THE TWINS: Completed their weekend series with the Indians with a three-game sweep...tonigh they will begin their final roadtrip of the 2020 season with the first of four against the White Sox followed by three at the Cubs this weekend...the Twins will complete the regular season after this trip with an off-day on September 21, two with Detroit September 22-23, an off day on September 24, then three against Cincinnati from September 25-27.
क The Twins have won 10 of their last 12 games overall but have lost six of their last seven away from Target Field.

BULLPEN TARGET PRACTICE ON A SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Twins beat the Indians yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 7-5, sweeping the three-game series, improving to an MLB-best 21-5 at Target Field and winning just their seventh game (7-14) when being out-hit by their opponent... Michael Pineda made his third start of the season, allowing three runs on eight hits in 4.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded just seven hits but four of them were home runs by Josh Donaldson (4), Nelson Cruz (16), Marwin Gonzalez (5) and Ryan Jeffers (3).

TWINS AND SOX...THIS MIGHT BE FUN: The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the seventh of 10 times in 2020...Twins are 4-2 vs. Chicago this season, going 2-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 2-1 at Target Field...the Twins are 9-3 in the last 12 vs. the Sox, dating back to last August...additionally, the Twins have gone 41-22 vs. the White Sox since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent in that span.
$\mp$ Twins have hit 50 home runs vs. the Sox since the start of 2019, their most against any opponent during that time...they have homers in five of six games vs. Chicago this season. ד Miguel Sanó has nine home runs and 20 RBI in 22 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019. $\Phi$ In 22 games since joining Minnesota, Nelson Cruz is hitting .446 ( 37 -for- 83 ) with eight doubles, 11 home runs, 34 RBI, 15 walks, a . 531 OBP, a . 940 SLG and a 1.470 OPS against the White Sox...of those 22 games, he has multiple hits in 11 games and three-plus hits in six games.
DOMINICAN DOMINANCE: Nelson Cruz hit his 417th career home run yesterday afternoon as he continues to chase Chicago-AL's Edwin Encarnación up the Major League Baseball home run chart (list below)...this season Cruz has 16 home runs to Encarnación's eight...among actives, they rank fourth and third respectively, trailing only Albert Pujols (660) and Miguel Cabera (482) PLAYER HOME RUNS

BOMBA SQUAD RETURNS TO A BALLPARK NEAR YOU: After hitting four home runs yesterday, the Twins have now recorded at least one homer in eight straight and multiple homers in six-straight games, tying a Minnesota record (since 1961)...see full chart below...they have hit 74 home runs on the season, fifth most in baseball and second in the AL, trailing only Chicago (78)...lastly, the Twins 25 home runs this month are the most in the AL and second most in baseball, trailing Atlanta (34).

BIG BUCK HUNTER: Byron Buxton is hitting . 308 (8-for-26) with one double, three home runs, seven RBI and a 1.000 OPS in his last nine games (Twins 9-0)...since 2019, the Twins are 71-33 (.683) when Buxton is in the starting lineup.
SEPTEMBER(S) TO REMEMBER: The Twins have opened September with a record of 10-2 (best in the majors), a year after their American League Central-best 18-9 mark in the season's final month helped Minnesota put away the division title... under Rocco Baldelli, the Twins are now 28-11 (.718) in September, the best mark in baseball.

F Twins are hitting . 276 (104-for-377) this month, the third best in the AL...their 25 home runs rank first...their 5.25 runs-per-game ranks second, only to Chicago (6.27).
CRUZ CONTROL: Nelson Cruz is hitting . 331 (52-for-157) with five doubles, 16 home runs, 32 RBI, 20 walks, a .420 on-base percentage, a 669 slugging percentage and a 1.089 OPS...among all American League players he ranks third in batting average (Tim Anderson, 1st - .362), tie for first in home runs (José Abreu, 4th - 15), tied for eighth in RBI (Abreu, 1st - 48), second in on-base percentage (Anderson, 4th - .402), first in slugging percentage (Abreu, 4th - .619) and first in OPS (Anderson, 4th - .981 \& Abreu, 5th - .980).
MANIC MONDAY: The Twins are 5-1 with a 2.50 ERA ( $54.0 \mathrm{IP}, 15 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in six games on Monday...the club is the only team in the American League and one of three teams in the majors with at least five Monday victories this season (San Diego, 6-0 and Chicago-NL, 5-1)...the Twins' 2.50 ERA on Monday is second in the majors only to the Padres' 1.67 ERA...additionally, the Twins' 59 strikeouts on Monday are tops in the AL and second in the majors to Milwaukee's 60.

LAST TIME OUT: In his previous start, Berríos faced the Cardinals in St. Louis in Game 1 of the doubleheader on September 8...Berríos was credited with his first road victory of 2020 in a Twins win, 7-3, after pitching 5.0 innings of a seven-inning game...he allowed four hits, three runs, a home run and two walks and struck out eight....marked the first outing of his career pitching 5.0-or-fewer innings while striking out at least eight hitters...he held the Cardinals scoreless through 5.0 innings, but then gave up a two-run homer to Tommy Edman in the sixth...allowed a single to Paul Goldschmidt in his final batter faced of the day, and was ultimately charged with that run as well after he scored on Matt Wisler's wild pitch...Wisler and Sergio Romo were effective for the rest of the game, though, and sealed the win with 1.0 inning each out of the bullpen.
BERRÍOS AND THE WHITE SOX: Berríos' experience with Chicago-AL is his most extensive against any team as a major leaguer, as he is set to make his 17 th career start against the South Siders tonight...in his 16 previous starts, he's combined for a $12-2$ record and a 2.69 ERA ( 103.2 IP, 31 ER), accompanying 24 walks and 109 strikeouts...Berríos' 12 wins are his most against any single opponent, and combine for more victories than the next two teams on his list ( 5 wins vs. BAL, 5 wins vs. CLE)... he's pitched at least 6.0 innings in 12 of his 16 starts, and Minnesota is $44-2$ against he White Sox in games started by Berríos...in his career at Guaranteed Rate Field, he owns a 4-2 record and a 4.34 ERA ( 45.21 P, 22 ER), with 14 walks, 40 strikeouts and a 263 ( 47 -for-179) opponents' batting average...Berríos' 12 wins against Chicago-AL are the most in the majors vs. any single opponent since 2016...Stephen Strasburg's (WAS) 11 wins against the Marlins are second place since 2016.
RIGHTING THE SHIP: Berríos didn't pitch to his usual standard in his first five starts of 2020, posting a 5.92 ERA ( 24.1 IP, 16 ER) with a $1-3$ record... in his last four starts, though, he's flipped the script with a 2.78 ERA ( $22.2 \mathrm{IP}, 7 \mathrm{ER}$ ) and a $3-0$ record. As a team, Minnesota went $2-3$ in his first five starts and 3-1 in his most recent four. Here is a further juxtaposition between the two stretches: FIRST 5 STARTS

BERRÍOS' WINNING WAYS: Berríos has 44 wins since the start of 2017, ranking third in the American League and trailing Justin Verlander (DET/HOU, 53) and Charlie Morton (HOU/TB, 46)... MLB-wide in that span, 44 wins rank tied for ninth in the majors with Trevor Bauer (CLE/CIN)... his 591 strikeouts rank seventh in the AL in that span, trailing Verlander (816), Chris Sale (BOS, 763), Gerrit Cole (HOU/NYY, 681), Morton (632), Bauer (602) and Carrasco (611).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Traditionally, Berríos has preffered starting in his home ballpark, and 2020 has proved no different...in his career, he's $28-16$ with a 3.52 ERA ( 322.1 IP, 126 ER) when working from him his home rubber, including 3-2 with a 2.67 ERA ( $27.0 \mathrm{IP}, 8 \mathrm{ER}$ ) this season....away from Target Field, he's 19-21 all-time with a 4.93 ERA (321.1 IP, 176 ER), including 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (20.0 IP, 15 ER) in 2020...additionally, he's allowed a home run in each of his last four road starts.

NUMBER 21: In yesterday's game against Cleveland, Berríos temporarily wore No. 21 in observance of Roberto Clemente Day...the rest of Major League Baseball observed on September 9 - a day that saw the entire Pittsburgh roster don the number to honor their club legend, as well as other Puerto Rican players around the league...Berríos, born in Bayamón, PR in 1994, joined fellow Puerto Rican Eddie Rosario and Dominican Nelson Cruz on the Twins roster in wearing the number yesterday... right-handed pitcher Tyler Duffey also wore No. 21, but that is his regularly-assigned jersey number.

PITCH MOVEMENT: In Berríos' first nine starts in 2019, he went 6-2 (7 QS), with a 3.05 ERA (59.0 IP, 20 ER ), 11 walks, 54 strikeouts, a .238 opponent batting average (53-for-223) and a .690 opponent OPS...Conversely, in his first nine starts this season, Berrios is 4-3 (3 QS) with a 4.40 ERA (47.0 IP, 20 ER), 22 walks, 55 strikeouts, a 237 opponent batting average ( 42 -for-177) and a .715 opponent OPS....here are Berríos pitch movement metrics, as they compare between 2019 and 2020:

- Selected to the 2019 MLB All-Star Game, pitching a scoreless third inning.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL, yielding one earned run across 4.0 innings pitched, with six strikeouts and three walks.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 Ks on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
- Named to 2018 AL All-Star team, threw 1.0 scoreless inning in the All-Star Game.
- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2

IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
