**THE TWINS:** The Twins opened their 61st season with a loss to the Brewers in Milwaukee on Thursday afternoon...tonight they will continue their three-game series at American Family Field in Milwaukee with the second of three games...following tomorrow afternoon's finale, the Twins will travel to Detroit to begin a three-game series vs. the Tigers with all 12:10 p.m. (CT) first pitches...the Twins went 24-7 at home last season and 12-17 on the road.

**OPENING DAY...NOT THE WAY YOU DRAW IT UP:** The Twins lost to the Brewers on Opening Day by a score of 5-6 in 10 innings, blowing a 5-2 lead in the ninth...Milwaukee walked off on an Orlando Arcia fielder's choice infield chopper, scoring Lorenzo Cain with nobody out in the 10th...it marked the third time in the Twins' last six Opening Days to lose on a walk-off, first since an Adam Jones 11th inning homer off Fernando Rodney March 29, 2018 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...Kenta Maeda was the starter, allowing two runs (1 earned) on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits, highlighted by a Byron Buxton two-run seventh-inning homer...Max Kepler added three hits, falling a home run short of the cycle.  
 ☞ Thursday marked the second time in Twins/Senators franchise history (since 1901) that they have allowed five unearned runs on Opening Day...the other was April 12, 1911 vs. Boston.  
 ☞ It marked the 10th time in club history the Twins went into extra innings on Opening Day.  
 ☞ Nelson Cruz did not start, snapping his consecutive Opening Day starts streak at 12.

**BORDER BATTLE:** The Twins are 235-227 all-time against the Brewers (games since 1970) and are 62-53 against them in IL Play, since their move to the NL in '98...the Twins are looking to avoid losing the series tonight, which would mark their first series loss in Milwaukee since getting swept in three games here in 2018...in 2020, the Twins went 13-5-2 in series play and did not lose their first series until their sixth series (3-game sweep in Kansas City).  
 ☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .325 (26-for-80) with 15 RBI and a .375 on-base percentage in 20 career games vs. the Brewers...has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 vs. Milwaukee and in 16 of 20 overall.  
 ☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .371 (13-for-35) with one double, two home runs, eight RBI, eight walks, a .488 on-base percentage and a 1.060 OPS in 12 career games vs. Milwaukee...he is hitting .440 (11-for-25) with a .500 OBP and 1.100 OPS at American Family Field (7 games).  
 ☞ Miguel Sanó has hit safely in nine straight games at American Family Field...he is tied with Brian Dozier (May 18, 2012-June 27, 2015) for third-longest Twins streak in this ballpark, trailing Justin Morneau (13 - June 22, 2003-June 23, 2009) and Torii Hunter (11 - June 14, 2002-June 25, 2005)...in 17 career games against MIL, he has hit .333 (21-for-63) with six doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, 16 walks, a .468 on-base percentage and a 1.087 OPS.

**WE'RE OUT OF THEIR LEAGUE:** The Twins went 13-7 in Interleague Play last season, playing the National League Central...they play the same division in 2021...after this series, their IL schedule is as follows: three vs. Pittsburgh April 23-25, two vs. Cincinnati June 21-22, three at St. Louis July 30-August 1, two at Cincinnati August 3-4, three vs. Milwaukee August 27-29, two vs. Chicago-NL August 31-September 1 and two at Chicago-NL September 14-15.  
 ☞ Twins are 232-211 all-time in IL Play, the fifth-most wins in baseball, trailing Boston (263-180), New York-AL (259-183), Los Angeles-AL (243-201) and Oakland (238-206).  
 ☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .315 (152-for-482) with 27 doubles, 31 home runs, 97 RBI, 98 runs scored and a .975 OPS in 130 career IL games...in his last 12 IL games, he is hitting .432 (16-for-37) with a .500 OBP, six doubles, three home runs and 13 RBI.  
 ☞ Tonight's starter, José Berríos, has a .197 (81-for-411) career opponent batting average in IL Play, the third-lowest mark in baseball history (min. 400 AB), behind only Mariano Rivera (.173) and Trevor Bauer (.191).  
 ☞ The last Twins "true" pitcher to record a hit was Kyle Gibson, who singled twice on July 2, 2018, both against Brent Suter in this ballpark...**DID YOU KNOW?**: the last Twin to homer from the pitchers spot was catcher Chris Gimenez on September 2, 2018 at Texas...Gimenez finished an 18-4 game on the mound, homering in the ninth inning.

**A LOOK AT THE ROSTER:** The Twins opened the 2021 season with 10 players on their 26-man roster who were not on the 2020 Opening Day roster: pitchers (6) - Jorge Alcalá, Alex Colomé, J.A. Happ, Hansel Robles, Matt Shoemaker and Caleb Thielbar; catchers (2) - Williams Astudillo and Ryan Jeffers; infielders (1) - Andrelton Simmons; and outfielders (1) - Kyle Garlick...of the 26 players on the Twins active roster, 12 began their professional careers in the Twins organization...the Twins do not have any players looking to make their major league debut.

**SPRING WRAP:** The Twins finished their 31st Spring Training in Fort Myers, FL on Tuesday with a record of 11-15-2...Williams Astudillo led the club in hits (15) while Kyle Garlick led the club in home runs (5) and RBI (13)...Kenta Maeda led the club in innings pitched (18.1) and strikeouts (22)...additionally, the Twins drew 34,586 over 14 openings for an average of 2,043-per-game...their overall attendance was fourth in all of baseball and second in the Grapefruit League, trailing New York-AL (35,215).

**ON YOUR DIAL:** The Twins, in conjunction with Audacy, yesterday announced the new Twins Today driven by Mauer Auto Group program that will air every Sunday morning from 10 a.m.-12 p.m. throughout the Twins season on 830 WCCO (WCCO-AM) and streaming live or on-demand via the Audacy app...Twins Today will take listeners into the Clubhouse, across the diamond, through the Press Box and the Front Office, and around the club's Minor League system...each two-hour program will include six exclusive interviews highlighting a different facet of Twins baseball, as well as encourage fan engagement...Twins Today will be hosted by Derek Wetmore, who has covered the Twins since 2013 via print, radio and various digital mediums...Wetmore will bring his familiar "5 thoughts" branding into the program, while he will be joined by unique guests and fan call-ins on a weekly basis...Twins Today debuts this Sunday, April 4 and features Twins Hall of Fame electee Justin Morneau; St. Paul Saints Vice President, Director Media Relations/Broadcasting Sean Aronson; a guest from the Twins Clubhouse and an exclusive interview with legendary broadcaster Bob Uecker.

**ON YOUR TELEVISION:** Bally Sports North (formerly from FOX Sports North), home of the Minnesota Twins, plans to broadcast 156 games over the Twins' regular season...all games not airing exclusively on a national platform will air on the all-new Bally Sports North regional network...Twins programming airing on Bally Sports North will stream live on the all-new Bally Sports app and on ballysports.com when a consumer authenticates through their pay-tv service...Bally Sports North presents more live, local sports programming than any other network or broadcast system in the market...serving sports fans throughout Minnesota, Wisconsin, Iowa and North and South Dakota, the regional network produces over 250 live sporting events every year.

**2020 RECAP:**

- ☞ Was the Twins' Opening Day starter for second time in career, both consecutively...allowed five runs on seven hits on 4.0 innings pitched July 24 at Chicago-AL but did not factor into the decision in a Twins 10-5 victory.
- ☞ Earned first win of season in third start on August 4 vs. Pittsburgh, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched with three walks and six strikeouts.
- ☞ Went 1-3, 5.92 ERA (24.1 IP, 16 ER) with 13 walks, 24 strikeouts and a .284 opponent batting average in first five starts July 24-August 15...in final seven starts, went 4-1, 2.79 ERA (38.2 IP, 12 ER) with .207 opponents' batting average.
- ☞ Set season-high with nine strikeouts August 20 vs. Milwaukee (6.0 IP).
- ☞ Made the start September 20 at Chicago-NL, pitching 6.0 shutout innings and earning the win...faced his brother-in-law Javier Báez twice, getting him to pop out foul to first base and ground into a fielder's choice to third base...he and Báez are married to sisters.
- ☞ Went 3-3, 3.38 ERA (32 IP, 12 ER) in six home starts, compared to 2-1, 4.56 ERA (31.0 IP, 16 ER) on the road.
- ☞ Held right-handed hitters to .287 (37-for-129) at the plate, and left-handers to .180 (20-for-111)...among pitchers that faced at least 100 left-handed hitters, his .180 opponent batting average ranked third in the American League and seventh in baseball.
- ☞ Held opponents to a .174 (8-for-46) batting average with runners in scoring position...ranked third in the American League and tied fourth in the majors in that regard (min. 45 opponent AB with RISP).
- ☞ Led club in games started (12), pickoffs (2), and finished second in innings pitched (63.0), quality starts (4) and pitching WAR (1.1)...also tied for the most home wins (3) on the team.
- ☞ Started Game 2 in AL Wild Card September 30 vs. Houston at Target Field, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and four strikeouts as the Twins lost 3-1.

**SPRING TUNE-UP:** Went 2-2, 3.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 7 ER) in five Grapefruit League starts...ranked second on the staff in innings pitched and tied for second in strikeouts...final spring outing came six days ago on Sunday at jetBlue Park, pitching 4.1 innings and roughly 70 pitches.

**BERRÍOS AND AND THE BREWERS:** Is making his third career start against the Brewers, going 1-1, 2.08 ERA (13.0 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and 12 strikeouts in two previous starts...his last start came August 20, 2020, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed and season-high nine strikeouts, earning the win in a 7-1 Twins victory...his last and only start at American Family Field came on July 4, 2018, allowing three runs on five hits in 7.0 innings pitched and was dealt the loss in a Twins 3-2 defeat.

☞ He is 2-for-14 (.143) with two singles, a walk and eight strikeouts for his career at the plate...his singles were off Bartolo Colón in 2016 and Jeff Samardzija in 2017.

**AN INTERLEAGUE RUNDOWN:** Berríos is 10-9, 3.55 ERA (114.0 IP, 45 ER) with 11 quality starts in 20 career Interleague starts...dating back to September of 2019, he is 5-1, 2.06 ERA (35.0 IP, 8 ER) with 10 walks and 38 strikeouts in six IL starts...in 2020, he posted a 2.57 ERA (28.0 IP, 8 ER) and .180 opponent batting average in IL Play, ranking sixth among AL pitchers in opponent average and seventh in ERA (minimum 20.0 IP)...his four IL wins last season tied him with Phil Hughes (2014) and Johan Santana (2004) for second-most in club history, trailing only Francisco Liriano (5-0 in 2006).

☞ He has a .197 (81-for-411) career opponent batting average in IL Play, the third-lowest mark in baseball history (min. 400 AB's), behind only Mariano Rivera (.173) and Trevor Bauer (.191).

**MINNEAPOLIS MAESTRO:** Last season, he went 3-3, 3.38 ERA (32.0 IP, 12 ER) in six home starts with a .183 opponent batting average - the seventh-best opponent average in the AL...over his career, he has appeared in 54 games (53 starts) at Target Field, going 28-17, 3.65 ERA (320.1 IP, 130 ER) with 91 walks and 337 strikeouts...all-time at Target Field, he ranks second in wins (Kyle Gibson - 32), innings pitched (Gibson - 534.1) strikeouts (Gibson - 417) and starts (Gibson - 95).

☞ He is 20-21, 4.79 ERA (332.1 IP, 177 ER) with 24 quality starts in 61 career road starts...last season he went 2-1, 4.65 ERA (31.0 IP, 16 ER) with one quality start in six away starts.

**2020 REPERTOIRE:** Threw his Curveball 29.8% (.167 BAA/.231 SLG)...4-Seam Fastball 26.0% (.380 BAA/.780 SLG)...Sinker 25.5% (.229 BAA/.286 SLG)...Changeup 18.8% (.214 BAA/.357 SLG)...had a .167 opponent batting average on his curveball and .231 slugging %.

**WINNING WAYS:** Berríos has 45 wins since the start of 2017, ranking third in the American League and trailing Justin Verlander (DET/HOU, 53) and Charlie Morton (HOU/TB, 47)...MLB-wide in that span, 45 wins ranked tied for ninth in the majors with Trevor Bauer (CLE/CIN)...his 604 strikeouts rank sixth in the AL in that span, trailing Verlander (816), Chris Sale (BOS, 763), Gerrit Cole (HOU/NYY, 696), Morton (646) and Carlos Carrasco (CLE, 635).
