ROOKIE NIGHT AT TARGET FIELD: The Twins beat the Royals last night by a score of 9-1, winning back-to-back games for the first time since April 7 and 8...Michael Pineda (2-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched...Ben Rortvedt
made his major league debut, going 1 -for-3, recording his first hit with an RBI single off Wade Davis in the eighth inning...Alex Kirilloff went 2-for-4 and hit his first two career homers... he became the first Twins hitter since Pat Meares on June 19, 1994 at Baltimore to hit both of his first two career home runs in the same game...the Twins have now homered in five consecutive games for the second time this season.

TWINS AND ROYALS: The Twins went 5 -5 against Kansas City last season, going 3-1 at Target Field and 2-4 at Kauffman Stadium...the Twins have won five of their last six agananst the Rovals. $\boldsymbol{\Phi}$ Luis Arraez is hitting .339 (20-for-59) with seven walks and a 418 OBP in 16 career games vs. the Royals, hitting safely in 12 of 16 .
