**THE TWINS:** After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 3-4 (1-3 against the White Sox and 2-1 against the Cubs), the Twins began their five-game homestand with a win over Detroit last night...tonight they will continue their final homestand of 2020 with the second of two with Detroit...the Twins will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Reds for three over the weekend.  
☞ The Twins have won 14 of their last 20 games overall, and are 22-5 at Target Field this season.

**WHY WOULD WE NOT WEAR A ROBE IN THE DUGOUT:** The Twins beat the Tigers last night by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings, making them 3-0 in extras this season...they entered the eighth inning trailing 3-2 but scored in the bottom of the eighth, marking their second win this season (2-12) when trailing after seven innings...Homer Bailey returned from the 45-day Injured List and allowed one run on two hits in 3.0 innings pitched...six relievers followed Bailey, matching a season-high for pitchers used in a game this season (7)...the offense recorded nine hits, three from Max Kepler, who delivered the walk-off single in the 10th inning...Twins got home runs from Byron Buxton (13), Mitch Garver (2) and Kepler (9)...Buxton's homer was a leadoff shot, the second of his career (first to go over the wall) and fifth for a Twins player this season, joining Kepler (3) and Jorge Polanco (1).  
☞ Postgame, Rocco Baldelli commented about the home run robe with media via ZOOM: "When I saw it in the dugout, I wasn't expecting it. I was a little surprised and then I'm like, yeah, why would we not wear a robe in the dugout."

**IT'S A WALK-OFF!:** Last night marked the Twins' fourth walk-off victory of the season, matching their 2019 total...below are the Twins walk-offs this season:

**ALSO:** Cleveland hosts the White Sox tonight at 5:10 p.m. (CT)...Shane Bieber and Lucas Giolito are the probables...tomorrow, those two teams finish the series with Zach Plesac vs. Dallas Keuchel.

**MINNESOTA AND THE MOTOR CITY:** The Twins and Tigers are playing the 10th of 10 meetings this season...Twins have gone 5-4 over the Tigers, 5-1 at Target Field and 0-3 at Comerica Park...Twins are attempting to win their fourth consecutive season series against Detroit.

☞ In 65 career games, Jorge Polanco is hitting .304 (76-for-250) all-time vs. Detroit pitching, including 14 doubles, four triples, seven home runs and 34 RBI.

**HOW DO YOU SAY "HEATING UP" IN GERMAN?:** Max Kepler is 7-for-14 (.500) in his last three games, with two doubles, two home runs and five RBI, including back-to-back three-hit games...prior to the last three games, he was just 2-for-19 in his first six contests after returning from the 10-day Injured List (left adductor strain).

**CAUTION, HIGH WATER:** Now at 34-22 and 12 games above .500, the Twins have matched their high-water mark in 2020, previously done through games of September 13, when they were 30-18...Twins were 41 games over .500 through games of September 28, 2019, their best mark since ending the 1965 season a club-record 42 games over (102-60).

**SWEEPS WEEK:** Twins are seeking their fourth sweep of an opponent this season, their previous three coming July 28-29 in two games vs. St. Louis, August 3-4 in two games vs. Pittsburgh and three games vs. Cleveland September 11-13, all at Target Field...their last sweep of Detroit came in three games at Comerica Park September 24-26 last season, clinching the AL Central title after the middle game.

**MAY DAY:** Trevor May is celebrating his 31st birthday today...he has appeared in one career game on his birthday, coming in 2018, pitching 1.1 scoreless inning in a Twins 5-1 victory at Oakland...he shares a birthday with Rockies outfielder Matt Kemp (36), Brewers infielder Jedd Gyorko (32), singer-songwriter Bruce Springsteen (71), the late singer Ray Charles, actor Jason Alexander (61) and rapper Layzie Bone (46).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1990, Gary Gaetti hit a grand slam off the Rangers Charlie Hough for his 200th career home run, as the Twins won, 6-4; it came nine years and four days after his first major league homer, also off Hough...in 2003, the Twins clinched the AL Central for the second straight season; the 4-1 win over Cleveland marked the 10th win in an 11-game winning streak.

**REST PEACEFULLY, DAN DETTMAN:** The Twins send thoughts and prayers to the family of longtime FOX Sports North cameraman Dan Dettman, who passed away Monday...a mainstay at ballparks and arenas around the Twin Cities since the early 80's, Dan worked Twins, North Stars, Timberwolves, Wild and Gophers games, always going about his day with a smile and a positive energy that one couldn't help but notice.

**MAED-A IN JAPAN:** Kenta Maeda (712) is two strikeouts away from tying Hisashi Iwakuma (714) for the sixth-most strikeouts by a Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history...he is also eight strikeouts away from tying Daisuke Matsuzaka (720) for the fifth-most on that list.

- Tonight is scheduled to make his 11th start of 2020 and the 114th of his career.
- Enters tonight's game with at least seven strikeouts in each of his last six starts...the run is currently tied for the fifth-longest such streak in Twins history.
- With 712 career strikeouts, Maeda is two shy of tying Hisashi Iwakuma (714) for sixth-most by a Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history...also is just eight shy of tying Daisuke Matsuzaka (720) for fifth-most all-time.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Maeda walked away with a no-decision in his previous start, which came in a 3-4 Twins defeat at the hands of the Chicago White Sox on September 17...at Guaranteed Rate Field, he allowed two earned runs (2 HR) across 5.0 innings on five hits, no walks and eight strikeouts... both homers were solo shots – one in the fourth by José Abreu and the other in the fifth by Edwin Encarnación...Twins held a 3-2 lead after the sixth inning, but two runs by the South Siders in the bottom of the seventh proved to be the difference.

**MAEDA VS. THE TIGERS:** Maeda tonight faces Detroit for the second time at Target Field, the third time overall in 2020 and for the fourth time in his career...four starts will be his most against any opponent in the AL Central...all-time against the Tigers, he's 0-2 with a 5.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 10 ER), one walk and 23 strikeouts...his two starts against Detroit this season were nearly identical, as he pitched 6.0 innings, allowed three earned runs and struck out eight in both of them (8/30 at Comerica Park and 9/5 at Target Field)...Twins are 1-1 in his starts against the Motor City, and is holding its hitters to a .194 batting average (13-for-67) in his career...in 11 career starts against teams of the American League Central division, he's 7-2 with a 2.66 ERA (61.0 IP, 18 ER), 11 walks and 69 strikeouts...his AL Central ERA is his best against any single division.

**MAEDA TOP OF HIS CLASS:** Maeda ranks near the top of several MLB categories among qualified pitchers, including WHIP (1st, 0.76) and opponent batting average (4th, .167)...furthermore, here is how Maeda stacks up against other qualified MLB pitchers this season:

**STRIKEOUT STRING:** With eight strikeouts in his last outing, Maeda has punched out at least seven batters in his last six starts, extending his career-best run in that regard...**there have only been four longer such streaks in Twins history: Johan Santana, 10 games; Tom Hall, 8 games; Santana, 7 games; Bert Blyleven, 7 games.**...José Berríos was the last Minnesota pitcher to reach the six-game threshold, also doing so in six consecutive outings, from May 15–June 13, 2018...the only longer active runs in MLB belong to Shane Bieber (CLE, 11), Yu Darvish (CHC, 8), Gerrit Cole (NY, 8) and Tyler Glasnow (TB, 7).

**RIGHT AT HOME:** Maeda today will make his fifth home start of the season, and is a perfect 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 4 ER), six walks and 33 strikeouts in that regard...**also holding hitters to a .092 batting average (8-for-87) at Target Field, which is by far the lowest mark in the majors among pitchers with at least 20.0 IP in their home ballpark.**...the next closest is Houston's Cristian Javier, who has posted a .135 opponents' batting average (13-for-96) across 29.0 innings at Minute Maid Park.

**FELLOW JAPANESE HURLERS:** Maeda is two strikeouts away from tying Hisashi Iwakuma (714, SEA, 2012-17) for sixth-most strikeouts among Japanese-born pitchers, and eight strikeouts away from tying Daisuke Matsuzaka (720, BOS/NYM, 2007-14) for fifth on the list...below is a look at how Maeda ranks in other categories among fellow Japanese-born pitchers (min. 600.0 IP):

## MISCELLANEOUS MAEDA MARVELS:

- ☞ He's striking out 31.6 percent of his batters faced, which is on pace to set a Twins single-season record...Johan Santana's 30.1 percent in 2004 is currently best in team history.
- ☞ In 2020, Maeda is also on track to finish with the lowest opponents' batting average (.167) among starting pitchers in team history (min. 10 starts).
- ☞ Opponents are hitting .083 (11-for-132) off of Maeda in two-strike counts, which is lowest in the American League and second-lowest in MLB among pitchers with at least 100 batters faced in such counts (Corbin Burnes, MIL, .051).

## FRIDAY'S STARTER – RHP JOSÉ BERRÍOS [SEASON: 5-3, 3.72 ERA // CAREER: 48-37, 4.17 ERA]

José Berríos is slated to take the ball for the Twins in Friday's series opener against the Cincinnati Reds at Target Field...the series will mark the Twins' last of the 2020 regular season, and their first against Cincinnati since 2018, when the Reds took two out of three games in Minnesota...after a turbulent beginning to the season, Berríos has corrected course by allowing three-or-fewer runs in each of his last six outings – all of which have totaled at least 5.0 innings...Berríos opposed Cincinnati once in the 2018 series for his only career start against the Redlegs, and lasted just 3.0 innings after surrendering four earned runs on five hits, three walks and zero strikeouts...will be his fifth start against the NL Central this season...has won each of his four starts against the division this year, and has posted a 1.57 ERA (23.0 IP, 4 ER) against it, with seven walks, 27 strikeouts and a .163 opponents' batting average (13-for-80).

## CAREER NOTES

- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight straight K's.
- Became the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Entering 2020, 9.79 career K/9.0 IP ratio was fourth among Japanese-born pitchers in MLB history (min. 100.0 IP), and .227 career opponent batting average was sixth.
- 16 wins in 2016 were the second most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
- Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in his major league debut, also hitting a solo home run in his second-career at-bat.
