**THE TWINS:** The Twins began their five-game, regular-season-ending homestand with a two-game sweep of the Detroit Tigers, followed by a loss to the Reds last night.

☞ The Twins' magic number to clinch home field advantage for the Wild Card Series is **one** – either a Twins win OR a Yankees loss and an Indians loss...Minnesota's magic number to clinch the club's second-consecutive AL Central division title is **two** – a combination of Twins wins and/or White Sox losses.

**TWINS DROP GAME ONE TO REDS:** The Twins lost to the Reds last night at Target Field by a score of 7-2...José Berríos (5-4) was the starter and loser, allowing four runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Edwar Colina made his major league debut, allowing three runs on four hits in 0.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Eddie Rosario and Jorge Polanco...the Twins went 2-for-13 with runners in scoring position and left 11 men on base...the loss snapped a six-game home win streak, matching the club's season high.

**BACK ON TOP:** After the Twins' victory Wednesday night and Cleveland completing a four-game sweep of the White Sox Monday-Thursday, the Twins now hold sole possession of first place in the American League Central...Minnesota initially took a 0.5-game lead Wednesday night, gaining sole possession of first place for the first time since August 27...despite last night's setback against the Reds, Minnesota maintains a 1.0-game lead on Chicago and Cleveland in the division, due to the White Sox loss to the Cubs last night and Cleveland's win over Pittsburgh...below are the current division standings:

**ALSO:** Cleveland hosts Pittsburgh tonight at 6:10 p.m. (CT), while the White Sox host the Cubs at 6:10 p.m. (CT)...should the year end with a tie for the division lead, the White Sox hold the two-team tiebreaker over the Twins, the Twins hold the two-team tiebreaker over the Indians, and the Twins hold the three-team tiebreaker over the White Sox and Indians.

**AND FINALLY:** The AL Central (Minnesota, Chicago, Cleveland) and the AL East (Tampa Bay, New York, Toronto) are the only two divisions so far with three confirmed playoff teams...all other divisions have two.

**THE TWIN CITIES VS. THE QUEEN CITY:** Minnesota and Cincinnati are facing off this weekend for the first time since 2018, when the Reds took two of three at Target Field...with last night's win, the Reds took a 13-12 lead in the all-time series, which dates back to the advent of Interleague Play in 1997...the Twins are 8-5 against the Redlegs at home and 4-8 in Cincy.

**WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE:** The Twins are 12-6 this season in Interleague Play, going 3-1 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 4-2 vs. Milwaukee, 2-1 vs. Chicago and 0-1 vs. Cincinnati...the Twins are 6-2 against the Senior Circuit at home and 6-4 on the road...the club's .667 winning percentage overall in IL Play this season is tops in the American League and second in the majors to Los Angeles-NL (14-4, .778).

☞ With a win over the Cubs at Wrigley Field a week ago, the Twins secured a winning season vs. the National League, their first since 2017 (13-7)...also marks their second winning season in IL play since 2010.

☞ Michael Pineda won his lone Interleague start so far this season, leading the Twins to an 8-1 win over the Cubs a week ago by allowing just one run on four hits in 5.0 innings...he's 9-4 with a 2.85 ERA (110.1 IP, 35 ER) in 19 career starts against the Senior Circuit...this includes 3-0 with a 2.83 ERA (35.0 IP, 11 ER) in six career starts against the National League Central division (has never faced Cincinnati).

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .314 (151-for-481) with 26 doubles, 31 home runs, 97 RBI, 98 runs scored and a .973 OPS in 129 career IL games...in his last 12 IL games, he is hitting .410 (16-for-39) with five doubles, four home runs and 15 RBI.

**POLO POWER:** Jorge Polanco recorded his team-leading 17th multi-hit game of the season last night, as he batted seventh for just the second time this season...enters tonight on a four-game hitting streak, one shy of his season high (done twice, most recently August 20-25)...he's batting .375 (6-for-16) with two doubles, two runs scored and an .875 OPS during his current streak...also batting .290 (20-for-69) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and nine runs scored in 17 IL games this season, including .333 (8-for-24) in his last six games against the Senior Circuit.

**RED-HOT ROSIE:** Eddie Rosario notched his 14th multi-hit game last night and third in his last five contests...he's batting .364 (8-for-22) with two homers, six RBI, four runs scored and a 1.028 OPS over his last five games...has six home runs and 16 RBI in 16 games vs. the NL this season...since the start of last season, he has 12 home runs and 31 RBI...the 12 homers are tied for third most in baseball while his 31 RBI are tied for sixth...Rosario has 61 Interleague RBI over all in his career, sixth most in Twins history and one shy of tying Brian Dozier (62) for fifth.

**RISP AND RELIEF:** Four different Twins relievers – Trevor May, Cody Stashak, Tyler Clippard and Jorge Alcalá – have each stranded the bases loaded without allowing a run to score this season...May was the first to turn the trick on September 17 at Chicago-AL, followed by Stashak on September 22 vs. Detroit, Clippard the following night, on September 23 vs. Detroit and Alcalá last night...the Twins bullpen has allowed just 19 of 72 inherited runners to score this season, and the club's 26.4 IR scored percent in second in the majors to the Rays (19.1%)...Twins relievers are holding opposing hitters to a .133 batting average (3-for-30) with the bases loaded, second lowest in the majors (Cleveland, .083)...similarly, the bullpen's .227 opponent batting average (51-for-233) with runners in scoring position is third in the AL, behind Oakland (.182) and Texas (.224).

**RAISING THIELBAR:** Caleb Thielbar recorded his second 2.0-inning perfect outing of the season last night (sixth of his career)...he's one of nine pitchers this season to record multiple perfect outings of at least 2.0 innings (six AL, three NL)...Thielbar's curve ball is averaging 79 inches of vertical movement this season, which is 7.5 more inches than similar curves at his average velocity...those 7.5 inches above average are second most in the majors among left-handed pitchers (min. 50 curves thrown this season), behind only Boston's Matt Hall (8.3 inches above average).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** in 1965, the Twins defeated the Senators 2-1 in Washington, clinching the first American League pennant in Minnesota history, as well as the first in overall franchise history (1901-present) since 1933...in 1981, the Twins' 7-3 win over the Rangers at Met Stadium was delayed for 48 minutes by rain – it marked the Twins' last home rain delay until outdoor baseball returned in 2010.
