LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the season in his last start on May 3 vs. Texas...allowed just two hits and two walks in 5.1 scoreless innings of work, with a season-high eight strikeouts... marked his most K's in a start since he fanned nine on September 23, 2020 vs. Detroit...three of the eight strikeouts were looking, his first time with three punchouts in a start since August 1, 2020 vs. Cleveland (also three)...marked his longest scoreless start since shutting out Cleveland for 7.0 innings on September 11, 2020...was his first victory since April 7 at Detroit.

START PRIOR: Took his second loss on Tuesday, April 27 in Cleveland, working 5.2 innings and allowing five runs (4 ER) on seven hits (3 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts...allowed at least five runs in consecutive starts for the second time in his career (also, July 29-August 4, 2019)... yielded three longballs in consecutive starts for the first time in his career...became the fifth starting pitcher in Twins/Senators history to allow at least three home runs and zero walks in back-to-back starts, first since Michael Pineda did so from May 11-16, 2019.

UPON FURTHER REVIEW: Major League Baseball recently announced a scoring change to a play that occurred during Maeda's start on April 27 at Cleveland...with Maeda on the mound in the bottom of the third inning, José Ramírez hit a line drive to leftfield that was originally ruled a double; it was been changed to a two-base error charged to leftfielder Alex Kirilloff...as a result of the change, the run scored in that inning is now unearned and there was no RBI on the play... Maeda is now charged with four earned runs on seven hits in that start.

SOUTH SIDE SUCCESS: Maeda is 2-0, 3.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 5 ER), with two walks, 17 strikeouts and a .246 opponent batting average (14-for-57) in three career starts against the White Sox...two of those starts occurred in 2020, when he went 1-0, 3.60 ERA (10.0 IP, 4 ER) vs. the ChiSox; the other came in 2017, with Los Angeles-NL...all three of his starts have occurred at Guaranteed Rate Field...the White Sox are one of two teams (also Atlanta) that Maeda has at least two wins and zero less against the bit career. zero losses against in his career.

CENTRAL SUPREMACY: Maeda is 1-1, 4.63 ERA (11.2 IP, 6 ER), one walk, nine strikeouts and a .304 (14-for-46) opponent batting average in two starts against the AL Central so far this season... 5-1, 2.74 ERA (46.0 IP, 14 ER) in eight starts against the AL Central last season...is 9-3, 3.09 ERA (78.2 IP, 27 ER) in 14 career starts vs. the division, marking his best career ERA against any single division. single division.

RESTED AND READY: Maeda has made 27 career starts on at least six days of rest, going 12-6 with a 4.36 ERA (138.1 IP, 67 ER) in those games...two of his six starts this season (aside from Opening Day) have come on six days of rest – April 14 vs. Boston (L, 4.1 IP, 7 H, 3 R/2 ER, 2 BB, 5 K) and April 21 at Oakland (3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 R/ER, 3 HR, 1 K).

SETTLING IN: Maeda finished April with a 6.56 ERA, his second-highest single-month ERA in his career behind his 6.58 mark in April 2017...owns a 4.48 career ERA in April, his highest in any month in his career...he tends to heat up with the weather, owning a 3.49 career ERA in May and 2.83 mark in June...here are his numbers by month in his career (full months only, excluding March and October) March and

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last several seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

2020 NOTES: Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on February 10, 2020, Maeda made his mark in his first season in a Twins uniform by finishing second in the American League Cy Young Award balloting, winning the Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year and being named the starting pitcher on the All-MLB Second Team...he also set several Twins single-season records.
Ø Began 2020 as Minnesota's No. 3 starter, making his Twins debut on July 26 at Guaranteed Rate Field against the White Sox...earned the win in a 14-2 Twins victory, after throwing 5.0 innings, allowing two earned runs on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts.
Ø Set a Twins/Senators franchise record for strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched at 10.80, passing Johan Santana's 2004 mark of 10.46.
Ø At ...168 (40-for-238), finished with the lowest single-season opponent batting average as a starting pitcher in team history (min. 10 GS)...led club in strikeouts (80), starter ERA (2.70) and innings pitched (6.2), while ranking second in starts (11).
Ø Finished first among qualified American League pitchers in WHIP (0.75), second in opponent batting average and OPS (.508), fifth in ERA and seventh in strikeouts.

DAYLIGHT, NOT ALRIGHT: Maeda is 1-1, 6.11 ERA (17.2 IP, 12 ER) in four day starts this season, compared to 1-1, 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP, 4 ER) in two starts in night games...his numbers in day games vs. night games this season mirror his career trends, as he's 13-11, 4.56 ERA (189.1 IP, 96 ER) in 44 career games (35 GS) in day games and 42-27, 3.51 ERA (495.0 IP, 193 ER) in 110 career games (85 GS) at night.

STRIKEOUTS, WALKS AND BASERUNNERS: Since the start of 2020, Maeda owns a 6.35 STRIKEUUTS, WALKS AND BASERUMNERS: Since the start of 2/2/0, Maeda owns a 6.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio (108 K, 17 BB)...his mark is third in the American League in that span, behind only Gerrit Cole (8.00) and Zach Plesac (6.77), and fifth in MLB (min. 300 BF)...his 9.06 baserunners-per-9.0 IP ratio in that span under those same parameters is sixth in the AL and 12th in the majors.
