THE TWINS: The Twins will open their 61st season with a three-game series at American Family Field in Milwaukee today through Sunday (off-day Friday)...today marks the third time in Twins history (since 1961) that they have opened against the Brewers ( 1971 \& ' 92 ) and second time in Milwaukee (1992)...following this series, the Twins will travel to Detroit to begin a three-same series vs. the
Tigers from Monday-Wednesday...the Twins went $24-7$ last season at home and 12-17 on the road. WRAP ON SPRING: The Twins finished their 31st Spring Training in Fort Myers, FL with a record of 11-15-2...Willians Astudillo led the club in hits (15) while Kyle Garlick led the club in home runs (5) the Twins drew 34586 over 14 penings for an average of 2043 -per-same their 22 ....adl was fourth in all of baseball and second in the Grapefruit League, trailing New York-AL $(35,215)$
2020 IN THE BLINK OF AN EYE: The Twins completed the 2020 regular season with a record of 36-24, winning the American League Central on September 27 after Iosing to Cincinnati while the White Sox also lost to the Cubs...the Twins went on to host Houston in the best-of-three AL Wild Card Series, getting swept in two games by scores of 1-4 and 1-3.
GRAND OPENING: The Twins opened last season vs. the White Sox at Guaranteed Rate Field, winning by a score of $10-5$, the start of what would be a $10-2$ stretch to begin the season... Minnesota is $27-33$ all-time in season openers and 16-21 in road openers...this marks the ninth time the Twins have opened on the road in the last 12 seasons, dating back to 2010.. they have won four of their last five openers and are looking to win three straight for the first time since winning four straight from 2001-04.
ROC SOLID: Rocco Baldelli is entering his third season as the skipper, and enters with a career managerial record of 137-85 (.617) following two consecutive AL Central Division titles... the 2019 AL Manager of the Year has amassed the best winning percentage in MLB history among managers with at least 200 career games...since 2019, Baldelli has led the Twins to the second-most wins in baseball, trailing only the reigning Los Angeles Dodgers (149-73).
ANOTHER YEAR OF NELLIE: Designated hitter Nelson Cruz was re-signed to a one-year contract on February $10 \ldots$ in 53 games for the Twins last season, he hit .303 ( 56 -for-185) with six doubles, 16 home runs, 33 RBI, 25 walks, a 397 on-base percentage, a .595 slugging percentage and a . 992 OPS....he finished third in the AL in OBP, fourth in OPS, fifth in SLG, tied for fifth in home runs and seventh in batting average...the 40-year-old finished sixth in American League MVP voting last season, totaling 128 voting points....he also earned his fourth Louisville Slugger® Silver Slugger Award, the Marvin Miller Award as part of the 2020 Players Choice Awards, the Twins Most Valuable Player Award, the Bob Allison Award (Twins leadership) and was named to the MLB All-Second Team as DH.
$\Phi$ Cruz entered today with 12 consecutive Opening Day starts and will have that streak snapped
this afternoon...he started each Opening Day since 2009: 2009-13 with Texas, 2014 with
Baltimore, 2015-18 with Seattle and 2019-20 with Minnesota...rankings in chart to the right
$\Phi$ Cruz's four Opening Day home runs are tied for second most among actives with Khris Davis, Evan Longoria, Yadier Molina, Mike Moustakas and Giancarlo Stanton, while trailing Bryce Harper (5) and Albert Pujols (5)...his nine Opening Day RBI are tied for seventh most玉 With Cruz on the bench, this will mark the first time the Twins have fielded an Opening Day lineup without a designated hitter since the position was established in 1973...the last Twins pitcher to bat for himself on Opening Day was Bert Blyleven in Oakland on April 15, 1972. BORDER BATTLE: The Twins are 235-226 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and are 69-57 against them in IL Play, since their move to the NL in '98...last season they went 4-2 against Milwaukee, going 2-1 at American Family Field from August 10-12 and 2-1 at Target move to the Au ins 18...20...during their last three-game series in Milwaukee, the Twins outscored the Brewers 20-10 and hit seven home runs. WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE: The Twins went 13-7 in Interleague Play last season, going 3-1 vs. St. Louis, 3-1 vs. Pittsburgh, 4-2 vs Milwaukee, $2-1$ vs. Chicago and 1-2 vs. Cincinnati.. 13 wins were tied for third-most IL wins in club history with their 2017 total, and trailing their 2006 total ( $16-2$ ) and 2008 total (14-4)...in 2020, they tied San Diego and Tampa Bay for second-most IL wins in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (16-4)...the Twins are 232-210 all-time in IL Play, the fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (263-180), New York-AL (259-183), Los Angeles-AL (243-201) and Oakland (238-206).
(ALMOST) CY-AEDA: Today's starter Kenta Maeda went 6-1, 2.70 ERA (66.2 IP, 20 ER) with 10 walks, 80 strikeouts, a 168 opponent batting average and a 0.75 WHIP in 11 starts for the Twins last season...finished first among AL pitchers in WHIP, second in opponent batting average and OPS (.508), fifth in ERA and seventh in strikeouts...after the season, he was named starting pitcher on the 2020 All-MLB Second Team...finished Second to Cleveland's Shane Bieber (unanimous) in AL Cy Young Award Voting with 92 total voting points ( 18 second place, 4 third place, 2 fourth place and 4 fifth place)...named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year.
A LOOK AT THE ROSTER: The Twins open the 2021 season with 10 players on their 26 -man roster who were not on the 2020 Opening Day roster: pitchers (6) - Jorge Alcala, Alex Colomé, J.A. Happ, Hansel Robles, Matt Shoemaker and Caleb Thielbar; catchers (2) - Wiliians Astudillo and Ryan Jeffers; infielders (1) - Andrelton Simmons; and outfielders (1) - Kyle Garlick...of the 26 players on the Twins active roster, 12 began their professional careers in the Twins organization...the Twins don't have any players looking to make their major league debut...the oldest on the club is Nelson Cruz ( 40 years, 9 months, 0 days) and the youngest is Ryan Jeffers ( 23 years, 9 months, 23 days).

REMEMBERING MIKE BELL: Twins bench coach Mike Bell passed away on Friday, March 26...Bell joined the Twins organization prior to the 2020 season; the 2021 campaign was to be his 29 th in professional baseball..... before coming to Minnesota, Bell spent the previous 13 years with Arizona's organization, serving as VP of Player Development (2017-19), Director of Player Development (2011-16), Minor League ield Coordinator (2010) and as a minor league manager for three seasons (2008-09 at Single-A Visalia and 2007 at Short-A Yakima).. Bell was selected by Texas in the first round of the 1993 First-Year Player Draft and played parts of 13 seasons (1993-2005) with seven organizations...he made major league debut on July 20, 2000 for the Cincinnati Reds and hit two homers with four RBI across 19 games. $\Phi$ The Twins will honor Bell with a sleeve patch for the 2021 season (seen bottom left).
$\Phi$ Kevin Morgan joins the staff as Major League Field Coordinator...Morgan spent one season as the club's Minor League Field Coordinator

## 2020: 6-1, 2.70 ERA CAREER: 53-36, 3.75 ERA

Making his first start of the season and his first career MLB Opening Day start....also marks his sixth career professional Opening Day start (2010-12, 2014-15 with the Hiroshima Toyo Carp of the Japan Central League).
$\Phi$ Making his 149th career appearance and 115th start.
$\Phi$ Becomes the sixth Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history to make an Opening Day start, first for the Twins...the others are: Masahiro Tanaka (4x), Hideo Nomo (3x), Yu Darvish (1x), Hiroko Kuroda (1x) and Daisuke Matsuzaka ( 1 x ).
$\Phi$ Including Maeda, Twins have had an Opening Day SP born outside the 50 states in five of the last six years (Maeda 2021, J. Berríos 2019-20, E. Santana 2016-17; not - J. Odorizzi 2018 - born in IL).

2020 NOTES: Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on February 10, 2020, Maeda made his mark in his first season in a Twins uniform by finishing second in the American League Cy Young Award balloting, winning the Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year and being named the SP on All-MLB Second Team...he also set several Twins single-season records.
$\Phi$ Began 2020 as Minnesota's No. 3 starter, making his Twins debut on July 26 at Guaranteed Rate Field against the White Sox....earned the win in a Twins victory, 14-2, after throwing 5.0 innings, allowing two earned runs on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts
Went 1-0, 3.60 ERA (5.0 IP, 2 ER) in one July start, 3-1, 2.39 ERA (37.2 IP, 10 ER) in six August starts and 2-0, 3.00 ERA ( $24.0 \mathrm{IP}, 8 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in four September starts.
क Held righties to a . 149 batting average ( 15 -for-101) and .484 OPS; lefties to .182 ( 25 -for137) with .5250 OPS.
$\Phi$ Picked up 150th career win as a professional in his final regular season start on September 23 vs. Detroit...went $97-67$ in Nippon Professional Baseball (2008-2015) and is $53-36$ in Major League Baseball (2016-present)
क At 168 ( 40 -for-238), finished with the lowest single-season opponent batting average as a starting pitcher in team history (min. 10 GS)...led club in strikeouts (80), starter ERA (2.70) and innings pitched (66.2), while ranking second in starts (11).
$\Phi$ Finished first among qualified American League pitchers in WHIP ( 0.75 ), second in opponent batting average and OPS (.508), fifth in ERA and seventh in strikeouts.
$\Phi$ Set a Twins/Senators franchise record for strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched at 10.80, passing Johan Santana's 2004 mark of 10.46.
$\mp$ Started Game 1 of AL Wild Card series vs. Houston September 29, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, three walks and five strikeouts in a Twins 4-1 defeat... his cap from the game was donated to the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum, since he threw the first official pitch of the adjusted playoff format.

SPRING RECAP: Went 0-0, 0.49 ERA ( $18.1 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{ER}$ ), one walk and 22 strikeouts in five Grapefruit League starts...yielded just one hit in his first 9.0 spring innings; lone blemish in that span was a solo homer allowed on March 20 vs. Tampa Bay (M. Brosseau)...led Twins in ERA (min. $9.0(P)$ and strikeouts.
AGAINST THE BREWERS: Owns a 3-2 record, 2.59 ERA ( 41.2 IP, 12 ER), 16 walks, 49 strikeouts and a 170 opponent batting average ( 25 -for-147) in seven career starts vs. Milwaukee... his opp. AVG against the Brewers is his lowest against any single opponent he's faced at least four times in his career.
$\boldsymbol{T}$ Last started at American Family Field Aug. 12, 2020, earning the win in a quality start (6.2 IP, 5 H, 2 R/ER, 1 BB, 5 K)...is 2-1, 2.70 ERA (16.2 IP, 5 ER), 6 BB, 18 K , 169 opp. AVG ( 10 -for-59) in 3 career GS here.
$\Phi$ On Aug. 18, 2020 at Target Field, Maeda recorded one of the best starts of his career, working eight no-hit innings before allowing a single (E. Sogard) to lead off the ninth....he also struck out 12 batters, one shy of his career high, and set a Twins record by fanning eight consecutive hitters from the third through fifth innings.

SENIOR CIRCUIT SHOWDOWN: Spent the first four seasons of his career in the National League with Los Angeles-NL and 121 of his 148 career games ( $82 \%$ ) have come against the Senior Circuit... he's $42-28,3.70$ ERA (528.0 IP, 217 ER) in those outings against the NL, which include 91 starts...Maeda is also 7-7, 4.22 ERA ( 102.1 IP , 48 ER ) in 22 career Interleague appearances (18 starts).
$\Phi$ Maeda went 1-0, 2.61 ERA ( $20.2 \mathrm{IP}, 6 \mathrm{ER}$ ), four walks and 21 strikeouts in three Interleague starts in 2020... his . 127 opponent batting average in IL Play led the AL and ranked second in the majors (min. 60 opp. AB), behind only Cincinnati's Trevor Bauer (.109).
NOT TOO HARD: Per Baseball Savant, Maeda's 24.7 hard hit percent in 2020 was the second lowest among qualified MLB pitchers, behind only Atlanta's Max Fried (23.8)...held opponents to an 85.3 average exit velocity, fourth lowest among qualifiers last season.
$\Phi$ According to Fangraphs, Maeda's 28.5 soft contact percent in 2020 also led qualified pitchers...since 2018, his 21.8 soft contact percent is fourth best in baseball (min. 300.0 IP), behind only Noah Syndergaard (23.2), Jacob deGrom (22.8) and Chris Sale (22.0).

KENTA, THE HITTER: Maeda is a career . 153 (27-for-176) hitter with four doubles, one home run, 14 RBI , one walk, 10 runs scored and 34 sacrifice hits.
玉 Hit a solo home run, his lone career homer, in his second career at-bat in his major league debut on April 6, 2016
$\Phi$ "He gets really amped up and he's got a good swing." - Manager Rocco Baldelli, on Maeda.
KENTA, THE ARTIST: While Maeda's pitching style might be described as artful, so is his penchant for drawing...is famous in Japan for his inability to draw and sells apparel with his drawings on it...full proceeds benefit various charities in Japan, including benefitting first responders and medical personnel fighting the COVID-19 pandemic...manager Rocco Baldelli admitted recently that he owns a piece of clothing with a Maeda masterpiece on it.

- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18,2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight straight K's. the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight straight K's. - Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins
(2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12)
- Enters 2020 with the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- 16 wins in 2016 were the second most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
- Named to the 2016 Baseball America Major League All-Rookie Team, and finished third in the NL Rookie of the Year voting.
- Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings in his major league debut, also hitting a solo home run in his second career at-bat.
