SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES': A win in any of the final three games against Detroit on this Labor Day weekend (tonight-Monday) would give the Twins their 10th series victory of the season...they have gone 9-3-1 in series play in 2020, including 6-0-0 at home.

HIP, HIP JORGE: Jorge Polanco's four-hit effort in Game 2 of yesterday's doubleheader was his 14th multi-hit game of the season, tied for second-best in the American League and tied for eighth-most in baseball (tops among junior circuit shortstops)...the 2019 All-Star now has 68 multi-hit efforts since the beginning of last season, tied for third-most in the AL (T-4th MLB).
$\mp$ Polanco has three multi-hit games in his last six contests, going 9 -for-24 (.375) with two home
runs and a 1.048 OPS in that stretch.
A WELCOME RAIN: Josh Donaldson, who became the fourth hitter to homer into Target Field's Delta Sky $360^{\circ}$ Suite in the opener of yesterday's doubleheader and drew a key, pinch-hit walk during the Twins' tying rally in the nightcap, is 3 -for-7 (.429) with one double, one homer, three RBI and an 1.556 OPS in three games (two starts) since returning from the Injured List on September 2. $\Phi$ The Twins are $8-2(.800$ ) in Donaldson's 10 games this season ( $7-2$ when he starts).
