THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-1 through six games on their eight-game homestand, going 2-0 vs. St. Louis and 3-1 vs. Cleveland...tonight they will begin a two-game series with Derek Shelton and the Pittsburgh Pirates...they will wrap the homestand tomorrow afternoon.

The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the first of three vs. Cleveland in

the middle of an eight-game homestand.

TWINS TAKE TRIBE: Twins beat the Indians yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-1, securing the four-game series win...Tyler Clippard was the Opening Pitcher, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings... Devin Smeltzer (1-1) was the primary pitcher and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 2.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Max Kepler and Jorge Polanco...Mitch Garver hit his first home run of the season, a solo shot in the second inning.

HOT START: The Twins are 7-2 through nine games, marking the eighth time in club history (since 1961) that they have won seven games in their first nine...below are the previous times.

NOTE: Twins have gone 8-2 in their first 10 just three times in their history (1961) and four times in Twins/Senators franchise history....Senators did it in 1930 and the Twins did it in 1961, 1970 and 2001.

G'DAY MATE!: Tonight Lewis Thorpe will become the first Australian-born pitcher to start an Interleague game since Liam Hendriks on June 20, 2014 for Toronto...will be the eighth Aussie-born overall to start an IL game, and third for the Twins (Hendriks twice in 2012, Brad Thomas once in 2001) Brad Thomas once in 2001).

INTERLEAGUE PLAY: The Twins are 2-0 this season in Interleague Play, sweeping the Cardinals

in two July 28-29...they went 8-12 in Interleague Play last season...they have had just one winning season against the NL since 2010, that coming in 2017 (13-7).

From 1997 (IL Play's inception) to 2009, the Twins went 132-96 in IL Play, second to only the Yankees (133-95) in wins during that span...since then they have gone 89-107, tied for 24th most IL wins in baseball in that span.

₱ Mitch Garver hit .333 (17-for-51) with a 1.260 OPS in 14 IL games last season...Garver's nine IL home runs last season tied him with Colorado's Nolan Arenado for most in baseball...the nine home runs tied him with Trevor Plouffe (2012) for most single-season

Basedall...the fillie floring that sted fillin with flevor Flouric (2012) for most single-season IL home runs in club history.

₱ Jorge Polanco is a career .301 hitter (55-for-183) with a .839 OPS in 53 career IL games.

₱ Josh Donaldson is hitting .310 (144-for-465) with 25 doubles, 29 home runs, 93 RBI and a .955 OPS in his last 123 Interleague games, dating back to 2012.

₱ The Twins have homered in a major league record 25 straight IL games, dating back to loly 4 2018 hitting 45 in that span

July 4, 2018, hitting 45 in that span.

WHAT'S UP, SHOOTER?: Pirates Manager Derek Shelton served as the Bench Coach for two seasons in Minnesota, spending 2018 under Paul Molitor and 2019 under Rocco Baldelli...Shelty managed two games for the Twins on July 28 and 29, 2018, losing both as Molitor traveled to Cooperstown for the Hall of Fame induction ceremony.

TWINS AND BUCS: The Twins and Pirates are playing each other for the first of four games...they play two here at Target Field then two at PNC Park on Wednesday night and Thursday afternoon...Twins are 19-13 all-time vs. the Pirates...the last time these two teams met was in 2018, with the Twins going 1-1 in Pittsburgh (April 2-4) and 2-0 at Target Field (August 14-15).

Twins hitting coach Edgar Varela is in his third season in the Twins organization and first in his current post after serving 2018-19 as the club's minor league field coordinator...Varela began his coaching career in 2008 as a GCL Pirates coach...over his time in the Bucs organization he was Single-A West Virginia hitting coach (2009-10, '12), Short-A State College hitting coach (2011), Single-A Bradenton hitting coach (2013), Rookie Bristol manager (2014-15), GCL Pirates manager (2016) and Latin American hitting coardinator (2017) hitting coordinator (2017)

BOMBA SQUAD, 2020: Twins have homered in eight of nine games this season (shutout Thursday vs. Bieber)...they have hit 16 bombas this season, third most in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (17) and New York-AL (17).

👁 Twins have had 10 different players homer this season, most in the AL...only the Dodgers have as many in baseball (also 10).

 In their last seven games, Twins pitchers are 6-1 with a 1.29 ERA (63.0 IP, 9 ER), 21 walks, 64 strikeouts, a .150 opponent batting average (32-for-214) and a .466 opponent OPS.
 Over the last five contests, Minnesota's staff has a 0.80 ERA (45.0 IP, 4 ER), 14 walks, 45 strikeouts, a .128 opponent batting average (19-for-149) and a .368 opponent OPS, along with four saves (in four opportunities), nine holds and two shutouts.

DO YOU KNOW THE DAZZLE MAN?: Twins radio stud Dan Gladden played 25 career games against the Pirates from 1984-86 while playing for the Giants...he hit .298 (31-for-104) with five doubles, two triples, two home runs, 15 RBI, 14 walks and a .829 OPS — even before registering an .800 OPS-or-higher was fashionable...he hit safely in each of his final seven games vs. Pittsburgh from April 30-July 27, 1986...Gladden's 31 career hits vs. the Bucs ties him with good ol' Gary Woods for 40th on baseball's all-time list among California-born right-handed hitting outfielders.
