## TODAY'S PITCHERS

YESTERDAY'S RECAP: The Twins were shutout by the Rays yesterday afternoon at Hammond Stadium by a score of 0-2..Cody Stashak
make the start, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning...the Twins used a total of nine pitchers on the day...the offense recorded just four hits, all singles from Josh Donaldson, Max Kepler, Jorge Polanco and Miguel Sanó...the Twins will play one more spring home game on Tuesday vs. Pittsburgh, the club's final game of the 2021 exhibition season.

ROSTER/CAMP NUMBERS: Prior to yesterday afternoon's game, the Twins reassigned the following players to minor league camp: catcher Tomás Telis, infielders Tzu-Wei Lin and JT Riddle, and outfielders Keon Broxton and Rob Refsnyder...the Twins currently have 30 active players in camp (2 non-roster): 16 pitchers (2 non-roster), 3 catchers, 5 infielders, 5 outfielders and 1 designated hitter

CHAIRMAN'S CUP: Today marks the last of eight scheduled spring meetings between the Twins and Red Sox (one rain-out on March 6)... the Twins are 2-3-1 in the six "official" spring games vs. the Sox and could draw a tie for the 2021 Chairman's Cup with a in today.... loss today would give the Sox the Chairman's Cup for the spring...since the Chairman's Cup series began in 1993, the Twins have won The Cup 13 of the 27 years, but have won it just three times since 2007 (2011, 2016 and 2019)...the Twins and Sox will play during the regular season for four games at Target Field from April 12-15 and three games at Fenway Park from August 24-26.

ALL ABOUT ALCALA: Jorge Alcala is scheduled to make his eighth spring appearance today...he has posted five-straight scoreless outings ( 6.0 IP ) and has allowed just one earned run all spring (Austin Meadows home run March 7 vs. TB)...he is in his second spring training with Minnesota...began 2020 season on Minnesota Taxi Squad, recalled by Twins on August 1...recorded first major league win August 18 vs. Milwaukee, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings in a 4-3, 12 -inning Twins victory...held opponents scoreless in 11 of 16 appearances...threw 17 pitches at 99.0 mph -plus, the most on the team and 20 th in baseball...topped out at 100.7 in an at-bat vs. Tim Anderson (foul ball) September 2 vs. Chicago-AL...originally signed by Houston as an international free agent on December 3, 2014

BUCK HUNTER: Byron Buxton is 5 -for-34 (.147) with a double, a triple, a home run, five RBI and two walks in 13 spring games...he is in his eighth spring camp with the Twins...in 2020 made Twins Opening Day roster for fifth time in career in 2020 ...finished 16 th in American League MVP voting with two voting points - one ninth place vote...named 2020 Rawlings Gold Glove centerfield finalist, along with Oakland's Ramón Laureano, both losing out to Chicago-AL's Luis Robert....was the club leader in WAR at 2.1.

SUPER LU-TILITY: Luis Arraez has hit safely in five-straight spring games...he is hitting . 316 ( 12 -for-38) with five doubles, five RBI, four walks and a .395 OBP in 14 games this spring....he has led off in 12 of 14 games he has played (all except last 2 games) and has started at second base eight times, third base four times and leftfield twice...he is in his third spring training with the Twins...came up as a second baseman but with the signing of SS Andrelton Simmons, moving Jorge Polanco to second base, Arraez is excepted to be the club's utility player for the 2021 season....he has major league experience at second ( 80 G ), third $(17 \mathrm{G})$, short $(8 \mathrm{G})$ and leftfield ( 21 G ).
GARLICK'S ON IT: Kyle Garlick is looking to make his first career Opening Day roster...he is hitting . 314 (11-for-35) with one double, five home uns, 12 RBI and nine runs scored in 15 games this spring... his five home runs and tied for fourth best in the Grapefruit League, while his 12 RBl are tied for seventh...he is entering his sixth MLB spring training and first with Minnesota after making previous appearances with Los Angeles-NL (2016-19) and Philadelphia (2020)...began 2020 campaign at the Philadelphia alternate training site in Lehigh Valley after being DFA'd by Dodgers in February....appeared in 12 games for the Phillies, batting. 136 (3-for-22) with a double and three RBI...has appeared in 42 major league games, hitting . 214 (15-for-42) with eight extra-base hits and nine RBI...claimed off waivers by Minnesota February 11

THIS AND THAT ON JEFFERS: Catcher Ryan Jeffers is hitting . 259 (7-for-27) with a double, a home run and five RBI this spring...today marks his 11th start at catcher this spring...he is in his third spring training with the Twins...made major league debut August 20 vs. Milwaukee, catching and batting ninth...recorded an RBI single in first career plate appearance off Brandon Woodruff...became first Twin with a hit and RBI in first career plate appearance since Eddie Rosario May 6, 2015 vs. Oakland (first-pitch home run)...ranked third for most games caught amongst MLB rookies in 2020.

EYES ON OPENING DAY: After today's game, the Twins have two spring games remaining...they will play tomorrow in Bradenton against the Pirates and Tuesday at Hammond against the Pirates again..they open the season on Thursday with a three-game series in Milwaukee Maeda to start). . it will mark the Twins first time opening a season with Interleague Play and third time facing Milwaukee on Opening Day.
