TIGERS their 12th series win of the season by way of their sixth rubber game victory...José Berríos was the starter and winner for Minnesota, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings on four hits, a walk and four strikeouts...he held his brother-in-law, Javier Báez, to an 0-for-2 effort after Báez fouled out and July: 2020 Record-4-4 August: The statist and while is brother-in-law, lavier Báez, to an 0-for-2 effort after Báez fouled out and grounded into a fielder's choice...marked the pair's first matchup in regular season play...after Berríos' exit, the bullpen combination of Trevor May, Taylor Rogers and Sergio Romo held Chicago hitless through the final 3.0 innings to round out the game and roadtrip...marked the second time this season Minnesota's bullpen finished a game with at least 3.0 IP without allowing a hit (other instance was also on the roadtrip – 5.1 perfect innings on 9/16 at CWS).
The Twins dealt Cubs starter and NL Cy Young Award contender Yu Darvish the loss, giving Minnessota three-straight series with a win over its opponent's ace (defeated CLE's Shane Bieber 9/11 and CWS' Lucas Giolito on 9/16).
Max Kepler went 3-for-5 out of the leadoff spot and finished a triple shy of the cycle after a first-inning single, a seventh-inning home run and a ninth-inning double...longball was his first since going yard on August 26 at Cleveland...became the third European-born player to reach 100 career home runs in MLB history, joining Bobby Thomson (264 HR, United Kingdom) and Didi Gregorius (119 HR, the Netherlands).
Josh Donaldson went 2-for-3 with two walks, booking his fourth multi-hit game of the season and his first game reaching base at least four times.
Jake Cave became the third player in Twins history to hit a triple at Wrigley Field, alongside Willians Astudillo (7/1/18) and Todd Walker (9/2/97). Run Differential: &3-2 (8) Romo/Jiménez/May +55(245-190)**ROSTER MOVE**: The Minnesota Twins today announced that they have reinstated right-handed pitcher Homer Bailey from the 45-day Injured list...Bailey will start tonight's game against Detroit... the 34-year-old missed 51 games with right biceps tendinitis, and made just one start – his first as a Twin before going on the Injured List...Bailey, who signed as a free agent in the offseason, earned the win in the Twins' home opener on July 28 vs. St. Louis after pitching 5.0 innings and allowing two runs on four hits, with two walks and four strikeouts...Bailey was originally placed on the 10-day IL on August 2 (retroactive to July 29) and was transferred to the 45-day Injured List on August 22...to make room on the 28-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Sean Poppen to the club's alternate training site in St. Paul...Poppen has posted a 4.70 ERA (7.2 IP, 4 ER) and 10 strikeouts in six appearances across five stints with the Twins this season...his most recent recall occurred on September 18, though his last outing was on September 8 at St. Louis. Was minor league manager in the Twins' system from 1988-90, before joining the major league coaching staff in 1991 (Single-A Kenosha in 1988, Double-A Orlando from 1989-90)...was the third base coach for Minnesota's 1991 World Series champions.
As a player, selected by New York-NL in sixth round of 1979 June Draft out of the University of Texas at Austin.
Made major league debut on September 1, 1981 at Houston; played parts of five seasons for the Mets from 1981-85...retired as player in 1987.
Overall, his 1,200 managerial wins are fifth most among active managers.
His 84 ejections are seventh most in MLB history (71 of the 84 came with the Twins).
Justin Morneau on Gardy (via MLB.com): "He looked out for me. He treated me like a son. He was a guy who always wanted the best for his players. He was a players' manager. And he had such a good feel of, once or twice a year, if the effort wasn't good enough, come in and yell and blow up the room and let everybody know that effort is expected and focus is expected."
"He was willing to change and do what was necessary to evolve and get the most out of his teams and his players. You can see them turning the corner, you can see his fingerprints on that club, and if that club turns into a winning club next year or the year after, you know he's had an impact on those guys who're still there once he's gon." WELCOME BACK, HOMER: Bailey was reinstated from the 45-day Injured List earlier today, to make the start tonight against the Tigers...he missed 51 games with right biceps tendinitis, going on the 10-day Injured List on August 2 (retroactive to July 29)...transferred to the 60-day IL on August 22.
 Homer made one start prior to going on the shelf...earned the win in his first career outing in a Twins uniform, leading Minnesota to a 6-3 victory over St. Louis in the 2020 Home Opener on July 28...marked his first career start at Target Field...allowed a base runner in each of his first four innings and took a shutout into the fifth before yielding a two-run homer to Tyler O'Neill... after the longball, retired his last three hitters, departing with a 6-2 lead after allowing the two runs on four bits in 5 0 inpings (2 R A SD)

GOOD LIVING IN THE JUNIOR CIRCUIT: Homer's Twins debut back in July marked his 32nd career start as an American League pitcher, a stretch in which he is 14-9 with a 4.54 ERA (168.1 IP, 85 ER), 166 hits allowed, 55 walks and 153 strikeouts...Bailey made his AL debut last season with Kansas City and Oakland, before signing a one-year contract with Minnesota on December 31,

## CENTRALLY SPEAKING: In nine starts last season vs. AL Central clubs (excluding Minnesota), Bailey went 4-0 with a 2.18 ERA (53.2 IP, 13 ER), 13 walks, 44 strikeouts, a .217 opponent batting average (43-for-198) and just four home runs allowed. Φ In three 2019 starts vs. Detroit, Bailey went 2-0 with a 1.96 ERA (18.1 IP, 4 ER), six walks,

13 strikeouts and a .203 opponent batting average (14-for-69)

CAREER VS. THE TIGERS: Tonight's start marks the sixth of Bailey's career against Detroit...he's 2-1 with a 2.45 ERA (33.01P, 9 ER) and a .190 opponent batting average (23-for-121) in his five prior starts...his ERA and BAA vs. Detroit are his lowest career marks against any single opponent that he's faced at least thrice...all five of his career starts against the Tigers have been quality, and four of the five have occurred since 2018-the only outlier is his first start against them on June 10, 2012 at Great American Ball Park (ND, 6.2 IP, 6 H, 3 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 7 K).

**THE REPERTOIRE:** Bailey's pitch mix has changed over the years, following the contours of his career...in 2009, his first full big league season, Bailey threw a four seamer, sinker, changeup, slider and curve...the changeup was phased out and replaced by his second-most thrown pitch in 2019, his split finger, between 2016-17...the split finger was his most effective out-creator last season, as he held opponents to a .188 (35-for-186) batting average on the pitch...below is the following Deviate the pitch...below

  He is in his 14th career major league season...the Twins are his fourth organization: Cincinnati (2007-18), Kansas City (2019) and Oakland (2019).
  Matched his career high in wins last season, going 13-9 with a 4.57 ERA between Kansas City and Oakland...his 31 combined starts were his most since 2013 (32 starts).
  He's one of 30 pitchers in major league history with multiple no-hitters, including five currently active (Jake Arrieta 2, Mike Fiers 2, Max Scherzer 2, Justin Verlander 2)... tossed his first no-hitter Sept. 28, 2012 at Pittsburgh (1-0 win)...pitched his second no-hitter the following season, on July 2, 2013 vs. San Francisco (3-0 win).
  On May 3, 2012 vs. the Cubs, participated in the first game in MLB history in which both starting pitchers celebrated birthdays, starting opposite Ryan Dempster...Bailey turned 26 that day, while it was Dempster's 35th birthday.
