TWINS AND CLEVELAND. Twins and Indians are playing for the 10 th and final time this season as Minnesota holds the advantage, going 6-3-5-1 at Target Field and 1-2 at Progressive Field.. Minnesota holds the advantage, going 6-3-5-1 at larget Field and 1-2 at Progressive Field... this marks the first time the Twins have won the season series over Cleveland since going 12-7 in 2015...additionally, they have taken the season series just thrice since 2011, the other time was going 12-6 in 2012.

Twins have won five straight at home vs. Cleveland, first time since September 8, 2012-July
20, 2013 (also 5)...last time they won at least six straight at home vs. the Indians was April
19-August 1, 2008 (also 6).
F In his career, Eddie Rosario is hitting . 302 (105-for-348) off Cleveland pitching with 17 doubles, four triples, 22 home runs, 47 RBI, a 338 on-base percentage and a . 901 OPS in 92 games...
his 105 hits and 22 homers are his personal most vs. any opponent.
$\Phi$ Josh Donaldson is hitting. 314 ( 53 -for-169) with seven doubles, two triples, 11 home runs,
40 RBI, 37 runs scored, 27 walks, a . 411 on-base percentage and a . 985 OPS' in 44 games.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have reinstated outfielder Max Kepler from the 10-day Injured List after missing nine games with a left adductor strain, an injury he suffered running the bases on September 2 vs. Chicago-AL...Kepler played in 35 games this season, hitting . 220 (27-for-123) with five doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBI, 18 runs scored, 17 walks, a . 322 on-base percentage and a . 753 OPS...to make room for Kepler on the 28-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder Brent Rooker on the 10-day Injured List...Rooker, who was hit by a pitch in the fourth inning of last night's game against
Cleveland, played in seven games for the Twins, going 6 -for-19 (316) with two doubles, one home run and five RBI...the 25 -year-old rookie hit safely in each of his last six games prior to the injury

BOMBA SQUAD RETURNS TO A BALLPARK NEAR YOU: After hitting five home runs last night, the Twins have now recorded multiple homers in five-straight games, a season-long streak and Minnesota's longest since a six-game streak from August 23-29, 2019...they have hit 70 home runs on the season fifth most in baseball and second in the AL, trailing only Chicago (77)...lastly, the Twins 21 homers this month are tied for most in the AL with BOS.

SWEEPS WEEK: Twins are seeking their third sweep of an opponent this season, their previous two coming July 28-29 in two games vs. St. Louis and August 3-4 in two games vs. Pittsburgh, both at Target Field...their last three game sweep of an opponent came September 24-26, 2019 at Detroit and their last at home came August 2-4, 2019 vs. Kansas City.

CAUTION, HIGH WATER: Now at 29-18, the Twins have set a new high water mark in 2020, passing their previous high of 10 games over .500, when they were 20-10 through games of August 24...they were 41 games over .500 through games of September 28, 2019, their best mark since ending the 1965 season a club-record 42 games over (102-60).

BIG MIKE，BIG PERFORMANCES：Pineda has been outstanding over the first two outings of his 2020 season，turning in back－to－back quality starts while going 1－0 with a 2.77 ERA（13．0 IP， 4 ER），three walks and 12 strikeouts．．．has limited the Chicago－AL and Detroit lineups to a ．191／．240／．255 slash ine，with just nine hits（3 doubles）in 47 at－bats
\＄Pineda＇s first start of the season was delayed as he completed a 60－game suspension for vio－ ation of Major League Baseball＇s Joint Drug Prevention and Treatment Program that was levied ast September 7．．．originally an 80－game ban，it was reduced to 60 upon appeal．．．suspension covered the Twins＇final 21 regular season games last year，the 2019 ALDS（three games）and the first 36 regular season contests of 2020
玉＂Big Mike＂was allowed to work out with the big league club during Spring Training；since the resumption of the 2020 season，he pitched regularly at Minnesota＇s Alternate Training Site，CHS Field in St．Paul，as part of Twins＇60－man Player Pool．

LAST TIME OUT：Pineda became the second Twins pitcher in 2020 to work 7.0 innings（joining Kenta Maeda），allowing two runs on three hits in Minnesota＇s 6－2，Labor Day victory over Detroit at Target Field．．．walked two and struck out eight，while tossing 104 pitches（third－most of his Twins tenure and his 36th career outing with 100－plus pitches）．

PINEDA CONTINUES TO ROLL：Beginning on June 29，2019，Pineda is 8－1 with a 2.76 ERA（78．1 IP， 24 ER）， 17 walks， 85 strikeouts and a $.225 / .271 / .362$ opponents＇slash line in his last 13 starts（ 9 quality starts）．．．Minnesota is $10-3$ in those games．

Big Mike enters today＇s start riding a career－high winning streak，as he is $6-0$ with a 2.95 ERA
（55．0 IP， 18 ER）， 10 walks and 57 strikeouts over his last nine starts（beginning July 26，2019）．
QUALITY CONTROL：Despite the 60－game suspension that cost Pineda the end of the 2019 campaign and the beginning of 2020，he is one of 21 American League pitchers with at least 15 quality starts since the start of last season．．．．Michael has amassed those 15 quality starts（2nd－most on the Twins since 2019）in his first 28 starts in a Minnesota uniform（53．6\％）
