THE TWINS: Completed their nine-game road trip with a record of 3-6, going 2-1 at Kansas City, 1-2 at Cleveland and $0-3$ at Detroit...tonight the Twins will begin an eight-game homestand with three against the White Sox tonight through Wednesday (all 7:10 starts), followed by an off day Thursday, then five against the Tigers Friday-Monday (doubleheader Friday).

$\Phi$ Twins are $8-12(.400)$ on the road this season (tied 20th for win percentage in baseball), compared to 12-3 (.800) at Target Field (best win percentage in baseball).
क Twins are looking to avoid losing six straight for the first time since June 29-July 4, 2018 (also
6)...their last win was a 3-2 victory in game one of the three-game series at Progressive Field 6)...their last
last Monday.

MOWED DOWN IN MOTOWN: The Twins lost to the Tigers yesterday afternoon by a score of 3-2 at Comerica Park, suffering their second sweep of the season and dropping 1.5 games back of the White Sox and Indians in the AL Central....Kenta Maeda (4-1) made his seventh start for the Twins and was the losing pitcher, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched...Maeda (8) and reliever Caleb Thielbar (4) combined for 12 strikeouts - third most for the Twins staff in a game this season...the
offense recorded just five hits, marking the eighth time this season with five hits-or-fewer (2-6)...Jorge offense recorded just five hits, marking the eighth time this season with five hits-or-fewer (2-6)....Jorge
Polanco highlighted the Twins offense with a solo shot in the third inning, his third homer of the season.
TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the fourth of 10 times in 2020... they opened the season at Guaranteed Rate Field July 24-26 as the Twins took the first and third games, outscoring the Sox 27-17 over the three games...the Twins are 7-2 in the last nine vs. the Sox, dating back to last August...additionally, the Twins have gone 39-21 vs. Chicago since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent since.
玉 Twins have hit 46 home runs vs. the Sox since the start of 2019, tied with Kansas City for their most against any opponent during that time.
\$ Miguel Sanó has seven home runs and 18 RBI in 19 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019. I Max Kepler has a 1.149 OPS vs. the Sox since the start of 2019, including 11 home runs and 26 RBI in 17 games.
$\Phi$ Individuals vs. Lucas Giolito: Nelson Cruz is 6-for-14 (.429) with three home runs and five RBI...
Max Kepler is 8 -for-19 (.421) with a triple, three home runs and five RBI...Marwin Gonzalez is 3 -for-10 (.300) with a double, a home run and four RBI.
CRUZ WEARING OUT SOX: Prior to joining the Twins in 2019, Nelson Cruz was hitting . 208 (51-for-245) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 29 RBI and a . 627 OPS in 66 career games vs. the White Sox...in 19 games since joining Minnesota, he is hitting 452 (33-for-73) with seven doubles, 11 home runs, $34 \mathrm{RBI}, 12$ walks, a .529 OBP, a 1.000 SLG and a 1.529 OPS...during the opening series at Chicago, he went 7-for-13 with two doubles, three home runs and 10 RBI.

PITCHERS HITTING THE TARGET: Twins are 12-3 at home, compared to 8-12 on the road...Twins pitchers have posted a 2.28 ERA (134.0 IP, 34 ER) with a . 190 opponent batting average and a .576 OPS in 15 home games...they have posted a 4.93 ERA (164.1IP, 90 ER) with a .273 opponent batting average and a . 801 OPS in 20 road games.
$\Phi$ Since the start of 2019, they have gone 58-38 at Target Field, tied for eighth most home wins in baseball.
ALL INCLUSIVE CRUZ: Nelson Cruz is hitting 319 (38-for-119) with four doubles, 13 home runs, 29 RBI, 14 walks, a . 409 on-base percentage and a 1.089 OPS in 34 games...he has nine home runs in his last 15 games and has not gone more than two games without homering in that span... among MLB leaders this season, he is tied with San Diego's Fernando Tatis Jr. for first in home runs, tied for fourth in RBI and third in OPS. a 1.043 OPS the Twins in 2019, he is hitting .312 (179-for-573) with 30 doubles, 54 home runs, $137 \mathrm{RBI}, 70$ walks, 106 runs scored and 41 walks, in 154 games...in that span, vs. the AL Central only, he is hitting .354 (110-for- 311 ) with 18 doubles, 37 home runs, 95 RBI , -
GETTING DEFENSIVE: Twins enter today with 10 defensive runs saved on the season, ranking seventh in baseball and third in the American League, trailing the White Sox (28) and Rays (15)...Twins defense has committed just nine errors on the season, the fewest in baseball, ahead of second-place Arizona (12)...White Sox are tied for eighth fewest (17).

LAST TIME OUT: Hill's last start came in Cleveland last Tuesday, August 25...tossed 5.0 strong innings against his former team, with four hits, two walks and a season-high five strikeouts.. allowed three singles and one run on an RBI knock by Carlos Santana in the first inning...however, settled in and yielded just three base runners in his final 4.0 innings of work, striking out the side in the bottom of the fifth...also allowed two stolen bases, both by José Ramírez in the first inning, his first start with two-0r-more steals allowed since May 9, 2019 vs. Washington.

AGAINST CHICAGO-AL: Hill last faced the White Sox on April 4, 2016, as a member of the Oakland Athletics...started and took the loss in Oakland after allowing four runs (2 ER) on three hits in just 2.2 innings of work with one walk and three strikeouts...overall, he's 0-2 with a 6.41 ERA ( 19.2 IP, 14 ER), 18 walks, 20 strikeouts and a .276 opponent batting average (21-for-76) in 17 appearances (three starts) against the White Sox...this includes $0-2$ with a 7.30 ERA (12.1 IP, 10 ER), eight walks and 11 strikeouts in the three starts.

AGAINST THE AL CENTRAL: Hill's lone start against the AL Central this season came in his last outing in Cleveland, a no-decision...he's 5 -5 with a 5.44 ERA ( 82.2 IP, 50 ER) in 62 games ( 11 starts), 278 opponent batting average ( 89 -for- 320 ) with 50 walks and 95 strikeouts in his career against the AL Central...this includes $4-4$ with a 5.37 ERA ( 52.0 IP, 31 ER), 26 walks
and 55 strikeouts in the 11 starts.

RICH'S PITCHES: The wiley veteran Hill has thrown five different offerings to opposing hitters this season (four seamer, curve, cutter, slider, sinker), two fewer than last year's seven (four seamer, curve, cutter, slider, sinker, eephus, changeup)...since 2015, he's primarily relied on his four seamer and curve...Hill's repertoire over the years has evolved with his pitching style and age, though Baseball Savant's pitch tracking ability only came into existence in the fourth season of Hill's career (2008)...early on in his career, he relied on his sinker more often, throwing it as much as 42.2 percent of the time in 2012...however, he threw the pitch just seven times in 2019 and has thrown it just twice so far in 2020...below is the full breakdown of Hill's pitches So tar in 2020, according to Baseball Savant:

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE: Hill has thrown his curve 45.9 percent of the time this season, his second-most used pitch so far, behind only his four seamer ( 48.5 percent)...opponents are hitting . 231 (6-for-26) off his curve this year....according to Baseball Savant, Hill's curve is averaging 18.7 inches of horizontal movement, which is 7.1 more inches than similar curves at his velocity...it's the second highest horizontal movement vs. average among pitchers with at least 50 curves thrown this season, behind only San Diego's Pierce Johnson (8), a righty.

HILL AT HOME: Tonight marks Hill's third home start of the season and third career start at Target Field...threw 5.0 scoreless innings on July 29 vs. St. Louis ( $2 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}$ ) in his first outing of hits against the just 2.2 innings in his most recent home outing, permitting four runs on four career games (2 GS) in this ballpark....he's also 31-20 with a 3.55 ERA (429.0 IP, 169 ER) and . 226 opponent batting average (359-for-1590) in 78 career home starts.

OVER THE HILL: Hill is in his 16th major league season and his 19th overall in professional baseball...he and Nelson Cruz became the first 40-year-olds to both make the Opening Day roster in Twins history, and are just the fourth pair of 40-year-olds to play for the Twins at the same time, joining Pat Borders and Terry Mulholland in 2004, and Clark Griffith and Jack Ryan from 1912-13.
$\Phi$ Entering this year, the last MLB team to have multiple 40-year-olds play for it in a single season was the 2017 Atlanta Braves, which featured Bartolo Colon (age 44) and R.A. Dickey (age 42)...the last AL team was the 2016 Boston Red Sox, with David Ortiz (age 40) and Koji Uehara (age 41).

- Since 2016 (min. 400.0 IP ), ranks third in baseball in opponent batting average (.209), seventh in ERA (3.02), ninth in WHIP (1.09) and 12th in strikeouts-per-9.0 IP (10.50)., - He's fifth among active pitchers (min. 3250 opponent AB) with a 280 opponent batting average on balls in play (BABIP).
- Surpassed 900.0 career innings pitched in the first inning on May 22, 2019 at Tampa

Bay...also struck out his 1,000th career batter on September 24, 2019 at San Diego. - Made his major league debut on June 15, 2005 with Chicago-NL against the Florid Marlins, allowing two runs on three hits and striking out two batters in 1.0 inning of relief. - Selected by Chicago-NL in the fourth round (112th overall) of the 2022 MLB First-Yea Player Draft out of the University of Michigan, where he pitched for three seasons from 2000-2002.
