THE MIGUEL SANÓ GAME: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 5-4 in walk-off fashion, their second walk-off winner this season...the first four runs all came off the bat of Miguel Sanó, who homered three times with solo shots in the fourth and sixth innings and a two-run shot to tie the game in the eighth...Jorge Polanco drove in the final run and game-winner with a ninth-inning single...Balley Ober made his major league debut as the club's starting pitcher, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the Twins bullpen combined to pitch 5.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed...Sanó became the 11th Twin (13th time) to homer three times in a game. ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have placed right-handed pitcher Michael Pineda on the 10-day Injured List with an abscess...Pineda has gone 2-2, 2.79 ERA (38.2 IP, 12 ER), 10 walks, 39 strikeouts and a 1.01 WHIP in seven starts for the Twins this season... to replace Pineda on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Luke Farrell from Triple-A St. Paul...Farrell, 29, will be making his second stint with the Twins this season, after being with the club from April 20-24 and pitching 1.0 scoreless inning in the first game of the doubleheader on April 20 at Oakland...he has posted a 1.93 ERA (4.2 IP, 1 ER) with two walks and nine strikeouts in three relief appearances for the Saints this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Matched a season-high 6.0 innings pitched, but took his fourth loss of the season last Friday in the series and homestand opener vs. Oakland...allowed five runs on five hits (3 HR) with two walks and four strikeouts, as the A's won, 6-1...yielded three home runs, matching his career high for the fifth time and first since August 4, 2020 at Atlanta...has allowed multiple longballs in four of his seven starts this year.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched 5.0 shutout innings in the series opener May 7 in Detroit en route to a 7-3 Twins victory...struck out five, including back-to-back hitters in the fourth inning to help him escape a first-and-third, no-out jam...earned his second win of the season, snapping his three-start skid...the Michigan native improved to 2-0, 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER) in two starts vs. Detroit this season (both at Comerica Park)...was his first start of at least 5.0 innings with no runs allowed since April 3, 2019 vs. Baltimore (7.0 IP, 0 R).

OPPOSITION IMBALANCE: Shoemaker is looking for his first victory against a team other than Detroit, as most of the Michigan native's early-season success has come exclusively against the Tigers...below is a breakdown of his numbers against Detroit compared to those against all other competition:
