**THE TWINS:** After completing their three-game roadtrip in Cleveland with a record of 1-2, the Twins began their seven-game homestand by splitting the first two games with the Royals on Friday night and Saturday afternoon...today they will play the three-game series finale with Kansas City...the homestand will continue with four against Texas from Monday-Thursday...the Twins are 4-8 at home this season and 5-8 on the road.

☞ Twins are 2-2 in rubber games this season.

**TWINS SLUGGED ON SATURDAY:** The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 11-3...Matt Shoemaker (1-3) was the starter and loser, allowing nine runs (8 earned) on eight hits in 3.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded five hits...Alex Kirilloff homered for the third time in his last two games and Nelson Cruz homered for the eighth time this season...for Kirilloff, his three career home runs through his first 10 career games are third most in Twins history, behind only Graig Nettles (5 in 1968) and Gary Gaetti (4 in 1981-82)...for Cruz, it marked the 425th homer of his career, passing Edwin Encarnación and moving into sole possession of 52nd on baseball's all-time list.

**TWINS AND ROYALS:** The Twins and Royals are playing the third of 19 meetings in 2021...their next series will be back in Minnesota for three games from May 28-30...the Twins have won five of their last seven against the Royals.

☞ Luis Arraez is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with nine walks and a .423 OBP in 17 career games vs. the Royals, reaching safely in 16 of those 17.

☞ Josh Donaldson has reached base in each of his last 11 games vs. the Royals, hitting .325 (13-for-40) with a .426 on-base percentage in those 11.

**KING CRUZ, ROYALTY:** Since joining the Twins in 2019, Nelson Cruz is hitting .375 (36-for-96) with seven doubles, 16 home runs, 38 RBI, a .470 on-base percentage, a .948 slugging percentage and a 1.418 OPS in 27 games vs. the Royals...in that span, he has not gone more than three games without homering.

☞ Additionally, since the start of 2019, Cruz has hit .348 (136-for-391) with 21 doubles, 42 home runs, 108 RBI, 49 walks, a .729 slugging percentage and a 1.152 OPS in 105 games against the American League Central...here are his home runs and OPS by AL Central opponent in that span: CLE - 6 HR/.748 OPS, CWS - 11 HR/1.328 OPS, DET - 9 HR/1.089 OPS, KC - 16 HR/1.418 OPS.

**BUCK BY THE NUMBERS:** Byron Buxton has hit safely in 16 of 19 games played this season and has homered in eight of those 19...he enters today top five in baseball in batting average, slugging and OPS (minimum 75 plate appearances):

**SERIES NOTES:** Twins are 2-5 in series play this season...their two series wins are: 2-1 at Milwaukee and 2-1 at Detroit...their five series losses are: 1-2 vs. Seattle, 1-3 vs. Boston, 0-3 vs. Oakland, 1-2 vs. Pittsburgh and 1-2 at Cleveland...Twins went 2-1-0 in series play vs. the Royals last season, winning each of the last two.

**FANS ON TARGET:** The Twins drew 9,993 yesterday afternoon and drew 9,982 on Friday night...they have 99,637 in total attendance this season and are averaging 9,058 per opening, the fifth best in the American League, trailing Texas (25,227), Houston (17,523), Los Angeles (12,155) and New York (10,021)...they have seven sellouts this season.

**HOMER HAPPY:** Twins have hit a home run in six-straight games, marking their longest streak of the season...last time they homered in seven straight was September 5-13 when they homered in eight straight...in their last nine games, dating back to April 21, the Twins have hit 19 home runs, second most in baseball since that date, trailing New York-AL (20).

**KIRILLOFF IS ON:** After going 0-for-14 in his first five games, Alex Kirilloff has now hit safely in each of his last five, hitting .300 (6-for-20) with one double, three home runs, six RBI and a 1.133 OPS in that span.

**DID YOU KNOW?:** Bally Sports North analyst Justin Morneau hit 26 career home runs against the Royals, his most vs. any opponent...in 153 career games vs. Kansas City, Morneau hit .256 (149-for-581) with 35 doubles, 26 home runs, 92 RBI with 60 walks...his first career homer was on June 17, 2003 at Kauffman Stadium, a solo shot off Albie Lopez.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1964, at Municipal Stadium in Kansas City, the Twins hit four consecutive home runs in one inning, Tony Oliva, Bob Allison, Jimmie Hall and Harmon Killebrew all went deep in the 11th inning to win 7-3...in 1992, Yankees pitcher Scott Sanderson became the 12th pitcher in major league history to surrender four home runs in a single inning as Shane Mack, Kirby Puckett, Kent Hrbek, and Randy Bush all went deep (all solo) in the fifth inning as the Twins won 7-6.

**LAST START:** Did not factor into the decision in the Twins 5-3, 10-inning defeat on April 26 at Cleveland...started the first of a three-game series at Progressive Field, opposite Zach Plesac... held the Indians scoreless through five innings until allowing two runs in the sixth inning on an Eddie Rosario double and a Frammil Reyes single...relieved by Hansel Robles, who closed that inning out...exited after throwing 83 pitches, his second fewest in a start this season... was pulled by Rocco Baldelli after a second mound visit in that inning...Alex Colomé allowed a two-run, walk-off home run to Jordan Luplow in the bottom of the 10th.

**START PRIOR:** Started the second game of a doubleheader at Oakland on April 20, opposite Jesús Luzardo...was issued his second-straight loss as the Twins fell 0-1...only run allowed came in the fourth inning on a Seth Brown RBI-single, scoring Matt Olson who led off the inning with a double...was backed by just two hits...Twins were shut out on the day, losing game one by a score of 7-0.

**MINNEAPOLIS MAESTRO:** Was the winner in his first start at Target Field this season, the club's Home Opener on April 8 vs. Seattle...last season, he went 3-3, 3.38 ERA (32.0 IP, 12 ER) in six home starts with a .183 opponent batting average – the seventh-best opponent average in the AL...over his career, he has appeared in 57 games (56 starts) at Target Field, going 29-18, 3.63 ERA (337.1 IP, 136 ER) with 97 walks and 355 strikeouts...all-time at Target Field, he ranks second in wins (Kyle Gibson - 32), innings pitched (Gibson - 534.1), strikeouts (Gibson - 417) and starts (Gibson - 95).

**MISSED BATS:** He enters today with 33 strikeouts, ranking tied for 10th in the AL...his opponent batting average (.196) ranks eighth...additionally, his 11.14 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio ranks fourth in the AL, while his 4.13 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks 12th.

**AGAINST THE ROYALS:** Is making his 16th career start against the Royals...he is 3-4, 4.66 ERA (87.0 IP, 34 ER) with nine home runs, 31 walks and 74 strikeouts in 15 career starts against KC...his last start came on August 15, allowing four runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched and was dealt the loss in a 4-2 defeat at Target Field...his last win against the Royals came September 27, 2019 at Kauffman Stadium, allowing five runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched...15 starts, 87.0 innings pitched and 74 strikeouts are all his second most vs. any opponent...his 73.1 innings vs. KC since 2017 are fourth most, trailing Matthew Boyd (93.2), Lucas Giolito (81.1) and Mike Clevinger (76.0).

**WINNING WAYS:** Berríos has 47 wins since the start of 2017, tied with Charlie Morton for second in the American League, trailing only Justin Verlander (53)...MLB-wide in that span, 47 wins rank tied for ninth in the majors (with Jon Lester)...his 637 strikeouts rank fifth in the AL in that span, trailing Verlander (816), Chris Sale (763), Gerrit Cole (758) and Morton (646).

**SINGLE BASE LIMITS:** He has allowed only six extra-base hits this season...10 total pitchers in the American League have limited opponents to six XBH's-or-fewer (minimum 100 batters faced).

- ☞ Of the six extra-base hits he's allowed this season, just one has left the yard...his 0.34 homers-per-9.0 IP ratio is tied for seventh in the American League (min. 20.0 IP) with HOU's Lance McCullers Jr. and tied for 13th in the majors.

2020 RECAP:

- ☞ Was the Twins' Opening Day starter for second time in career, both consecutively...allowed five runs on seven hits on 4.0 innings pitched July 24 at Chicago-AL but did not factor into the decision in a Twins 10-5 victory.
- ☞ Went 3-3, 3.38 ERA (32 IP, 12 ER) in six home starts, compared to 2-1, 4.56 ERA (31.0 IP, 16 ER) on the road.
- ☞ Held right-handed hitters to .287 (37-for-129) at the plate, and left-handers to .180 (20-for-111)...among pitchers that faced at least 100 left-handed hitters, his .180 opponent batting average ranked third in the American League and seventh in baseball.
- ☞ Held opponents to a .174 (8-for-46) batting average with runners in scoring position...ranked third in the American League and tied fourth in the majors in that regard (min. 45 opponent AB with RISP).
- ☞ Led club in games started (12), pickoffs (2), and finished second in innings pitched (63.0), quality starts (4) and pitching WAR (1.1)...also tied for the most home wins (3) on the team.
- ☞ Started Game 2 in AL Wild Card September 30 vs. Houston at Target Field, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and four strikeouts as the Twins lost 3-1.

CAREER NOTES

- Named to 2018 and 2019 AL All-Star teams, pitching 1.0 inning in both games.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL and Game 2 of the 2020 AL Wild Card Series vs. Houston.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 Ks on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do were Hall of Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins' history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
- Named Twins' second-best prospect entering 2016, as well as best curveball, best changeup, and best control in Twins' system by *Baseball America*.
