**THE TWINS:** Today the Twins will complete their 60th regular season in Minnesota with the three-game series finale with Cincinnati...they have gone 3-1 on their final homestand, going 2-0 over Detroit, followed by a split with the Reds so far this weekend...Twins will play their next game in the AL Wild Card round on Tuesday with a time and opponent yet to be determined.

☞ Minnesota's magic number to clinch the club's second-consecutive AL Central division title is **one** - needing either a Twins win or a White Sox loss.

**I LOVE LUEY:** The Twins beat the Reds last night at Target Field by a score of 7-3...Michael Pineda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs (both in the 1st inning) on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the top four in the Twins lineup combined to go 8-for-14 with six doubles, including four hits in four at-bats for Luis Arraez, three of which were doubles...the eight doubles on the night for the offense tied for second-highest single-game total in Twins/Senators franchise history (record is nine on July 5, 2019 by MIN and June 9, 1934 by WAS).

☞ Last night's win, combined with Oakland's two losses to Seattle in their doubleheader, slid Minnesota into the No. 2 seed in the American League Postseason picture...they can keep that spot a win today or losses by Oakland and Chicago-AL...Rays own the No. 1 seed.

**AND FINALLY:** The AL Central (Minnesota, Chicago, Cleveland) and the AL East (Tampa Bay, New York, Toronto) are the only two divisions so far with three confirmed playoff teams...all other divisions have two.

**THE TWIN CITIES VS. THE QUEEN CITY:** Minnesota and Cincinnati are facing off this weekend for the first time since 2018, when the Reds took two of three at Target Field...Twins are 13-13 all-time against the Reds, going 9-5 against the Redlegs at home (7-2 at Metrodome & 2-3 at Target Field) and 4-8 in Cincy (1-5 at Cinergy Field & 3-3 at Great American Ball Park).

☞ Reliever Matt Wisler is the only player on roster that has played for the Reds, appearing in 11 games for them in 2018, going 0-0, 2.03 ERA (13.1 IP, 3 ER) with two walks and 11 strikeouts.

**WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE:** The Twins are 13-6 this season in Interleague Play, going 3-1 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 4-2 vs. Milwaukee, 2-1 vs. Chicago and 1-1 vs. Cincinnati...the Twins are 7-2 against the NL at home and 6-4 on the road...the club's .684 winning percentage overall in IL Play this season is tops in the American League and second in the majors to Los Angeles-NL (15-4, .789).

☞ This season marks the Twins' second winning season in IL play since 2010...also 13-7 in 2017.

**WIN-NESOTA:** Twins are 24-6 at Target Field this season, the most home wins in baseball...they have a .793 winning percentage at home...prior to this season, the Twins/Senators franchise top winning percentage at home were the 1930 Senators (56-21, .727), 1931 Senators (55-22, .714), 1925 Senators (53-22, .707) and the 1960 Twins (57-24, .704)...fun fact, three teams have finished a season with a higher home winning percentage: the 1932 Yankees (62-15, .805), the 1961 Yankees (65-16, .802) and the 1931 Philadelphia Athletics (60-15, .800).

**RED-HOT ROSIE:** Eddie Rosario has reached safely via hit or walk in each of his last 13 games...he has hit safely six straight, hitting .360 (9-for-25) with one double, two home runs, eight RBI, a .370 on-base percentage and a 1.010 OPS in that span...has six home runs and 18 RBI in 18 games vs. the NL this season...since the start of last season, he has 12 home runs and 32 RBI...the 12 homers are tied for third most in baseball while his 32 RBI rank fifth...Rosario has 62 Interleague RBI in his career, tied with Brian Dozier for fifth most in Twins history...the top four are Joe Mauer (123), Justin Morneau (107), Torii Hunter (106) and Michael Cuddyer (66).

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1998, Twins manager Paul Molitor played his final game of his Hall of Fame career, batting fourth at DH for the Twins...he went 2-for-4 and singled off Doug Jones in his last career plate appearance for hit number 3,319...in 2019, the Twins won their 100th game of the season in a 6-2 victory over Kansas City, marking the second time in club history (102-60 in 1965).
