ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed right-handed pitcher Michael Pineda on the 10-day Injured List with an abscess...Pineda has gone 2-2, 2.79 ERA (38.2 IP, 12 ER), 10 walks, 39 strikeouts and a 1.01 WHIP in seven starts for the Twins this season... to replace Pineda on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Luke Farrell from Triple-A St. Paul...Farrell, 29, will be making his second stint with the Twins this season, after being with the club from April 20-24 and pitching 1.0 scoreless inning in the first game of the doubleheader on April 20 at Oakland...he has posted a 1.93 ERA (4.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in three relief appearances for the Saints this season.
TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing the sixth of 19 meetings this season... Twins are 1-4 against the Sox this season...their next series will come June 28-July 1 at Guaranteed Rate Field for four games.
$\mp$ Josh Donaldson is hitting .303 ( 61 -for-201) with 10 doubles, 17 home runs, 43 RBI, 39
walks and a 1.021 OPS in 57 career games vs. the White Sox...Donaldson has reached safely in each of his last 27 games against the Sox ( 25 hits, 28 walks), posting a . 444 on-base percentage in that span.

LAST TIME OUT: Matched a season-high 6.0 innings pitched, but took his fourth loss of the season last Friday in the series and homestand opener vs. Oakland...allowed five runs on five hits ( 3 HR ) with two walks and four strikeouts, as the A's won, 6-1...yielded three home runs, matching his career high for the fifth time and first since August 4, 2020 at Atlanta...has allowed multiple longballs in four of his seven starts this year.
TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched 5.0 shutout innings in the series opener May 7 in Detroit en route to a 7-3 Twins victory...struck out five, including back-to-back hitters in the fourth inning to help him escape a first-and-third, no-out jam...earned his second win of the season, snapping his three-start skid...the Michigan native improved to 2-0, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER) in two starts vs. Detroit this season (both at Comerica Park)...was his first start of at least 5.0 innings with no runs allowed since April 3, 2019 vs. Baltimore (7.0 IP, 0 R).
