LAST TIME OUT: Maeda settled for a no-decision in his last start on May 16 vs. Oakland...allowed five runs (3 earned) on eight hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in just 4.0 innings...yielded four consecutive hits to start the fifth inning (double, RBI single, single, single) before departing with the bases loaded; three additional runs scored off Tyler Duffey, on a groundout and an interference error called on catcher Ben Rortvedt...has completed fewer than five innings in four of his eight starts this season...his eight hits allowed matched his season high, also done on April 21 at Coklede the test elements... Oakland; last allowed at least eight hits in multiple starts in a single season in 2018 (also twice).

START PRIOR: Did not factor into the decision on May 11 at Chicago-AL...maneuvered around a shart Prior. Did not ractor into the decision on Way 11 at Chicago-AL...Indifference about a one-out single to complete a scoreless first before running into trouble in the second...allowed a leadoff single to José Abreu and walked Yermín Mercedes in the second before permitting a three-run homer to Yasmani Grandal, his seventh longball in a four-start span from April 21-May 11... retired the final nine batters he faced from the third through fifth innings and departed with the game tied 3-3; Twins' bullpen allowed six runs over the final three innings.

BATTLE WITH BIEBER: Maeda and the Twins handed Shane Bieber his lone losing decision of the 2020 campaign, as Maeda out-dueled Bieber on September 11, 2020 at Target Field... Maeda worked 7.0 shutout innings, allowing just four hits and two walks, with seven strikeouts; Bieber yielded three runs on five hits (2 HR), with two walks and eight strikeouts in 7.0 innings or the Twing rung 2.1 as the Twins won 3-1.

**CENTRAL SUPREMACY:** Maeda is 1-1, 4.86 ERA (16.2 IP, 9 ER), three walks, 12 strikeouts and a .286 (18-for-63) opponent batting average in three starts against the AL Central so far this season...went 5-1, 2.74 ERA (46.0 IP, 14 ER) in eight starts against the AL Central last season... is 9-3, 3.23 ERA (83.2 IP, 30 ER) in 15 career starts vs. the division, marking his second-best career ERA against any single division (NL East - 3.11 ERA).

**ON THE ROAD:** Maeda is making his sixth road start of the season, going 1-1, 6.38 ERA (24.0 IP, 17 ER) in his five prior outings...this compares to his 3.29 ERA (13.2 IP, 5 ER) in three starts at Target Field this season...all eight of the home runs he's allowed so far this season have come on the road.

**2021 ARSENAL:** Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last several seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

**OPPOSING COUNTS:** Opponents are hitting .500 (9-for-18) off Maeda's first offering of an at-bat... his opponent batting average on the first pitch is tied for seventh highest in the majors (min. 15 opp. at-bats) with STL's John Gant.

), at-bats) with sit s John dant. When the count goes full, Maeda is holding opposing hitters to just 1-for-17 (.059), tied with NYM's Marcus Stroman for sixth lowest among major league starting pitchers (min. 15 opp. at-bats)...however, of the five pitchers ranked above him in batting average in those circum-stances, none have issued fewer full-count walks than Maeda's six (HOU's José Urquidy has a .000 BAA and 6 walks issued in full counts). ¢

SETTLING IN: Maeda finished April with a 6.56 ERA, his second-highest single-month ERA in his career behind his 6.58 mark in April 2017...owns a 4.48 career ERA in April, his highest in any month in his career...he tends to heat up with the weather, owning a 3.68 career ERA in May and 2.83 mark in June...however, Maeda's 5.26 ERA so far this season is his highest mark through his first eight appearances of the season in his career (dating back to 2016)...here are his numbers by month in his career (full months only excluding March and October)
