TWINS BEAT UP ON BUCS AGAIN: The Twins beat the Pirates last night by a score of 5-2... Randy Dobnak (2-1) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with three hits allowed, no walks and one strikeout...Dobnak has not allowed a run in his last 12.0 innings, dating back to his start on July 25, 2019...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Marwin Gonzalez...Max Kepler hit his fourth home run of the season.
ODO, READY TO GO: Right-handed pitcher Jake Odorizzi is scheduled to make his 2020 debut on Saturday at Kansas City...the 2019 AL All-Star has missed the start of the 2020 season with a right intercostal strain...in 2019 , he went 15-7, 3.51 ERA (159.0 IP, 62 ER) with 16 home runs allowed, 53 walks and 178 strikeouts in 30 'starts.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!: The Twins have won six straight games...the last time they won six straight in one season was September 22-28, 2019...last time they won seven straight in one season was from June 11-21, 2011 when they won eight straight.
WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: The Twins are 5-0 this season in Interleague Play, sweeping the Cardinals in two July 28-29, sweeping the Pirates at Target Field from Monday-Tuesday, then a win last night in Pittsburgh...the Twins went 8-12 in Interleague Play last season... they have had just one winning season against the NL since 2010, that coming in 2017 (13-7).
$\Phi$ Remaining IL schedule (15 games): one more vs. Pittsburgh today ..three at Milwaukee August 10-12...home for three vs. Milwaukee August 18-20...two at St. Louis September 8-9...three at Wrigley Field September 18-20...three at home vs. Cincinnati September 25-27.
क From 1997 (IL Play's inception) to 2009, the Twins went 132-96 in IL Play, second to only the Yankees (133-95) in wins during that span...since then they have gone 92-107, tied for 18th most IL wins in baseball in that span.
$\Phi$ Nelson Cruz is hitting 284 (185-for-651) with 30 doubles, 49 home runs, 138 RBI and a 921 OPS in 181 career Interleague games...in his last nine IL games, he is hitting .350 ( $14-$-for-40) with three home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.009 OPS...among actives, he ranks fourth in homers, tied for third in RBI and eighth in OPS.

EARLY RISERS: The Twins have scored 16 runs in the first inning this season, the most of any team in MLB...backing it up, they've also scored 15 second-inning runs, which are also tops in the league....first- and second-inning runs (31) account for 49.2 percent of Minnesota's total offense ( 63 R, 5 th in MLB)...entering play today, the Twins are league-best in first-inning hits (18), batting average (.353), walks (9) and total bases (32)...Twins are 9-0 when scoring the first run of the game.

WHITEFIELD OPTIONED: Last night the Twins optioned outfielder Aaron Whitefield...Whitefield appeared in three games, going 0-for-1.

LAST TIME OUT：In his last start，on August 1 vs．Cleveland，Maeda gave the Twins their first quality start of the season，pitching 6.0 scoreless innngs，striking out six and allowing just one base hit．．．he held the Indians hitless through 4.1 innings，marking his longest no－hit bid since July 6，2019，also through 4.1 innings vs．San Diego and took the loss．．．the last time he pitched more than 4.1 hitless innings came on August 20，2017，when he no－hit Detroit through 5.0 innings．

HISTORIC，EARLY SUCCESS：With his last start vs．Cleveland，Maeda became just the fifth Japa－ nese－born pitcher to throw at least 5.0 innings，allow two－or－less earned runs and record at least six strikeouts in his first two starts of the season．He joined Hiroki Kuroda（Los Angeles－NL，2010），Hideki Irabu（New York－AL），Daisuke Matsuzaka（Boston，2008）and Yu Darvish（Texas，2014）

MAEDA VS．THE BUCS：Maeda has faced Pittsburgh three times in his career，and owns a 2－1 record with 18.1 innngs pitched，two walks and 13 strikeouts．．．most notably，on May 10，2017，he pitched into the ninth inning at Dodger Stadium and recorded one out（ 8.1 IP ）before turning the game over to relief．．．efficiency played a large role in his success，only needing 104 pitches（ 75 strikes， $72 \%$ ）to navigate into the final frame．．．allowed five hits，two earned runs and zero walks with five strikeouts in that May matchup．．．in his three starts against the Pirates，has allowed five home runs．

WELCOME TO THE CLUB：Maeda was acquired in a trade with Los Angeles－NL on February 10，along with minor league catcher Jair Camargo and cash，in exchange for right－handed pitcher Brusdar Graterol，minor league outfielder Luke Raley and a Competitive Balance B pick in the 2020 MLB First－ Year Player Draft．．．with the draft selection，the Dodgers chose right－handed pitcher Clayton Beeter out of Texas Tech University．．．．previously，the Twins and Dodgers exchanged pleasantries at the trade deadline in 2018 when the Twins sent infielder Brian Dozier to Los Angeles，and in return received Raley，infielder Logan Forsythe and left－handed pitcher Devin Smeltzer．
