**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 1-2 through three games on their current six-game homestand, dropping their series against the A's over the weekend...tonight they will continue the homestand with the first of three against the White Sox...they will play the Sox tomorrow night and Wednesday afternoon, then travel to Anaheim for a five-game roadtrip with two against the Angels on Thursday and three in Cleveland over the weekend...the Twins have gone 7-13 at home this season and 6-12 on the road.

**TWINS LOSE CRUSHER TO A's:** The Twins lost to the Athletics yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-6...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs (3 earned) on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Taylor Rogers (0-2) was issued the loss, allowing an unearned run to cross in the ninth inning...the offense recorded 11 hits as Max Kepler hit a three-run homer (4) in the second inning and Andrelton Simmons hit a game-tying two-run homer (2) in the eighth...Trevor Larnach had his first career three-hit game, all singles...the Twins drew 10,270, marking their second-highest single-game attendance of 2021.

**TWINS AND SOX:** The Twins and White Sox are playing the fourth of 19 meetings this season...they played their first three-game series of the season last Tuesday-Thursday as the Sox swept the Twins, outscoring them 13-26.

☞ Miguel Sanó has 10 home runs and 22 RBI in 26 games vs. the Sox since the start of 2019.  
☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .396 (44-for-111) with nine doubles, 12 home runs, 35 RBI, 17 walks, a .477 OBP, an .802 slugging percentage and a 1.278 OPS in 29 games vs. the Sox while in a Minnesota uniform (since 2019).

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .306 (59-for-193) with 10 doubles, 16 home runs, 41 RBI, 39 walks and a 1.026 OPS in 55 career games vs. the White Sox.

**PAIR OF SOX STREAKS:** Nelson Cruz has reached safely in each of his last 29 games against the Sox with a plate appearance (45 hits, 16 walks) posting a .466 on-base percentage in that span...Josh Donaldson has reached safely in each of his last 25 games against the Sox (23 hits, 28 walks), posting a .447 on-base percentage in that span...the longest streak ever against the Sox was Ted Williams in 54 straight from 1948-51.

**MASH 22:** Miguel Sanó hit his 134th career home run Saturday afternoon, moving him within seven of tying Michael Cuddyer for 12th on the Twins all-time list (below)...additionally, he has a 15.27 AB/HR ratio in his career, second to only Harmon Killebrew's 13.88 (minimum 2,000 plate appearances).

☞ Twins have a batting average in the first inning of .300 (45-for-150), the fourth best in baseball, trailing Chicago-AL (.319), Washington (.308) and Houston (.303)...they have eight home runs in the first inning, tied with Toronto for fourth most in baseball trailing Atlanta (14), Philadelphia (12) and San Francisco (9).

**SOUTHPAW STORIES:** The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 15th time this season, going 5-9 in their previous 14 when a lefty starts...they faced 16 (9-7) lefties all of 2020 and 39 (22-17) in 2019.

☞ Kyle Garlick has hit .343 (12-for-35) with six doubles, one home run, three RBI and a .951 OPS against left-handed pitching this season.  
☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .364 (16-for-44) with one double, three home runs, six RBI, two walks and a .995 OPS vs. lefties this season...since the start of last season, he is hitting .414 (36-for-87) with a 1.227 OPS vs. southpaws.

☞ Individuals vs. Keuchel: Mitch Garver is hitting .455 (5-for-11)...Jorge Polanco is hitting .364 (4-for-11)...Nelson Cruz is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with six home runs, 10 RBI and eight walks.

**REMEMBERING HARMON:** On this day in 2011, Twins legend Harmon Killebrew passed away at age 74 in Scottsdale, AZ after being diagnosed with esophageal cancer...Killebrew played 21 seasons for the Twins/Senators franchise, from 1954-1974...he was the 1969 AL MVP and was elected to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 1984...Killebrew is the club's all-time leader in home runs (475), RBI (1,325), walks (1,321) and games (1,939).

### THIS AND THAT:

☞ Josh Donaldson has reached base safely in each of his last 15 starts, dating back to April 28...has a .382 on-base percentage in that span.  
☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .386 (12-for-33) with four doubles, two home runs, four RBI and four walks in his last eight games.

☞ Twins have seven outfield assists this season, tied for fourth in the American League...Twins outfielders are averaging 88.4 mph on throws (per 90 feet), fifth highest in the AL and seventh in baseball.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .321 (25-for-78) with nine walks and a .400 on-base percentage from the leadoff spot in the batting order.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Recorded his first loss of the season last Wednesday at Guaranteed Rate Field after allowing nine runs on nine hits to Chicago-AL over his shortest outing this season (3.1 IP)...nine runs set a new career high and nine hits set a season high...allowed multiple runs four different innings, including a five-run fourth...allowed an Andrew Vaughn two-run homer in the fourth inning...struck out three batters and walked two, as the White Sox eventually won, 13-8.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Happ started the second game of the Texas series at Target Field on May 4...took a no-decision in a 6-3 Twins loss after allowing just one run on four hits over 5.1 innings, with one walk and three strikeouts...Adolis Garcia's first-inning RBI single was the first run Happ allowed in an opening frame this season (White Sox then touched him for two first-inning runs in his last start)...threw a season-high 101 pitches, his most since throwing 113 on September 19, 2020 at Boston (with the Yankees).

**ROCK 'EM, SOX 'EM:** Tonight marks Happ's 10th career appearance and start against Chicago-AL...is 4-4, 6.34 ERA (49.2 IP, 35 ER) with 16 walks and 54 strikeouts over his previous nine games...after his loss in Chicago last Wednesday, his career ERA vs. the White Sox is his highest against any opponent...Happ held a four-game win streak vs. the White Sox from June 26, 2014-April 3, 2018...holds a record of 3-2, 5.52 ERA (29.1 IP, 18 ER) vs. Chicago-AL at home.

**ILLINOIS TIES:** Happ was born and raised in Peru, IL, which is an hour and a half away from where the White Sox play at Guaranteed Rate Field...played on his high school's varsity baseball and basketball teams all four years...was named Bureau County Athlete of the Year in 2001...also played college baseball at Northwestern University in Evanston, IL, located about 18 miles north of Guaranteed Rate Field.

**AL CENTRAL COMPETITION:** Happ has spent 10 seasons of his career in the American League and seven seasons in the National League...this year marks his first time playing for a team in the AL Central...is 19-16, 5.05 ERA (260.0 IP, 146 ER) in 49 appearances (46 starts) against the AL Central...has recorded 19 quality starts among his 46 starts vs. the division.

☞ Happ is 1-1, 7.53 ERA (14.1 IP, 12 ER), six walks and 10 strikeouts in three starts against the AL Central so far this season...by comparison, he's 1-0, 1.56 ERA (17.1 IP, 3 ER) with four walks and nine strikeouts in his other three starts against non-AL Central competition.

**LOW HIT ZONE:** Happ has allowed 15 runs, 25 hits and 36 base runners over the course of 31.2 innings this season...25 hits allowed is fifth fewest among American League pitchers (min. 30.0 IP)...his 15 runs allowed are tied with Detroit's Matthew Boyd for sixth fewest by a left-handed pitcher in the American League (min. 30.0 IP).

☞ Happ is averaging 7.11 hits-per-9.0 IP and 10.23 base runners-per-9.0 IP, ranking 18th among American League pitchers (min 30.0 IP) in both categories.

☞ Happ has allowed the fewest amount of hits among Twins starting pitchers (min. 6 GS).

**RISP AND NO REWARD:** Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

☞ Happ's opponents are 5-for-19 (.263) against him with RISP in 2021...he allowed three hits with RISP in his last start, doing so for the first time since September 3, 2020 at NYM.

**A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB:** Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (468), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (426), Ervin Santana (385), Max Scherzer (376), Clayton Kershaw (363), Adam Wainwright (334), Johnny Cueto (313), David Price (311) and Madison Bumgarner (303).

☞ After tonight's game, he will have made at least 10 starts against 12 of 30 MLB teams.

**PITCH SELECTION:** This season Happ is rotating between four different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, dealing it nearly half of the time...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

**LEFTIES LUCK:** Happ is currently tied with former Twin Rich Hill for 12th-best ERA among left-handed pitchers in the American League this season (min. 30.0 IP)...the two are also the oldest left-handed pitchers in baseball this year (min. 5.0 IP) Hill (41) and Happ (38)...Happ's winning percentage (.667) is also tied with Hill for fifth best among AL southpaws so far (min. 30.0 IP), accompanied by NYY's Jordan Montgomery, TOR's Robbie Ray and CWS's Dallas Keuchel.

**STRONG START:** Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...his streak was ended in his last start, May 12 at Chicago-AL (3.1 IP, 9 R).

2020 NOTES:

- ☞ Spent third season with New York-AL, his second full season with the Yankees.
- ☞ Set season-high in strikeouts on September 8 at Toronto, fanning 10 batters in 6.1 innings...marked his 11th career double-digit strikeout game and sixth on the road...also marked his third career start of at least 10 strikeouts in less than 7.0 innings.
- ☞ Set season high in innings pitched on September 19 at Boston, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, no walks and nine strikeouts...marked just his third career start with no walks in at least 8.0 innings.
- ☞ Did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- ☞ Ranked second on club in innings pitched (49.1) and fourth in strikeouts (42).
- ☞ Led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655).
- ☞ Appeared in relief in Game 2 of the American League Division series on October 6 vs. Tampa Bay and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on five hits in 2.2 innings pitched.

CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (125) and starts (304), while is fifth in innings pitched (1773.0) and seventh in strikeouts (1558).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
- In 2020, led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655)...did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- Has made 12 Opening Day rosters with six teams: Philadelphia (2009-10), Houston (2011-12), Toronto (2013, '16-18), Seattle (2015), New York-AL (2019-20) and Minnesota (2021).
- Enters 2021 with 14 MLB seasons under his belt, with the Phillies (2007-10), Astros (2010-12), Blue Jays (2012-14, '16-18), Mariners (2015), Pirates (2015) and Yankees (2018-20).
- Made his 300th career major league appearance and 275th career start on June 23, 2019 vs. Houston.
- Compiled a career-best 19.1-inning scoreless streak from August 26-September 12-G1, 2019, the AL's eighth-longest scoreless streak in 2019 and longest by a Yankee.
- Finished sixth in 2016 AL Cy Young Award voting after going 20-4, 3.18 ERA for Toronto and tying for the second-most wins in baseball...marks his only career 20-win season and is one of just seven pitchers in the majors (and one of two southpaws) with a 20-win campaign in 2016.
- Finished second in 2009 BBWAA NL Rookie of the Year balloting to Florida's Chris Coghlan...appeared on all 32 ballots, receiving 10 first-place votes...won the 2009 Players' Choice Award for NL Outstanding Rookie...named 2009 NL Rookie of the Year by The Sporting News.
- Selected by Philadelphia in the third round of the 2004 First-Year Player Draft out of Northwestern University...debuted for the Phillies on June 30, 2007.
