THE TWINS: Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 against
Oakland last weekend and 1-2 against Chicago-AL this weektoday the Twins will begin their
fifth roadtrip of 2021they play two makeup games against the Angels today then travel to
Cleveland to play three at Progressive Field over the weekendthe Twins have gone 8-15 at
home this season and 6-12 on the road.

Twins are 3-11 vs. AL West opponents this season, going 1-2 vs. Seattle, 0-1 vs. Los Angeles-AL, 1-5 vs. Oakland and 1-3 vs. Texas.

TWINS TWO-HIT ON WAY TO SERIES DEFEAT: The Twins lost to the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 2-1...Matt Shoemaker (2-5) was the starter and loser, allowing two runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the bullpen combined for 3.0 perfect innings of relief, including 1.0 from Alex Colomé, who extended his scoreless appearance streak to seven straight (7.2 IP)...the offense recorded just two hits, both coming from Nelson Cruz as he singled and homered, his 10th of the season...the game was played in two hours and 35 minutes...Twins fell to 3-9-1 in series play this season, including 1-6 at Target Field.

DOUBLE VISION: Today marks the Twins' third doubleheader this season, going 0-4...last season the Twins played four doubleheaders, going 3-1 in Game 1 and 1-3 in Game 2...below are this season's results:

TWINS AND HALOS: Today marks the second and third of seven scheduled meetings with the Angels this season as today's games are makeups from the April 17 and 18 cancellations due to Iwins COVID testing and contact tracing...Twins lost game one April 16...the Twins will host Anaheim for four games from July 22-25...Iwins have won five of their last six against the Angels.

♣ Angels manager Joe Maddon was one of four managers Rocco Baldelli had during his playing career (Lou Piniella - 2003-05, Maddon - 2006-08, '10 and Terry Francona - 2009).

♣ Josh Donaldson has reached base in 17-straight games vs. the Angels, tied for fourth-longest active streak against the Halos with Justin Turner, trailing Francisco Lindor (24 games) and J.D. Martinez (22 games)...during the streak, Donaldson has a .438 on-base percentage...in 36 career games at Angel Stadium, he is hitting .324 (44-for-136) with 13 doubles, three home runs, 17 RBI and 12 walks.

♣ Max Kepler is hitting .313 (26-for-83) with four doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 15 walks, a .424 on-base percentage and a .966 OPS in 26 career games against the Angels...he has reached safely in 20 of his last 23 vs. the Halos.

♣ Miguel Sanó is hitting .306 (26-for-85) with six doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, 11 walks and a .974 OPS in .22 career games vs. the Angels...in his last 14 he is hitting .368 (21-for-57) with five home runs and a 1.102 OPS.

NELLIE, ANGELIC: Nelson Cruz is hitting .285 (196-for-687) with 28 doubles, 50 home runs, 125 RBI, 57 walks and 106 runs scored in 187 career games vs. the Angels...the hits, homers, RBI, walks, runs and games are all his most vs. any opponent...he has reached safely 14 straight against the Angels...Cruz leads all actives vs. LAA in homers, RBI and total bases (374)...only Alex Rodriguez (70) has more home runs all-time against the Angels franchise... among active players, only Albert Pujols has as many home runs against any single opponent (vs. HOU - 62, vs. CHC - 57 and PIT - 50).

TOP 50: Nelson Cruz hit his 427th career home run yesterday afternoon, tying Mike Piazza for 50th on baseball's all-time home run list...Cruz has hit 270 home runs since 2014, the most in baseball ahead of Mike Trout's 248...in that span, he has averaged 33.8 homers-per-season... he is on pace for 39 homers this season...below is Cruz's rankings on all-time home run list.

POLO PUNCH: Jorge Polanco has reached safely in 10 of his last 11 games, hitting .318
(14-for-44) with four doubles, two home runs, six RBI, six walks, a .400 on-base percentage and a .945 OPS in that span.

After starting the season hitting .167 (10-for-60) with a .455 OPS in his first 16 games, Polanco is hitting .291 (25-for-86) with an .849 OPS in his last 23 games.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1970**, Hall-of-Famer Rod Carew hit for the first cycle in Twins history in a 10-5 win in Kansas City... he went 4-for-5, and sealed the cycle with an eighth-inning triple...in **1989**, Randy Bush tied a team record with eight RBI in a 19-3 rout against the Texas Rangers...collected three-run home runs in back-to-back innings, while current Twins broadcaster Dan Gladden tied a major league record with seven plate appearances in the game, going 1-for-7 with an RBI and run scored...in **2005**, Carlos Silva threw a 74-pitch complete game in a 7-1 victory over the Brewers at home...in **2011**, the Twins were fortunate enough to be playing in Arizona and were able to attend the funeral of Twins legend Harmon Killebrew, who had passed a few days prior.

SEASON SUMMARY: Thorpe was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul as the 27th man for today's SEASUN SUMMARY: Thorpe was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul as the 27th man for today's doubleheader, his fourth major league stint this season (also, April 16-17, April 20, May 5)...has appeared thrice this season for the Twins, twice in a starting role and once out of the bullpen across his three prior stints, going 0-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks, five strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and a .216 opponent batting average (8-for-37).

◆ Thorpe has also made a pair of scoreless relief appearances for Triple-A St. Paul, working in games on the Saints' current homestand...pitched 3.0 empty frames on May 12 vs. lowa, followed by another scoreless outing four days ago, also vs. lowa (2.0 IP, 1 BB, 1 K).

LAST TIME OUT: Thorpe's last MLB outing came in a start on May 5 vs. Texas...matched his career high with 5.0 innings of work but was saddled with the loss after allowing three runs on five hits, with one walk and two strikeouts...retired nine of the first 10 batters he faced through the end of the third inning before allowing a run on a Joey Gallo groundout in the fourth...yielded a walk and a single to lead off the sixth before departing; both runners later scored off Cody Stashak, giving Thorpe the negative decision as the Twins fell 3-1.

HELLO, HALOS: Thorpe's season debut came on April 16 at Angel Stadium, his lone career outing against the Angels...worked 3.0 scoreless innings to begin his start, retiring 10 of the first 11 batters he faced before issuing a two-out walk to Mike Trout in the fourth, followed by a Justin Upton double and a two-run single off the bat of Jared Walsh that put the Angels ahead 2-0...departed after completing the fourth inning; Twins took the lead in the top of the sixth before ultimately falling to the Angels, 10-3.

ALL ABOUT THE WEST: All three of Thorpe's major league appearances so far this season have come against the teams of the American League West division, a trend that continues today... he entered the season having never faced the division...started on April 16 in Anaheim, then appeared in relief in the first game of the doubleheader on April 20 in Oakland, followed by a start on May 5 vs. Texas...is 0-1, 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER), two walks, five strikeouts and a .216 opponent batting average (8-for-37) in three career appearances (2 starts) vs. the AL West.

DOUBLE THE FUN: Thorpe has appeared in a doubleheader thrice in his career, including one start and two relief appearances...his lone start came in the second game on September 14, 2019 at Cleveland, taking a no-decision after allowing five runs on three hits in 3.2 innings... is 0-0, 8.10 ERA (6.1 IP, 6 ER) in those three outings.

STARTER AND RELIEVER: Thorpe has just 22 major league appearances under his belt entering today, including five starts...his starts have varied in length (5.0 IP, 3.2 IP, 4.0 IP, 4.0 IP, 5.0 IP), and he's 0-2, 6.23 ERA (21.2 IP, 15 ER), four homers allowed, 12 walks, 20 strikeouts and a .310 opponent batting average (26-for-84) in those five outings.

Thorpe's career relief appearances have lasted anywhere between 0.1 and 4.0 innings, and battal 26 EFT 100 100 with 100 for the strength of the strength of

he's 3-2, 5.57 ERA, 10 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .331 opponent batting average (44-for-133) in 17 career appearances out of the bullpen.

TAKING A RISP: Has held opposing hitters to a .250 batting average (12-for-48) with runners in scoring position in his career, far below his career opponent batting average of .323...he's yielded multiple hits with RISP just twice, August 3, 2020 vs. Pittsburgh (2-for-5) and August 29, 2020 at Detroit (2-for-6)...has allowed two hits with RISP this season, a two-run single to LAA's Jared Walsh in Anaheim on April 16 and a single to TEX's Nate Lowe on May 5.

With RISP and two outs, Thorpe has held opposing hitters to just 2-for-15 (.133) in his career.

YOU CAN GET ON BASE, BUT YOU'LL HAVE TO STAY THERE: In 2020, posted a 77.5 left on base percent (per Fangraphs), just above league average and well above the 66.2% mark he posted in 2019...for context, Thorpe's 77.5 left on base percent in 2020 matched Twins starter José Berríos's mark and was just below that of Kenta Maeda (80.2%).

Thorpe is averaging just 9.00 base runners-per-9.0 IP this season, second fewest among Twins pitchers (min. 10.0 IP) behind Jorge Alcala (8.27).

PITCH SELECTION: Thorpe has consistently thrown four different offerings to opposing hitters across
