4.75 ERA（30．1 IP， 16 ER）， 14 walks， 33 strikeouts，a 246 opponent batting average （28－for－114）and a ． 741 opponent OPS．．．although the numbers may tell a different story，Berríos＇ pitch statistics don＇t corroborate a large disparity in performance．．．per Baseball Savant，the following chart displays his pitch movement metrics compared between the two campaigns．
