**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 1-2 through three games on their seven-game homestand, losing the three-game series to the Mariners over the weekend...today they will begin a four-game series with Boston through Thursday — all afternoon games...the Twins are 1-2 at home this season and 4-2 on the road.

**NINTH INNING UNKIND TO COLOMÉ:** The Twins lost to the Mariners yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-8, allowing all of Seattle's runs from the sixth inning on...Matt Shoemaker was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings pitched with one walk and seven strikeouts prior to being ejected from the game...Alex Colomé blew his second save, allowing a three-run home run to Kyle Seager in the ninth inning...the offense recorded eight hits, three from Byron Buxton, who fell a triple short of the cycle and hit his fifth home run of the season...the Twins drew another sellout crowd with 9,782 in attendance.

**ROTATIONAL PULL:** Twins starters have combined to go 5-0, 2.44 ERA (48.0 IP, 13 ER) with 12 walks, 58 strikeouts, seven home runs allowed, a 1.06 WHIP and a .218 opponent batting average and .651 OPS through eight games...below is an individual breakdown:

**WORTH NOTING:** Nelson Cruz (25.0%) and Byron Buxton (22.6%) rank first and second in baseball in barrels-per-plate appearance percentage, ahead of Shohei Ohtani (19.4%) and J.D. Martinez (18.4%).

**A STREAKING BUCK:** Buxton has hit safely in all eight games this season and is one of six players in baseball to hit safely in each of their games played (minimum 8 games)...his eight game hitting streak is the second longest of his career, trailing his career-high of 12, done August 10-21, 2017...his current streak marks the Twins' longest streak to start a season since Brian Dozier hit safely in the first 17 of 2018...the Twins/Senators franchise best (since 1901) is held by Sam Rice, who hit safely in the first 28 of 1930.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins and Red Sox are playing the first of seven meetings in 2021...they will play three game at Fenway Park from August 24-26...these teams met six times in 2019, as the Twins went 1-2 at Target Field June 17-19 and 2-1 at Fenway from September 3-5.  
 ☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .295 (104-for-353) with 21 doubles, 23 home runs, 65 RBI, 40 walks, a .368 on-base percentage and a .935 OPS in 93 career games vs. the Red Sox.  
 ☞ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .336 (37-for-110) with six doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, 10 walks and a .390 on-base percentage in 30 career games vs. the Red Sox.  
 ☞ Today's Sox starter, Martín Pérez, pitched in 32 games (29 starts) for the Twins in 2019, going 10-7, 5.12 ERA (165.1 IP, 94 ER) with 67 walks and 135 strikeouts...he started that season 7-1, 2.95 ERA (58.0 IP, 19 ER) in his first 11 games (8 starts).

**LEFTY AFTER LEFTY AFTER LEFTY:** The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the fourth time in their last five games...last season the Twins hit .236 (123-for-521) against left-handed pitching with a .309 on-base percentage, a .349 slugging percentage and a .658 OPS...they ranked 28th in slugging, 27th in OPS, and 21st in both average and OBP.  
 ☞ Through nine games this season they are hitting .310 (36-for-100) with nine doubles, three home runs, seven walks and a .854 OPS against lefties...they rank third in baseball in batting average and fourth in OPS.  
 ☞ Notables vs. lefties this season: Kyle Garlick is 5-for-9 (.556), Nelson Cruz is 6-for-11 (.545), Byron Buxton is 5-for-10 (.500), Andrelton Simmons is 4-for-9 (.444).

**CRUZ CONTROL:** Nelson Cruz has hit safely in each of his last six games, hitting .440 (11-for-25) with one double, four home runs, nine RBI, three walks, a .483 on-base percentage, a .960 slugging percentage and a 1.443 OPS in that span...he has driven in 10 runs overall this season, which is tied for fourth in the American League and tied for sixth in baseball.

**DONALDSON UPDATE:** Josh Donaldson (right hamstring strain) played five defensive innings at the alternate training site in St. Paul yesterday afternoon in an intersquad game...he also took six at-bats and reported no medical issues.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2010, the Twins played their first ever game at Target Field, hosting the Boston Red Sox and winning 5-2...Carl Pavano was the starter and winner while Jon Rauch earned the save...Joe Mauer went 3-for-5 with two RBI and Jason Kubel went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI.

### THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ The staff has 97 strikeouts, the most through the first nine games of the season in Twins/Senators history...the staff's walk total (20) is tied for seventh fewest, with 1968 and 2003.
- ☞ The Twins have 13 home runs this season, tied for third-most in the AL and tied for sixth-most in baseball.
- ☞ The Twins have struck out 99 times on the season, the second-most in baseball, trailing Baltimore (111).
- ☞ Twins are 4-for-5 (.800) in 2-0 counts, 8-for-18 (.444) in 2-1 counts and 3-for-7 (.429) in 3-1 counts.
- ☞ Twins are hitting .342 (13-for-38) from the leadoff spot in the order, sixth best in baseball... .444 OBP - fifth best in baseball.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his season debut last Tuesday, April 6 in Detroit...did not factor into the decision in a 3-4 Twins loss...yielded one run on three hits in 4.0 innings, with three walks and four strikeouts, and threw 89 pitches...held opposing hitters to 2-for-11 (.182) with runners on base.

**RIGHTEOUS AGAINST THE RED SOX:** Is 13-4, 2.79 ERA (154.2 IP, 48 ER), 57 walks, 125 strikeouts, a .216 BAA (122-for-565) in 27 games (26 starts) against the Red Sox...in the 2020 regional-based schedules, started against Boston twice and went 2-0, 0.66 ERA (13.2 IP, 1 ER), .149 BAA (7-for-47), two walks and 12 strikeouts.

☞ **Happ's 13 career wins over the Red Sox are his most against any single opponent in his career...**today marks his 28th appearance and 27th start vs. Boston, breaking a tie with his totals against Baltimore for his most against any opponent...his 125 strikeouts vs. the Red Sox are his second most against any opponent, behind only his 149 strikeouts against the Orioles.

**BEAST AGAINST THE EAST:** In 2020 for New York-AL, went 2-1, 2.48 ERA (29.0 IP, 8 ER), six walks, 29 strikeouts and a .192 BAA (20-for-104) in five starts against the AL East...is 38-22, 3.54 ERA (551.0 IP, 217 ER) in 100 career games (96 starts) vs. the division.

☞ Owns 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP, 3 ER), two walks, 24 strikeouts and a .186 BAA (13-for-70) across his last three starts against the AL East, since September 8, 2020.

**RISP AND NO REWARD:** Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

☞ In his first start of 2021, Happ held opposing hitters to 1-for-5 with runners in scoring position...opponents also went just 2-for-11 (.182) with runners on base.

**A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB:** Today marks Happ's 300th career start...he's the ninth active pitcher to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (461), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (423), Max Scherzer (369), Clayton Kershaw (356), Adam Wainwright (328), David Price (311) and Johnny Cueto (310).

**PITCH SELECTION:** After featuring five pitches last season, Happ has shown four offerings to hitters so far this season...here is Happ's 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

**SPRING RECAP:** Missed the start of spring training due to COVID-19...went 1-1, 9.35 ERA (8.2 IP, 9 ER) with three walks and seven strikeouts in three games (2 GS) in spring play...cleared to return to action and made his first official Grapefruit League appearance on March 15 at Atlanta, starting and working 2.0 scoreless innings...yielded just one hit and two walks, while striking out one batter, in the outing...earned the win in his next start March 21 at Baltimore, despite allowing five runs (four earned) on six hits in 3.0 innings...last pitched on March 26 vs. Atlanta (L, 3.2 IP, 10 H, 6 R/5 ER, 1 BB, 4 K).

2020 NOTES:

- ☞ Spent third season with New York-AL, his second full season with the Yankees.
- ☞ Made the start in the Yankees' fifth game on July 30 at Baltimore, his first of nine starts on the season.
- ☞ Set season-high in strikeouts on September 8 at Toronto, fanning 10 batters in 6.1 innings...marked his 11th career double-digit strikeout game and sixth on the road...also marked his third career start of at least 10 strikeouts in less than 7.0 innings.
- ☞ Set season high in innings pitched on September 19 at Boston, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, no walks and nine strikeouts...marked just his third career start with no walks in at least 8.0 innings.
- ☞ Did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- ☞ Ranked second on club in innings pitched (49.1) and fourth in strikeouts (42).
- ☞ Led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655).
- ☞ Appeared in relief in Game 2 of the American League Division Series on October 6 vs. Tampa Bay and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on five hits in 2.2 innings pitched.
- ☞ Signed a one-year deal with Minnesota on January 22, 2021.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP KENTA MAEDA (2021 SEASON: 1-0, 2.61 ERA // CAREER: 54-36, 3.73 ERA)

Maeda is due to start the second game of this series against the Red Sox tomorrow afternoon - will mark his first home start of the season...earned his first win of the season in his last start last Wednesday in Detroit...recorded a quality start, working 6.0 innings and yielding two runs on seven hits (one home run), with one walk and six strikeouts...five of his last seven starts have been quality, dating back to August 30, 2020...has faced Boston just once before, in a start on July 12, 2019 at Fenway Park...took the loss (1-8) despite allowing just three runs on four hits (2 HR), with one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.2 innings...is 1-2, 5.32 ERA (23.2 IP, 14 ER), 10 walks, 29 strikeouts and a .225 BAA (20-for-89) in six career games (4 GS) against the AL East.

- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
