LAST TIME OUT: In his previous start, on August 4 vs. Pittsburgh, Berríos contributed his first quality start of the season, pitching 6.0 innings, allowing just one earned run on four hits, while walking three and striking out six. the game was the fifth win in the Twins' season-long streak of six, which has since been snapped by a stretch of three consecutive losses, also a season most...he was infamously interrupted by a drone in his last outing, which caused an nine-minute delay with two outs in the fifth inning...after the airspace intermission, Berríos pitched 1.1 scoreless innings further before giving way to the bullpen.

BERRÍOS VS. KANSAS CITY: Berríos has faced Kansas City 13 times - his second-most-commor adversary in MLB (Chicago-AL, 15)...in those appearances (all starts), he is 3-2 with a 4.29 ERA (77.2 IP, 37 ER)...when disregarding his three starts vs. the Royals in his rookie 2016 season, though, his ERA lowers to 3.52 (64.0 IP, 25 ER)...has pitched at least 6.0 innings in each of his last nine outings vs. KC, including at least 7.0 innings in five of them.

26-AND-UNDER CLUB: Berríos currently stands at 598 strikeouts in his career...once he strikes out his 600th batter, he will become the eighth Twin to cross the milestone before or during his age-26 season, and the 16th to reach the milestone with the club, regardless of age...here is the list of Twins pitchers who have nunched out at least 600 batters before or during their age-26 season
