THE TWINS: Opened their final roadtrip of the 2020 regular season, a seven-game stay in Chicago,
with consecutive losses to the White Soxthey will play two more at Guaranteed Rate Field tonight
and tomorrow, followed by three at the Cubs this weekendthe Twins will complete the regular
season after this trip with an off day on September 21, two with Detroit on September 22-23, an
off day on Contambor 24 than three against Cincinnati from Contambor 25, 27

off day on September 24, then three against Cincinnati from September 25-27.

The Twins have won 10 of their last 14 games overall but have lost eight of their last nine away from Target Field.

TWINS DUN IN AT GUARANTEED RATE: The Twins lost to Dane Dunning and the White Sox last night by a score of 6-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Randy Dobnak (6-4) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on eight hits in 4.1 innings pitched...the offense was held to just four hits, two from Byron Buxton, who hit his second career inside-the-park home run (previous, August 18, 2017 vs. Arizona)...it marked the 55th in club history and third for Buxton, matching Tony Oliva, Tom Brunansky and Greg Gagne for most in Twins history (since 1961).

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing each other for the ninth of 10 times in 2020... Twins are 4-4 vs. Chicago this season, going 2-3 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 2-1 at Target Field... the Twins are 9-5 in the last 14 vs. the Sox, dating back to last August...additionally, the Twins have gone 41-24 vs. the White Sox since the start of 2017, their most wins vs. any opponent in that span.
₱ Twins have hit 51 home runs vs. the Sox since the start of 2019, their most against any opponent during that time...they have homers in six of eight games vs. Chicago this season.

₱ Nelson Cruz still boasts a .422 batting average (38-for-90) with eight doubles, 11 home runs, 34 RBI, 16 walks a .509 OBP, an .878 slugging percentage and a 1.387 OPS in 24 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019).

RISP REWARD: Twins are 2-for-21 (.095) with RISP in these last two games vs. the White Sox... however, they are still second in the American League with a .274 (87-for-318) RISP average and fifth in baseball, trailing San Diego (.316), Los Angeles-NL (.280), Miami (.276) and Detroit (.275).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1970**, Bert Blyleven, a 19-year-old rookie, ties an American League record by striking out the first six batters and strikes out 10 in 6.2 innings...in **1991**, Kevin Tapani (15-8) becomes the Twins' third 15-game winner (Morris & Erickson), pitching a three-hitter for 7.2 innings against the Royals...in **1993**, Dave Winfield becomes the 19th player to collect 3,000 hits as he singles to left off Dennis Eckersley in the Metrodome...in **1996**, Paul Molitor records his 3,000th hit, tripling at Kauffman Stadium.

HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH: As part of the variety of player and community-centric digital programming in celebration of Hispanic Heritage Month, the Twins' many Hispanic players will be featured in profiles that highlight both their on-field excellence and their native culture, showcasing "favorite things" from the Dominican Republic, Puerto Rico and Venezuela...additionally, the Twins are collaborating with Minneapolis-based MLatino Media, LLC to launch profile videos of Latino community members in a series titled "Yo.  Twins are a 10-9 with a 3.62 ERA (159.0 IP, 64 ER) this season in games following a loss, the third-best ERA in the American League and fifth best in the majors.
 Twins pitchers lead the American League and rank second in the majors with eight pickoffs this season, behind San Francisco (9)...individually, José Berríos' two pickoffs are tied for first in the AL and tied for fifth most in the majors.
 Twins are averaging 3.99 pitches-per-plate appearance this season, the team's third-highest single-season mark since 1988 (when accurate pitch count data is available), trailing only the 2013 Twins (4.02) and the 2014 Twins (4.00)...this is with the caveat that those teams saw approximately 3.5 times as many pitches as the current Twins. approximately 3.5 times as many pitches as the current Twins. LAST TIME OUT: Odorizzi last appeared on August 21 at Kansas City, taking the loss after allowing five runs on seven hits (one home run), with one strikeout in 3.0 innings, plus two batters...four of those runs came in the first inning, on an RBI single by Hunter Dozier and a three-run homer by Jorge Soler...Odo also pitched to two batters in the fourth, allowing singles by Maikel Franco and Alex Gordon; Franco scored off Jorge Alcala after Jake departed...marked his most runs allowed in a start since July 24, 2019 vs. New York-AL (9 ER in 4.0 IP).

In the bottom of the fourth inning, Odo was struck on the ribs by a 103.2 mph line drive off the bat of Alex Gordon and was removed from the game...the resulting chest contusion put him on the 10-day Injured List for the second time this season (also, July 23-August 8, right intercostal strain)...he was reinstated earlier today to make the start tonight.

AGAINST THE SOX: Odo went 2-2 with a 2.86 ERA (22.0 IP, 7 ER), five walks, 32 strikeouts and a .247/.297/.306 opponent slash line in four starts against the White Sox in 2019...last faced the South Siders on September 18, 2019 at Target Field, taking the loss despite permitting just two runs on seven hits in 5.2 innings, with one walk and nine strikeouts...his **32 K's against the White Sox in 2019 were his most against any single opponent**...in 10 career starts against Chicago-AL, Jake is 3-4 with a 3.20 ERA (56.1 IP, 20 ER), 15 walks and 74 K's...this includes 1-1 with a 3.74 ERA (21.1 IP, 9 ER) in four career starting nods at Guaranteed Rate Field.

CENTRAL-LY SPEAKING: Jake has done some of his best work over the last season-plus within the division...in 17 starts vs. the AL Central since 2019, he is 8-4 with a 3.36 ERA (88.1 IP, 33 ER), 22 walks, 106 strikeouts (10.80 K/9.0 IP) and a .234/.288/.359 opponents' slash line...Minnesota is 11-6 in those games.

SETTLING IN: Since the start of 2019, opposing batters have hit .313 (31-for-99) off Jake's first 15 pitches of his starts...in the same span, that number drops to .180 (18-for-100) for pitches 16-30 and to .170 (17-for-100) for pitches 31-45...similarly, since the start of 2019 opponents are batting .279 (36-for-129) against Odo in the first inning, .180 (20-for-111) in the second inning and .207 (24-for-116) in the third inning.

AN OPPOSITE TREND: Last year, Jake held right-handed batters to a .194 (59-for-304) batting average, second best among AL pitchers (min. 150.0 IP) and seventh best in the majors...his mark was the lowest by a Twins pitcher (min. 150.0 IP) since Johan Santana in 2004 (.191) and the second lowest single-season mark by a Twins right-handed pitcher, behind Scott Erickson's .191 batting average vs. right-handed batters in 1991...however, opposing right-handed hitters are batting .370 (10-for-27) with three home runs against Jake so far this season.

ON THE ROAD: Two of Jake's three starts this season have occurred on the road...Odo is 4-1 with a 4.08 ERA (39.2 IP, 18 ER) in his last eight road starts, dating back to July 13, 2019...if you subtract his last start in Kansas City, his road ERA in that span drops to 3.19 (36.2 IP, 13 ER).

THE REPERTOIRE: Jake's first three starts have shown a prevalence on off-speed pitches that was not present in 2019, including re-introducing a slider...after throwing his four seamer a career-high 57.9 percent of the time last season, he has used that pitch just 37.3 percent of his first three efforts (with a nearly identical 92.9 mph average velocity)...here's the full breakdown, per Baseball Savant:
