THE TWINS: After going 0-4 on their last roadtrip (0-1 in Anaheim and 0-3 in Oakland), the Twins began their weekend home series with a victory over the Pirates last night...today they will play the middle game of this three-game series...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Cleveland for a short three-game roadtrip at Progressive Field from Monday-Wednesday... the Twins are 3-5 at home this season and 4-6 on the road.

HERE'S WHAT HAPP-ENED: The Twins beat the Pirates last night by a score of 2-0 at Target Field, their second shutout of the season (also, April 3 at Milwaukee)...J.A. Happ was the starter and winner, carrying a no-hitter through 7.1 innings pitched...he combined with Tyler Duffey ( 1.0 IP ) and Taylor Rogers ( 0.2 IP ) to throw the 19th one-hitter in Twins history....marked the second one-hitter for the Twins this season, the previous coming April 3 at Milwaukee (Berríos, Rogers, Duffey, Colomé)...second time in club history to have two one-hitters in a season, the other coming in 1973 (Blyleven twice and Kaat once)...the offense was provided by Willians Astudillo and Jake Cave, who each hit solo home runs.

THE STARTING FIVE: Twins starting pitchers have gone 6-4, 3.56 ERA (91.0 IP, 36 ER) with 27 walks, 88 strikeouts, a 224 opponent batting average and a .677 opponent OPS...among AL starting staffs, they rank second in ERA, fourth in opponent BA, and fifth in OPS and strikeouts-per-walk (3.26).

MORE ON BUCK: Byron Buxton has hit safely in 12 of 13 games played this season and has homered in six of those 13 ...he enters today leading all of baseball (minimum 50 plate appearances) in slugging percentage (.936), OPS (1.407) and isolated power (.511)...additionally, he ranks second in batting average (.426), trailing only Chicago-AL's Yermín Mercedes (.429)

NATIONAL TREASURE: The Twins have gone 3-1 in Interleague Play this season, taking a three-game series in Milwaukee to start the season and one game against Pittsburgh last night... after this series, their IL schedule is as follows: two vs. Cincinnati June 21-22, three at St. Louis July 30-August 1, two at Cincinnati August 3-4, three vs. Milwaukee August 27-29, two vs. Chicago-NL August 31-September 1 and two at Chicago-NL September 14-15.
$\Phi$ Twins are 235-211 all-time in IL Play, the fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (263-180), New York-AL (260-184), Los Ange-les-AL (243-201) and 0akland (241-208).
क Josh Donaldson is hitting . 313 (152-for-485) with 27 doubles, 31 home runs, 97 RBI, 98 runs scored and a . 969 OPS in 131 career IL games...in his last 13 IL games, he is hitting .400 ( 16 -for-40) with a 1.243 OPS, six doubles, three home runs and 13 RBI.
$\mp$ Nelson Cruz is hitting. 280 (196-for-700) with 30 doubles, 52 home runs, 146 RBI and a .9120 OS in 198 career Interleague games. among actives, he ranks third in homers (Pujols - 66, Cabrera - 57) and RBI (Pujols - 229, Cabrera - 200).
TWINS AND BUCS: The Twins are 23-14 all-time against the Pirates, going 2-4 at Three Rivers Stadium, 8-4 at the Metrodome, 8-4 at PNC Park and 5-2 at Target Field...the Twins have won seven of their last eight games vs. Pittsburgh, dating back to April of 2018.
$\Phi$ Outfielder Alex Kirilloff attended Plum High School in Pittsburgh, located approximately 18 miles east of PNC Park, and grew up a
Pirates fan; his favorite player was Andrew McCutchen.
क Reliever Randy Dobnak grew up in South Park Township, approximately 14 miles south of PNC Park.
BRINGER OF OFFENSE: Josh Donaldson has hit safely in six of seven games he has played this season, hitting . 476 ( 10 -for-21) with one double, one home run, three RBI, two walks and a 1.188 OPS.... in fact, in his last 22 games, dating back to September 8, 2020, he is hitting 313 (21-for-67) with five home runs, nine RBI, 12 walks, a .425 on-base percentage and a .992 OPS.

GRIDIRON GLORY: Director of Team Security and Football Coach at Minneapolis North Community High School, Charles Adams III, has been named Positive Coaching Alliance's 2021 Coach of the Year....out of over 600 nominations, Adams was one of 25 national recipients of the Double-Goal Coach $®$ award presented by TeamSnap, named for coaches who strive to win while also pursuing the more important goal of teaching life lessons through sports...thanks to the generosity of the Taube Family Foundation, Adams will receive the $\$ 10,000$ Taube Family Prize in Recognition of Excellence in Coaching... $\$ 2,500$ will go directly to Adams and $\$ 7,500$ will go to the Minneapolis North Community High School Football Program...Adams and the other 24 National Winners, in addition to the 75 Regional Winners, were all recognized on Sunday, April 18th at PCA's first-ever virtual National Youth Sports Awards and Benefit.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1996, Greg Myers and Paul Molitor each recorded five RBI as the Twins set a team record for runs and beat the Detroit Tigers, 24-11...it was the highest run total against the Tigers in 84 years, matching the mark set in a $24-2$ loss to the Philadelphia Athletics on May 18, 1912, in a game in which Detroit did not have its regulars due to a players strike... in 2018, Joe Mauer played in his 1,748 th career game, passing Kent Hrbek and moving into sole possession of third on the Twins all-time list (since 1961)

LAST TIME OUT: Pineda turned in arguably his finest start in a Twins uniform, holding Boston to a pair of singles (one infield hit) over 7.0 -shutout innings, with one walk and six strikeouts, in Minnesota's eventual 4-3, walk-off victory April 15.
क Allowed a single to Kiké Hernández leading off the game, then retired 14 straight before a two-out walk in the fifth...only other blemish was an infield single by Xander Bogaerts leading off the seventh.
क Departed with a 3-0 lead, only to have the Red Sox rally against the Twins bullpen for three runs in the eighth...Max Kepler delivered the walk-off, RBI-single with one out in the ninth.
क Marked his ninth career start of at least 7.0 innings and no earned runs, his first since June 8, 2017 (also against Boston, as a member of the New York Yankees).
$\Phi$ Was his third career effort of at least 7.0 innings, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and no earned runs... others were May 21, 2011 at San Diego, with Seattle (7.0 IP, 2 H, 1 BB, 9 SO) and September 22, 2014 vs. Baltimore, with New York-AL (7.1 IP, 1 H, 1 BB, 6 SO)

A LOOK AT THE LEADERBOARD: Entering today's start, Pineda ranks among the early-season American League leaders for: WHIP (2nd at 0.72), opponents' OPS (3rd at .464), opponents' batting average (3rd at .159, 10-for-63), ERA (4th at 1.00), opponents' slugging percentage (6th at .270) and Fangraphs WAR (18th at 0.4).

A HOT START: Pineda has been Minnesota's most consistently effective starting pitcher through the season's first month....beyond the leaderboard, some additional context:

Big Mike has allowed a run in only two of his 18.0 innings thus far (unearned run in the 2nd inning April 4 at Milwaukee and a pair of solo home runs in the 3rd inning April 10 vs. Seattle), while he carries a 10.0 -inning scoreless streak into today's start

* Pineda has had only four innings where a runner has reached second base, including the twohomer inning by the Mariners.... the lone hit failing to plate a run.

BIG MIKE, BIG PERFORMANCES: Pineda enters today's start on a career-high winning streak that began July 26, 2019, as he is 8-0, 2.70 ERA ( 86.2 IP, 26 ER), 17 walks and 87 strikeouts over his last 15 starts (.225/.266/.346 opponents' slash line)...his last loss came July 16, 2019 at Target Field vs. New York-NL
$\Phi$ Going back even further, since June 29, 2019, "Big Mike" is 10-1, 2.62 ERA (110.0 IP, 32 ER), 24 walks, 115 strikeouts and a .224/.269/.346 opponents' slash line in his last 19 starts ( 11 quality starts)...Minnesota is 15-4 (.789) in those games.
MINNESOTA MIKE: Big Mike has made 34 starts in a Minnesota uniform, going 14-5, 3.63 ERA (190.2
IP, 77 ER)...the Twins are 23-11 (.676) when he toes the rubber
T Pineda has a 4.79 strikeout-to-walk ratio since 2019, along with a 1.12 WHIP...those stats, along with his ERA, are all better than his career numbers (4.46, 1.17 and 3.96)
$\Phi$ His 4.1 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 13th among AL starters (min. 190.0 IP).
HOME COOKING: Pineda takes the mound this afternoon for his 20th start at Target Field as a member of the Twins....over his first 19 outings, he has gone 4-3, 3.61 ERA (107.1 IP, 43 ER), while Minnesota is 12-7 (.632).
I Including today, seven of Pineda's last nine starts have come here at home (4 of his 5 efforts in the 2020 season, and 3 of his first 4 in 2021).
A RARE PIRATE ENCOUNTER: Pineda has made just one career start vs. Pittsburgh, which came in an eventual 11-5 victory for the New York Yankees at PNC Park on April 22, 2017...did not factor in the decision after allowing three runs (all earned) on five hits over 5.0 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts.
ד Adam Frazier and Gregory Polanco are the lone Pirates from that day's starting lineup still with the Bucs...Frazier, hitting leadoff, went 1-for-2 with a walk off Pineda, while Polanco was 0-for-3 with a strikeout from the cleanup spot.

NOT FOOLING AROUND IN APRIL: Pineda has made more starts (32) and has posted more victories (16) in April than any other month of his career...he is 16-9, 3.73 ERA (181.0 IP, 75 ER) lifetime in the traditional season-opening month, while his ERA is second only to his 3.18 career mark in September (152.2 IP, 54 ER).

SIX EQUALS SUCCESS: Big Mike has put together consecutive starts of at least 6.0 innings for the fifth time as a Twin....he had a run of four-straight such starts May 11-27, 2019, three from June 29-July 16, 2019, back-to-back outings July 26 and August 1, 2019 and a run of four-consecutive spanning his final two starts of 2019 (September 1 and 6) and his first two of 2020 (September 1 and 7).
क In 92 career starts of at least 6.0 frames, Pineda is 45-21, 2.85 ERA (588.1 IP, 186 ER).
क In his 18 Minnesota starts of 6.0-or-more innings, he is 9-1, 2.79 ERA (113.0 IP, 35 ER)...the Twins are 12-6 when he completes six.

Reinstated from Restricted List September 1 after missing the Twins' first 36 games, serving his suspension after violating MLB's Joint Drug Prevention and Treatment Program.
क Held right-handed batters to a . 184 batting average (9-for-49); lefties hit . 308 (16-for-52)

- Per Fangraphs, Pineda tied for second among AL starters with a 1.1 WAR in September, matching New York-AL's Gerrit Cole and trailing only Kansas City rookie Brady Singer (1.2).
क The Twins went 5-0 in Pineda's starts, as he played a key role in Minnesota going 16-8 over the season's final month, erasing a 2.5 -game deficit and valuting from third place to repeat as AL Central Division champions.

- Missed last 21 games of 2019, the entire ALDS and the first 36 contests of 2020 due to a 60game suspension for violating MLB's Joint Drug and Prevention Treatment Program.
- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...also missed the entire 2012 campaign with New York-AL recovering from right shoulder surgery, and was out of the majors in 2013 while rehabbing.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded $200+$ strikeouts in American League history.
Was an AL AII-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 303 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER ) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of . 198 in the first half, and finished the
year tifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting,
- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007)
Was signed by Seattle as a 16 -year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005...signed by Patrick Guerrer

IN CONTROL: Pineda enters today's start ranked third among American League starters by pouring in a first-pitch strike 73.1 percent of the time...he is seventh with a 5.67 strikeout to-walk ratio and 10th with an average of 1.50 walks per 9.0 innings.
FLAILING AWAY: Pineda has induced hitters to swing at pitches outside the zone 36.4 percent of the time, good for sixth best among AL starters...his chase rate ranks in the 94th percentile among all major league pitchers
$\Phi$ He also ranks ninth among AL starters with a soft contact percentage of 21.3
2021 ARSENAL: Below is a breakdown of Pineda's 2021 three-pitch repertoire, according to Baseball Savant, which follows similar to what he featured in 2020
$\Phi$ His slider usage (33.2\%) leads AL starters, and with good reason: it has produced a 143 opponents' batting avg. (3-for-21) and a . 223 WOBA, an 84.9 MPH avg. exit velocity (with a -1 avg. launch angle) and a $37.8 \%$ whiff rate.
