THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 1-3 through four games on their current six-game homestand, dropping their series against the A's last weekend, followed by a loss to the White Sox last night...tonight they will continue the homestand with the second of three against the White Sox...they will play the series/homestand finale tomorrow afternoon, before traveling to California for a five-game roadtrip that begins in Anaheim with two against the Angels on Thursday and continues with three in Cleveland over the weekend...the Twins have gone 7-14 at home this season and 6-12 on the road.

TWINS SOCKED BY CHICAGO: The Twins lost to the White Sox last night by a score of 16-4, marking their largest margin of defeat this season...J.A. Happ (2-2) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs on seven hits in 3.2 innings pitched...the bullpen combined to allow 10 runs on 12 hits in 5.1 innings...the offense recorded 11 hits, four coming from Rob Refsnyder, who set a career-high...Josh Donaldson hit his fifth home run of the season and drove in two of the club's four runs.

OBERTIME: The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitchers Bailey Ober and Cody Stashak from Triple-A St. Paul...Ober, 25, has made two starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 0-0 with a 1.29 ERA (7.0 IP, 1 ER), five hits allowed, three walks and eight strikeouts...the 6-foot-9, 260-pound pitcher was drafted by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of College of Charleston in South Carolina...over two seasons in the Twins minor league system, he has gone 17-3 with a 2.34 ERA (188.2 IP, 49 ER) with 24 walks and 231 strikeouts in 36 games (33 starts) and is currently ranked as the club's 23rd-best prospect according to MLB.com...he also led all minor league pitchers (minimum 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 14 appearances (13 starts) in 2019...Stashak, who was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 7, will be making his third stint with the Twins in 2021...he has made 12 appearances for the Twins, posting an 8.44 ERA (10.2 IP, 10 ER) with two home runs allowed, seven walks, 19 strikeouts and a 16.03 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio...after his most recent option on May 7, Stashak made two scoreless relief appearances for the Saints, working 2.1 innings and allowing two hits, with no walks and three strikeouts...to make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Shaun Anderson on the 10-day Injured List with a left quad strain and designated right-handed pitcher Derek Law for release or assignment...Anderson appeared in three games this season, posting a 9.00 ERA (5.0 IP, 5 ER) with three walks and six strikeouts...Law appeared in five games, posting an 8.53 ERA (6.1 IP, 6 ER) with six walks and nine strikeouts.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the fifth of 19 meetings this season...Twins are 0-4 against the Sox this season and have lost five straight dating back to September 17, 2020...they are looking to avoid dropping six straight to the Sox for the first time since April 11-May 8, 2016 (also 6)...Twins have been outscored by the Sox 17-42 this season.

☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .306 (60-for-196) with 10 doubles, 17 home runs, 43 RBI, 39 walks and a 1.036 OPS in 56 career games vs. the White Sox...Donaldson has reached safely in each of his last 26 games against the Sox (24 hits, 28 walks), posting a .444 on-base percentage in that span.

☞ Tonight's Sox starter, Lance Lynn, made 20 starts for the Twins in 2018, going 7-8, 5.10 ERA (102.1 IP, 58 ER)...he signed with the Twins on March 12 of that season and was eventually traded to New York-AL on July 30, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Luis Rijo and first baseman/outfielder Tyler Austin...Rijo is still in the Twins organization but is currently inactive and Austin is currently playing for Yokohama in the Japanese Central League.

TREVOR TIME: After going 0-for-6 in his first two games, Trevor Larnach has gone 6-for-15 (.400) with three doubles and one walk in his last five games...his double last night registered an exit velocity of 116.0 MPH, the second-hardest hit ball by a Twins hitter this season, behind only Nelson Cruz's 116.6 mph home run on April 5 in Detroit...the double is also tied with Kennys Vargas's 116.0 mph home run on June 10, 2017 at San Francisco for the fifth-hardest hit ball by a Twins batter in the Statcast Era (2015-present).

☞ Larnach and Sox infielder Nick Madrigal were teammates at Oregon State University from 2016-18 and were members of the 2018 College World Series Championship team...in the championship game vs. Arkansas, Madrigal led off and played second base and Larnach batted third in rightfield...Twins pitching coach Wes Johnson was the Razorbacks' pitching coach.

SERIES NOTES: Twins are 3-8-1 in series play this season, going 1-5-0 in home series and 2-3-1 in road series (2-game series tie in DET May 7-8)...their three series wins are: 2-1 at Milwaukee, 2-1 at Detroit and 2-1 vs. Kansas City...their eight series losses are: 1-2 vs. Seattle, 1-3 vs. Boston, 0-3 at Oakland, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh 1-2 at Cleveland, 1-3 vs. Texas, 0-3 at Chicago-A and 1-2 vs. Oakland.

THE PLUS: Tonight's game can be seen on Bally Sports North PLUS due to scheduling conflicts as the Minnesota Wild play the Vegas Golden Knights in Game 2 of the NHL Stanley Cup Playoffs.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1962, Bob Allison and Harmon Killebrew hit grand slams in the first inning to lead the Minnesota Twins to a 14-3 victory over Cleveland...in 1969, Rod Carew stole second base, third, and home plate during the third inning of an 8-2 loss to Detroit...Carew pulled off the trifecta against the battery of Mickey Lolich and Bill Freehan and became the first player in 28 years to steal three bases in sequence in the same inning...Cesar Tovar also stole two bases in the game.

SEASON SUMMARY: Ober has made two starts for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-0, 1.29 ERA (7.0 IP, 1 ER), three walks, eight strikeouts and a .192 opponent batting average (5-for-26)...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game of the campaign on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts...the run crossed home on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work and represents his only run permitted so far this season...took the ball again on May 13 vs. Iowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision.

CAREER SUMMARY: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 17-3, 2.34 ERA (188.2 IP, 49 ER) with 24 walks, 231 strikeouts and a .221 opponent batting average (155-for-701) over 36 career minor league appearances (33 starts)...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020 and is currently ranked as the 23rd-best prospect in Twins system by MLB.com.

- ☞ **Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.63 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).**
- ☞ Over that same time span, Ober also ranks second with a 0.95 WHIP (behind only the 0.93 mark posted by Houston prospect Enoli Paredes), second by allowing just 183 total baserunners (second to Milwaukee's Luke Barker), fourth by walking just 1.19 batters per 9.0 innings and 14th for ERA.

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full professional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramirez's 0.51 ERA (88.0 IP, 5 ER) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners.

2019 RECAP: Combined to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponents batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, Single-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola in 2019, his last full campaign...led all Twins minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) in ERA and 0.81 WHIP...held right-handed batters to a .183 (28-for-153) batting average and left-handed batters to a .206 (27-for-131).

- ☞ Began the season with Single-A Fort Myers and was named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week on April 14, after going 1-0 with 12.0 scoreless innings across two starts (8 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 15 K)...placed on the 7-day Injured List on May 1 (retroactive to April 29) with right ulnar nerve subluxation.
- ☞ Made two rehab starts with the GCL Twins on July 2 and July 8, allowing two unearned runs in 9.0 innings, with one walk and 13 strikeouts...activated by Fort Myers on July 12 and promoted to Double-A Pensacola August 9.
- ☞ Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K)...also named Southern League Pitcher of the Week on September 2, after going 1-0 with 10.0 scoreless innings across two starts (5 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 14 K).

LOW TRAFFIC: Ober struck out 100 batters and walked just nine in 2019, good for an MiLB-best 11.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio (min.. 75.0 IP)...that season, he also ranked second in the minors in WHIP (0.81) and base runners-per-9.0 IP (7.55), and was fifth in walks-per-9.0 IP (1.03).

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober becomes one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins/Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...the others are:

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober becomes the fifth player to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and first pitcher...the others: 1B/OF Alex Kirilloff (April 14), C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF Nick Gordon (May 6) and OF Trevor Larnach (May 8).

#82 IN YOUR PROGRAMS, #1 IN YOUR HEART: When he takes the mound tonight, Ober will become the first player in Twins history to wear uniform number 82...former hitting coach James Rowson is the only other uniformed personnel to wear #82, doing so while presiding over 2019's "Bomba Squad."

TAKE A CHANCE ON ME: Ober attended the College of Charleston from 2014-17, compiling a 24-9 record, 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings pitched...named the 2014 NCBWA National Freshman Pitcher of the Year, missed the 2015 season while recovering from Tommy John surgery on his right elbow, and was selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 22nd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft...elected to return to the College of Charleston for the 2017 season, fanned 73 batters in 56.0 innings that season, and was tabbed by the Twins as a 12th-round pick.

- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, Single-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Florida State League Pitcher of the Week for Fort Myers on April 14 and Southern League Pitcher of the Week for Pensacola on September 2.
