LAST TIME OUT: In his previous start, on August 26, Berríos took a no-decision as the Twins fell to Cleveland, 3-6...at Progressive Field, he threw 5.2 innings and allowed three earned runs with a season-high-tying four walks and six strikeouts...all three earned runs were scored via the bat of José Ramírez, whose third-inning homer scored Delino DeShields and César Hernández...

BERRÍOS AND THE SOX: Looking at Chicago-AL, Berríos sees his most frequent MLB adversary, against whom he's started against 15 times (tied with Kansas City)...he began the season as the Twins' Opening Day starter, facing the Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field on July 24...

SAME MAKEUP, DIFFERENT RESULTS: Berríos has gotten off to a slower start in his first seven starts of 2020 compared to his first seven in 2019...last season, he went 5-1 in his first seven nods (6 QS), with a 2.91 ERA (46.1 IP, 15 ER), eight walks, 46 strikeouts, a .216 opponent batting average (37-for-171) and a .654 opponent OPS...

A TALE OF TWO HANDEDNESSES: In his career, Berríos has held right-handed hitters to a .251 batting average, and left-handed hitters to .241...this season, though, Berríos has seen a stark difference in his efficiency with regard to the two orientations...lefties are hitting just .188 (13-for-69), with a .305 OBP and .711 OPS...righties are hitting .328 (22-for-67), with a .387 OBP and .849 OPS.

FRIDAY'S STARTER - RHP RANDY DOBNAK (SEASON- 5-2, 3.12 ERA // CAREER- 7-3, 2.43 ERA)

Right-hander Randy Dobnak is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season in the first game of Friday's doubleheader against Detroit at Target Field...it will be his second consecutive start against the Tigers — the second time this season he'll face an opponent in two consecutive nods (also 8/16 & 8/22 vs. Kansas City)...in his previous start, at Comerica Park, Dobnak surrendered 12 hits and six runs, each of which were career-mosts for a single outing...

- Selected to the 2019 MLB All-Star Game, pitching a scoreless third inning.
• Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL, yielding one earned run across 4.0 innings pitched, with six strikeouts and three walks.
• In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 Ks on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
• Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
• Became 21st pitcher in Twins history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
• Named to 2018 AL All-Star team, threw 1.0 scoreless inning in the All-Star Game.
• Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.

MAKING A TARGET RUN AT HISTORY: In 52 career games (51 starts) at Target Field, Berríos is 27-16 with a 3.64 ERA (309.1 IP, 125 ER), compared to his 18-21 record and 4.92 ERA (316.1 IP, 173 ER) in games on the road...his 322 strikeouts in the venue are only second to Kyle Gibson's 417...additionally, his 27 career Target Field wins are secondary only to Gibson since the ballpark's inception in 2010...below is a chart of all-time wins at Target Field:

BERRÍOS' WINNING WAYS: Berríos has 42 wins since the start of 2017, tied with Rick Porcello for fourth most in the AL, trailing Justin Verlander (53), Charlie Morton (46) and Carlos Carrasco (43)...his 575 strikeouts rank eighth in that span, trailing Verlander (816), Chris Sale (763), Gerrit Cole (662), Morton (621), Trevor Bauer (602), Carrasco (598) and James Paxton (576).
