**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 1-3 through four games on their current eight-game roadtrip, going 1-1 at Pittsburgh, followed by consecutive losses to the Royals...today they will play the three-game series finale at Kauffman Stadium...after today's game, the Twins will travel to Milwaukee for three against the Brewers from Monday-Wednesday.

☞ The original 2020 schedule would have the Twins in the fourth of four at Kansas City.

☞ Twins are looking to avoid losing four straight for the first time since August 6-9, 2019 (also 4).

**TWINS DROP THEIR THIRD STRAIGHT:** The Twins lost to the Royals last night by a score of 6-9... Jake Odorizzi made his season debut and did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 3.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded nine hits, led by Marwin Gonzalez, who raised his batting average to .350.

☞ Have lost three straight games—following a 10-2 start—for the first time since losing four straight from August 6-9, 2019 vs. Atlanta/Cleveland.

☞ Clinched their first series loss of the season (now 4-1-1) and their first to the Royals since dropping three of four from September 13-16, 2018...a loss today would mark their first time being swept in three games since September 3-5, 2018 at Houston (they're 41-34-7 in 82 series since their last 3-game sweep).

☞ Have homered in 12 of 15 games and have hit 25 homers total, passing the 1964 Twins (23) for the most homers through 15 games in club history.

☞ Last night marked the first time the Twins homered thrice, scored at least six runs against the Royals and lost since August 17, 2014, a 12-6 defeat at Target Field.

**FULL NELSON:** Nelson Cruz has four home runs on the season and has now hit 45 total since the start of 2019 - 29 coming against the AL Central...last night marked the 405th of his career, moving within two of tying Hall of Famer Duke Snider (407) for 56th on baseball's all-time list.

**FURTHERMORE ON NELLY:** With his 16th RBI last night, Cruz tied the record for a 40+-year-old through the first 15 games of a season, matching Hank Sauer (16 in 1957 for NYG) and Dave Winfield (16 in 1993 for MIN).

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins are playing the Royals for the third of 10 times in 2020... after today, they will host the Royals at Target Field for three August 14-16 then come back to KC for three August 21-23.

☞ Max Kepler is hitting .318 (27-for-85) with four home runs, 14 RBI, 17 walks and a .427 OBP in his last 24 games vs. the Royals.

☞ Nelson Cruz has 11 career home runs and 33 career RBI in 43 games at Kauffman Stadium...he has nine homers and 21 RBI in his last 12 vs. KC.

☞ Twins have homered 18 of their last 19 against the Royals, including each of their last seven, dating back to June 14, 2019, totaling 38 homers in that span.

☞ Twins have 178 wins at Kauffman Stadium, the most for any single opponent in the ballpark's history.

☞ Twins have now hit multiple homers in three consecutive games against the Royals for the third time in franchise history, with the current streak dating back to September 29, 2019...the other streaks were: September 5-7, 2016 (8 total HR) and May 25-August 13, 2016 (8 total HR).

☞ Byron Buxton has homered in three consecutive games for the first time in his career, all on the road (at PIT, at KC, at KC)...the last Twin to homer in consecutive games at Kauffman Stadium was C.J. Cron from June 21-22, 2019...the last Twin to homer in three consecutive (by date) road games was C.J. Cron from August 29-31, 2019 (at Chicago-AL, at Detroit, at Detroit).

**RISP, REWARD:** The Twins lead baseball with a .365 batting average (31-for-85) with runners in scoring position - next-closest team is the Cardinals (.321)...the Twins hit .291 (374-for-1284) with RISP last season, second best in baseball, trailing only New York-AL (.294, 374-for-1271).

**TENACIOUS D:** Twins are tied with St. Louis for fewest errors committed in baseball, having just two on the season...in fact, the Twins/Senators record for fewest errors in a normal, full season is 74 in 161 games in 2002...pro-rated for 60 games, that's equal to 27.6 errors...Twins are currently on pace to commit just eight errors this season (2 errors in 15 games), which would be equal to 21.4 errors in a 161-game timeframe, which would be a new record, in a pro-rated sense.

☞ The only errors committed have come from Miguel Sanó on July 30 vs. Cleveland and Ehire Adrianza on August 2 vs. Cleveland.

☞ Twins rank second in baseball in Ultimate Zone Rating at 3.0, trailing only Baltimore (3.9).

**MARWIN FOR THE WIN:** Marwin Gonzalez is starting at third base for the sixth time this season...on the season he is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with five walks, a .435 on-base percentage and a .935 OPS...since Josh Donaldson was hurt (calf), Gonzalez is hitting .393 (11-for-28).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1997, Brad Radke's 12-decision win streak ended in a 4-1 loss to New York-AL at the Metrodome; Radke's streak is tied with Scott Erickson (April 21-June 24, 1991) for the second-longest winning decision streak by a starter in Twins history...2014: Trevor May made his major league debut, starting and taking the loss in Oakland...happy birthday to former Twins pitcher Pat Mahomes, father of current Royals part-owner and Kansas City Chiefs quarterback Patrick Mahomes.

**ST. PAUL PLAYER POOL PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Typically every Sunday during the regular season the Twins name a minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...with no minor league season in 2020, the Twins will name a St. Paul Player Pool Player and Pitcher of the Week each Sunday...this week Trevor Larnach and Danny Coulombe are the player and pitcher...they both put in work all week at CHS Field in St. Paul, Larnach hitting dozens of BP balls into the Mississippi River...Coulombe threw electric bullpens all week, turning a lot of heads.

## TEAM BULLPEN NOTES

- Pen is 3-3, 3.98 ERA (61.0 IP, 27 ER) w/ 24 BB & 76 K's in first 15 games of the season...pen's 6 SV are tied with three other teams for second most in the majors...pen also ranks 9th in American League, 16th in MLB in relief ERA...76 K's are 3rd best in AL, also 3rd best in MLB...pen's .230 (53-for-230) opponent batting average is 6th in AL, 16th in MLB...pen suffered its first blown save of the season on Thursday in Pittsburgh.
- Pen has a 1.32 ERA (34.0 IP, 5 ER) in 8 home games this season (Twins are 7-1 at home)...however pen has 7.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 22 ER) in 7 road G this season (Twins are 3-4 on the road).
- Pen went 8-2 with a 3.07 ERA (67.1 IP, 23 ER), 21 walks, 71 strikeouts and a .230 opponent batting average (58-for-252) against Kansas City in 2019...this included a 2.32 ERA (31.0 IP, 8 ER) at Kauffman Stadium.
- Pen went 34-22, 4.17 ERA (573.2 IP, 266 ER), with 50 saves, 185 walks and 619 strikeouts in 2019...the 50 saves were tied for second most in baseball...the 619 strikeouts were the most in club history...their 3.24 strikeouts-per-walk ratio also set a club record...69.4 save percentage was seventh best in MLB and sixth in AL in 2019.
- Pen went 14-15, 4.43 ERA (296.2 IP, 146 ER) with 36 saves, 100 walks and 338 strikeouts at home vs. 20-7, 3.90 ERA (277.0 IP, 120 ER) with 26 saves, 85 walks and 281 strikeouts on the road in 2019.
