TWINS SWEPT ON THE DAY: The Twins lost both games of the doubleheader with the Red Sox yesterday afternoon by scores of 2-3 and 1-7...it marked the club's first time being swept in doubleheader since August 29,2020 at Detroit and first time at Target Field since June 17, 2017 vs. Cleveland...Kenta Maeda started game one, allowing three runs (2 earned) on seven hits in 4.1 innings pitched and was deatt the loss...José Berríos started game two and allowed four runs on four hits in 4.1 innings pitched and was also dealt the loss...the offense
went 10 -for-50 on the day with just two extra-base hits (2 doubles)...they also went 1 -for-16 with runners in scoring position and left 11 men on base on the day.

$\mathrm{P}, 4 \mathrm{ER}$ ) with two walks and 12 strikeouts.
STREAKING BUX: Byron Buxton has hit safely in all nine games this season and is one of two players (C. Mullins - 11) in baseball to hit safely in each of their games played (minimum 9 games)...his nine-game hitting streak is the second longest of his career, trailing his career-high of 12 , done August 1h-21, $2 /$ S...his current streak marks the Twins longest streak to start a season since Brian Dozier hit
safely in the first 17 of 2018...the Twins/Senators franchise best (since 1901) is held by Sam Rice, who hit safely in the first 28 of 1930 .

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and Red Sox are playing the fourth of seven meetings in 2021...they will play three games at Fenway Park from August $24-26 \ldots$ wins are 3 14-319 all-time against the Red Sox, going 180-136 in Minnesota $13-20$ at larget Field)
I Nelson Cruz is hitting . 296 (106-for-358) with 22 doubles, 23 home runs, 65 RBI, 40 walks, a .370 on-base percentage and a .937 OPS in 95 career games vs. the Red Sox.
CRUZ CONTROL: Nelson Cruz enters today with a nine-game hitting streak, batting . 452 ( 14 -for- 31 ) with two doubles, four home runs 10 RBI, three walks, a 486 on-base percentage, a . 903 slugging percentage and a 1.390 OPS in that span...he has driven in 10 runs overall'this season, which is tied for 10th in the American League.
JACKIE ROBINSON DAY: As has been tradition each season since 2004, MLB and Clubs are commemorating Jackie Robinson Day at ballparks throughout the league today - the anniversary of Robinson's historic MLLB debut as he broke baseball's color barrier - or Friday April 16...the extra day allows for teams not playing on a traditional "off-day" of the regular season to appropriately commemorate Jackie Robinson Day...Angels have an off-day today so the Twins will join them in wearing number 42 in Anaheim again tomorrow night. on-field details include:

LAST TIME OUT：Pineda made his 2021 Target Field debut last Saturday vs．Seattle，turning in a quality start in the Mariners＇eventual $4-3,10$－inning victory．．．limited the Mariners to a pair of solo home runs among four hits over 6.0 innings，with no walks and six strikeouts．．．departed after 75 pitches，with the game tied 2－2．
क Marked his 15th career start of at least 6.0 innings without a walk and six－or－more strike－ outs．．．was his fifth such effort allowing four－or－fewer hits and two－or－fewer earned runs． $\boldsymbol{\Phi}$ Was Pineda＇s 76 th career quality start，and his 16 th with the Twins（in 33 trips to the hill）．

STRONG SEASON DEBUT：＂Big Mike＂opened his 2021 campaign by pitching the Twins to an 8－2，rubber－game victory at Milwaukee on April 4．．．worked in－and－out of trouble，stranding six baserunners and allowing just one unearned run on four hits over 5.0 innings（2 BB， 5 S0）．．． departed with a 2－1 lead，before Minnesota tacked on six runs against the Brewers＇bullpen．

MICHAEL PINEDA，STOPPER：Looking to snap a five－game losing streak，the Twins are giving the ball to the right pitcher in Michael Pineda．．．Big Mike has started 15 times following a Minnesota loss since 2019，with the Twins going 14－1 in those outings．．．personally，Pineda is 8－1，3．00 ERA（84．0 IP， 28 ER）
玉 Last season，Minnesota went 4－0 when Pineda started the next game following a Twins loss．
BIG MIKE，BIG PERFORMANCES：Pineda enters this afternoon＇s start on a career－high winning streak that began July 26，2019，as he is 8－0，2．94 ERA（79．2 IP， 26 ER）， 16 walks and 81 strike－ outs over his last 14 starts．．．his last loss came July 16， 2019 at Target Field vs．New York－NL． T Going back even further，since June 29，2019，Big Mike is 10－1，2．80 ERA（103．0 IP， 32 ER）， 23 walks， 109 strikeouts and a ．232／．277／．361 opponents＇slash line in his last 18 starts
（11 quality starts）．．．Minnesota is 14－4（．778）in those games．
FOUR BELOW：When Pineda throws the first pitch of today＇s contest，he will do so with a career ERA under 4.00 （3．99）for the first time since he took the mound at Yankee Stadium on June 25， 2017 （3．94）．．．he surrendered seven runs in 4.0 innings that afternoon to the Texas Rangers， raising his career ERA to 4.01 ．
玉 Big Mike made two more starts in 2017 before landing on the Injured List on July 14 and undergoing Tommy John surgery on July 18.
玉 His ERA reached 4.16 following a June 7， 2019 start（the highest it had been since 4.50 after his MLB debut）．．．since then，he has fashioned a 2.93 mark（ $119.2 \mathrm{IP}, 39 \mathrm{ER}$ ）over 21 starts．

MINNESOTA MIKE：Big Mike has made 33 starts in a Minnesota uniform，going 14－5，3．77 ERA （183．2 IP， 77 ER）．．．the Twins are 22－11（．667）when he toes the rubber．
\＄Pineda has a 4.76 strikeout－to－walk ratio since 2019，along with a 1.15 WHIP．．．those stats， along with his ERA，are all better than his career numbers（4．45， 1.18 and 3．99）．
$\Phi$ His 3．8 WAR（per Fangraphs）since 2019 is 14th among AL starters（min． 180.0 IP）
HOME COOKING：Pineda takes the mound this afternoon for his 19th start at Target Field as a member of the Twins．．．over his first 18 outings，he has gone 4－3，3．86 ERA（100．1 IP， 43 ER）， while Minnesota is 11－7．

BOSTON BANTER：Today marks Pineda＇s 14th career start vs．the Red Sox，his second with the Twins．．．in his previous 13 outings，he is 5－5， 4.00 ERA（72．0 IP， 32 ER）
$\boldsymbol{\Phi}$ Made one start against Boston in 2019，allowing one run on five hits over 6.0 innings（ 1 BB ， 5 SO）on June 18 at Target Field，opposite David Price．．．．departed the game tied at 1－1，a contest the Twins eventually won，4－3 in 17 innings．．．Max Kepler homered to tie the game 3－3 in the 13th，then delivered the walk－off single to end the 5－hour，45－minute marathon．

NOT FOOLING AROUND IN APRIL：Pineda has made more starts（31）and has posted more victories（16）in April than any other month of his career．．．he is 16－9，3．88 ERA（174．0 IP， 75 ER）lifetime in the traditional season－opening month，while his ERA is second only to his 3.18 career mark in September（ $152.2 \mathrm{IP}, 54$ ER）．

SIX EQUALS SUCCESS：In his last start，Pineda worked 6.0 innings for the first time in 2021 and the 16th time in 33 outings with the Twins．．．in 91 career starts of at least 6.0 frames，Big Mike is 45－21，2．88 ERA（581．1 IP， 186 ER），while his teams are 56－35．
玉 In his 16 Minnesota starts of 6．0－or－more innings，he is 9－1，2．97 ERA（106．0 IP， 35 ER）．．． the Twins are 11－6 when he completes six
