TIGER KINGS：The Twins beat the Tigers yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 6－2，taking four of five games from Detroit．．．Michael Pineda（1－0）made his second start of the season and earned the win，allowing two runs on just three hits in 7.0 innings pitched．．．the offense recorded 10 hits．．．Byron Buxton went 2－for－4 with a double（2）and a home run（6）and Ryan Jeffers hit his first career home run，a solo shot in the third inning off Michael Fulmer．．．Twins went 3－for－7 with runners in scoring position and left four men on base．

DOUBLE VISION：Twins are playing their fourth doubleheader this season．．．since the start of last season，the Twins are 8－4 in doubleheaders（4－2 in game one，4－2 in game two）．．．below are the DATE

ROTATIONAL PULL：Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 16－8，3．49 ERA（198．1 IP， 77 ER） with 22 home runs allowed， 66 walks， 183 strikeouts，a .225 batting－average－against and a .653 opponent OPS on the season．．．among all starting staffs in baseball，they rank tied for third in wins， fifth in ERA and BAA and third in OPS（Cardinals rank first in both BAA and OPS－． 192 and ． 625 respectively）．．．below are some notable numbers on the current Twins starting five：

Louis， $3-1$ vs．Pittsburgh and 4－2 vs．Milwaukee．．．Twins have a 750 IL winning percentage，best in the AL and second best in baseball，trailing only Los Angeles－NL（10－2，．833）．
$\Phi$ Remaining IL schedule（8 games）：two at St．Louis today．．．three at Wrigley Field September 18－ 20．．．three at home vs．Cincinnati September 25－27．．．Twins need two wins in those remaining games to have their first winning season against the National League since 2017 （13－7） which would also mark their second winning season in IL play since 2010.
玉 From 1997 （IL Play＇s inception）to 2009，the Twins went 132－96 in IL Play，second to only the Yankees（133－95）in wins during that span．．．since then they have gone 96－110，tied for

TWINS AND BIRDS：Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the third and fourth time this season．．．they swept the two－game series last time these two met at Target Field July 28 and 29，winning the first game 6－3 and the second game 3－0．．．Twins are 15－13 all－time against St．Louis in the regular season and 7－1 in their last eight．．．last time they played at Busch Stadium came May 7－8，2018，sweeping the two game series．．． they were 2－7 all－time in the regular season at the old Busch Stadium（1997－2001）and are 4－4 all－time at the new Busch Stadium（2006－18）．
STARTING TO GET OFFENSIVE：Twins are hitting ． 289 （ 66 －for－228）with 11 doubles，one triple，nine home runs， 20 walks，a 352 on－base per－ centage and an ． 817 OPS in their last seven games．．．they have recorded 10－plus hits in five of those games．．．they have the third most hits in the AL since September started．
ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY：In 2012，the Twins retired number 10 in honor of Tom Kelly as he joined Harmon Killebrew（3－1975），Rod Carew （29－1987），Tony Oliva（ $6-1991$ ），Kent Hrbek（14－1995），Kirby Puckett（34－1997）and Bert Blyleven（28－2011）as the seventh Twin，at the time（Mauer \＃7 in 2019），to have his number retired by the organization（the Twins，in conjunction with all of MLB，retired Jackie Robinson＇s No． 42 in 1997）．．．Kelly is the club＇s all－time leader in managerial wins with $1,140 \ldots$ he had a postseason record of 16－8，leading the Twins to two World Championships in 1987 over the St．Louis Cardinals and 1991 over the Atlanta Braves．
REST IN PEACE，LOU BROCK：Twins would like to send condolences to the Cardinals family on the passing of legend Lou Brock，who passed away on Sunday at the age of 81 ．．．Brock never faced the Twins，but spent one season as a member of the St．Cloud Rox when they were deemed a Class－C minor league squad for Chicago－NL in the Northern League．．．prior to the minor league realignment in 1963，Class－C teams were comparable to modern－day Single－A clubs．．．that year，across 128 games for the Rox，Brock hit ． 361 （ 181 －for－501）with 33 doubles， 14 home runs， 82 RBI and 38 stolen bases with his home ballpark just an hour north of Target Field．．．．other historical Rox alumni include Gaylord Perry（SFG，1958）and Orlando Cepeda（NYG，1956），while current Twins catcher Mitch Garver played for the club within its current affiliation with the Northwoods League．

- Today he makes his ninth start of the season and the 112th of his career.

Today's start will mark the 18th Interleague nod of his career and his third of the season...also will be his second career start against the Cardinals, and his first at Busch Stadium.


LAST TIME OUT: In his previous start, Berríos faced Chicago-AL at Target Field on September 2 in an 8-1 Twins win...Berríos garnered his third victory of the season after pitching 6.0 innings, allowing one earned run, walking two and striking out eight...José Abreu's RBI groundout in the third inning marked the only Chicago score on an otherwise-clean slate for Berríos...after his exit, relievers Jorge Alcala and Devin Smeltzer combined to blank the South Siders in the final three innings of the game, securing the win...in 16 total starts against the White Sox, Berríos now holds a 12-2 record with a 2.69 ERA (103.2 IP, 31 ER) and 24 walks against 109 strikeouts.

BERRÍOS AND THE CARDINALS: Berríos has made one start against the Cardinals in his career - a 7.1-inning gem on May 15, 2018 at Target Field...throughout his 7.1 innings, he held St. Louis to a single run on two hits with a walk and a hit batter...he struck out 10 hitters, making it one of nine career starts wherein he's reached double-digit punchouts...since his call-up in 2016, Berrios owns nine of the Twins' 17 double-digit-strikeout performances (59.2\%)...despite having just seven starts against the National League Central division, he has faced each of the member squads at least once... all-time, he's $3-3$ with a 4.34 ERA ( 37.1 IP, 18ER) against the cohort, with 16 walks and 34 strikeouts.

A TALE OF TWO HANDEDNESSES: In his career, Berríos has held right-handed hitters to a 250 batting average, and left-handed hitters to .239...this season, though, Berríos has seen a stark difference in his efficiency with regard to the two orientations...lefties are hitting just . 173 (13-for-75), with a . 300 OBP and .673 OPS...righties are hitting . 301 (25-for-83), with a 359 OBP and .768 OPS.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Traditionally, Berríos has preffered starting in his home ballpark, and 2020 has proved no different...in his career, he's 28-16 with a 3.52 ERA ( 322.1 IP, 126 ER) when working from him his home rubber, including 3-2 with a 2.67 ERA ( $27.0 \mathrm{IP}, 8$ ER) this season...away from Target Field, he's 18-21 all-time with a 4.92 ERA (316.1 IP, 173 ER), including 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 12 ER) in 2020.

AN INTERLEAGUE RUNDOWN: Berríos has started 17 games in Interleague Play, of which 10 have been quality starts...he's made seven starts against the NL Central, five starts against the NL East and five starts against the NL West...in total during Interleague Play, he owns an 8-8 record and a 3.49 ERA ( 98.0 IP, 38 ER) with 35 walks and 100 strikeouts...he's also holding National League opponents to a .194 batting average ( 68 -for-350).

BERRÍOS' WINNING WAYS: Berríos has 43 wins since the start of 2017, tied with Cleveland's Carlos Carrasco for third most in the American League, trailing Justin Verlander (DET/HOU, 53) and Charlie Morton (HOU/TB, 46)...league-wide in that span, 43 wins rank tied for ninth in the majors with Trevor Bauer (CLE/CIN), Rick Porcello (BOS/NYM) and Stephen Strasburg (WAS)... his 583 strikeouts rank seventh in the AL in that span, trailing Verlander (816), Chris Sale (BOS, 763), Gerrit Cole (HOU/NYY, 672), Morton (628), Bauer (602) and Carrasco (605).

PITCH MOVEMENT: In Berríos' first eight starts in 2019, he went 6-1 (7 QS), with a 2.53 ERA (53.1 IP, 15 ER), eight walks, 51 strikeouts, a .209 opponent batting average (41-for-196) and a . 618 opponent OPS...conversely, in his first eight starts this season, Berríos is 3-3 (3 QS) with a 4.29 ERA ( $42.0 \mathrm{IP}, 20 \mathrm{ER}$ ), 20 walks, 47 strikeouts, a 241 opponent batting average ( 38 -for-158) and a .722 opponent OPS.
