**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-2 through four games on their five-game roadtrip, splitting a doubleheader with the Angels on Thursday in Anaheim, followed by a split of the first two games in Cleveland...today the Twins will play the series finale at Progressive Field...after the game, the Twins will travel home to begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with three against the Orioles from Monday-Wednesday and three against the Royals from Friday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 8-15 at home this season and 8-14 on the road.  
 ☞ Twins are 0-8 in extra-inning games, 1-5 in seven-inning games and 15-16 in nine innings.

**DÉJÀ VU IN CLEVELAND:** The Twins lost to Cleveland yesterday afternoon by a score of 5-3 in 10 innings, dropping to 0-8 in extra-inning games...Alex Colomé allowed a two-run walk-off homer in the bottom of the 10th inning to Cesar Hernandez, his second in a similar instance this season after allowing one to Jordan Luplow on April 26...Twins suffered their fifth walk-off defeat of 2021...Kenta Maeda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched with one walk and six strikeouts...the bullpen combined to allow just one run on five hits in 4.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded eight hits, highlighted by a Miguel Sanó home run (8) and a Max Kepler double (9) and triple (2)...the offense also went 2-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

**TWINS AND CLEVELAND:** The Twins are playing the Indians for the sixth of 19 meetings in 2021...they have gone 2-3 against Cleveland this season...they have won two of their last three against the Tribe, outscoring them 23-7 in that span.  
 ☞ Since the start of 2020, 12 of the 14 games between these two teams have been decided by three runs-or-less and eight have been decided by two runs-or-less.  
 ☞ Twins have hit 34 home runs in 17 games at Progressive Field since the start of 2019, the most among opponents...they have multiple home runs in nine of those 17 games.  
 ☞ Miguel Sanó has a nine-game hitting streak at Progressive Field, hitting .314 (11-for-35) with three doubles, four home runs, nine RBI, four walks and a 1.127 OPS in that span.  
 ☞ Max Kepler is hitting .378 (17-for-45) with three doubles, one triple, six home runs and 12 RBI in his last 11 games at Progressive Field...he has 16 career home runs against Cleveland, his most vs. any opponent...12 of those homers have been hit at Progressive Field, his most in an opposing ballpark.

**MIGGY CONTINUES TO MASH:** Miguel Sanó hit his 139th career home run yesterday, moving him within two of tying Michael Cuddyer for 12th on the Twins all-time list (below)...additionally, he has a 14.91 AB/HR ratio in his career, second to only Harmon Killebrew's 13.88 (minimum 2,000 plate appearances)...more on Sanó's recent home run stretch in right margin below.

**SANÓ WATCH:** Miguel Sanó is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with three doubles, six home runs, 13 RBI, three walks and a 1.375 OPS in his last nine games...since this current stretch started last Saturday, he has an average exit velocity of 96.2 mph, sixth best in baseball in that span (minimum of 20 balls put in play), trailing Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (99.2 mph), Aaron Judge (98.1 mph), Adolis García (96.9 mph), Michael Brantley (96.8 mph) and Evan Longoria (96.2 mph)...since May 15, Sanó leads baseball in homers (6).

**HOMER HAPPY:** Twins have hit 61 home runs this season, tied for third most in the American League and tied for sixth most in baseball...they are just 14-21 when homering at least once in a game, but 10-5 when homering multiple times.  
 ☞ Since April 21, the Twins have homered 47 times in 29 games, the most in the AL and second most in baseball in that span, trailing only Atlanta (50).

**KIRILLOFF IS ON:** Alex Kirilloff has hit safely in nine-straight games, third-longest active streak in baseball...it marks the third-longest streak by a Twin this season as Byron Buxton (April 1-20) and Nelson Cruz (April 5-16) share the longest, each with 10...during the streak, Kirilloff is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with three doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, an .750 slugging percentage and a 1.109 OPS in that span.  
 ☞ Kirilloff's streak is tied with Adolis García (May 2-10) for longest streak by a rookie this season...it marks the longest streak for a Twins rookie since Luis Arreola hit safely in 12 straight from July 2-19, 2019...Kent Hrbek holds the club rookie record with 23 straight from April 17-May 13, 1982.

**SERIES NOTES:** Twins are 3-9-2 in series play this season, going 1-6-0 in home series and 2-3-2 in road series...their three series wins are: April 1-4 at Milwaukee (2-1), April 5-7 at Detroit (2-1) and April 30-May 2 vs. Kansas City (2-1)...the Twins are 3-2 in their last five series vs. Cleveland with their last series win at Progressive coming September 14-15, 2019 in three games.

**TWINS WEEKLYS:** Twins outfielder Matt Wallner and right-handed pitcher Matt Canterino have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week...Wallner, 23, played in six games for Single-A Cedar Rapids, hitting .400 (10-for-25) with one double, one triple, two home runs and four RBI, including a four-hit game on Thursday vs. Beloit...the Forest Lake, MN native was drafted by the Twins in the first round (39th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Southern Mississippi...Canterino, 23, made two starts for Cedar Rapids, going 1-0, 1.64 ERA (11.0 IP, 2 ER) with one walk and 19 strikeouts, including a 10-strikeout game on Friday vs. Beloit...the Southlake, TX native was selected by the Twins in the second round (54th overall) of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Rice University.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1997, Paul Molitor went 5-for-5 in a Twins 8-4 loss to Oakland at the Metrodome...Molitor recorded five hits seven times in his career, one of 18 players in baseball history with at least five hits at least seven times (all-time leader, Ty Cobb had 14 games of five-plus hits)...additionally, Molitor ranks fifth all-time in multi-hit games (967).

**VAX FACTS:** The Twins, in partnership with CUB Pharmacy, will host on-site vaccination opportunities at Target Field for fans attending this week's series vs. the Orioles...additionally, all fans 18-and-over who choose to receive the one-dose, Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine at Target Field will receive a voucher good for one complimentary ticket to a future Twins regular season home game in 2021...the Twins' on-site vaccination opportunity is in support of Governor Tim Walz' "Roll Up Your Sleeves, Minnesota Fans" campaign...vaccinations will be available inside Gate 34 at Target Field on May 24, 25 and 26, beginning when gates open and lasting through the seventh inning of all three Twins-Orioles games.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Evened his season record to 2-2 Monday night at Target Field during his second-straight start and second-straight loss against the White Sox...allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR) over just 3.2 innings, with three walks and one strikeout...threw 37 pitches in the first inning, the second-longest opening frame of his career by pitch count, behind only his 41 pitches in the first inning on September 15, 2010 vs. Milwaukee...paired with his start on May 12, permitted at least six earned runs in back-to-back starts for the third time in his career, first since July 1-7, 2018.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Was handed his first loss of the season on May 12 at Guaranteed Rate Field after allowing nine runs on nine hits to the White Sox in his shortest outing this season (3.1 IP)...nine runs set a new career high and nine hits set a season high...allowed an Andrew Vaughn two-run homer in the fourth inning...struck out three batters and walked two as the Twins lost, 13-8.

**CLEVELAND ENCOUNTERS:** Today marks Happ's ninth career appearance and eighth start against the Indians...he is 4-2, 3.92 ERA (41.1 IP, 18 ER) with 11 walks and 31 strikeouts against the Tribe in his career...today is Happ's second start of the season vs. Cleveland after recording a win at Progressive Field April 28...allowed just two runs on four hits over 7.0 innings pitched, as the Twins won 10-2...owns a career 7.16 ERA (16.1 IP, 13 ER) in four games (3 starts) at Progressive Field, compared to a 1.80 ERA (25.0 IP, 5 ER) when facing Cleveland as the home pitcher.

**AL CENTRAL COMPETITION:** Happ has spent 10 seasons of his career in the American League and seven seasons in the National League...this year marks his first time playing for a team in the AL Central...is 19-17, 5.19 ERA (263.2 IP, 152 ER) in 50 career outings (47 starts) against the AL Central.

- ☞ Happ is 1-2, 9.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 18 ER), nine walks and 11 strikeouts in four starts against the AL Central so far this season...by comparison, he's 1-0, 1.56 ERA (17.1 IP, 3 ER) with four walks and nine strikeouts in his other three starts against non-AL Central competition.

**KEEP THE SWINGS LOW:** Happ has allowed 21 runs, 32 hits and 46 base runners over the course of 35.1 innings this season...32 hits allowed is seventh fewest among American League pitchers (min. 35.0 IP)...Happ's 21 runs allowed are ninth fewest and his 13 walks are tied for 13th fewest by a left-handed pitcher in the American League (min. 35.0 IP).

- ☞ Happ is averaging 8.15 hits-per-9.0 IP and 11.72 base runners-per-9.0 IP.
- ☞ He owns a .239 (32-for-134) opponent batting average this season.
- ☞ Happ has allowed the fewest home runs (4) among Twins starting pitchers (min. 4 GS).

**RISP AND NO REWARD:** Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

- ☞ However, this season, opposing hitters are 7-for-23 (.304) against Happ with RISP.

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** Happ has collected 148 quality starts throughout his career, including two this season...88 of his quality starts have come against the American League and 19 of them vs. the AL Central...four of the quality starts he has recorded have come against Cleveland.

**A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB:** Happ's start on April 13 vs. Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitchers to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (469), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (428), Ervin Santana (385), Max Scherzer (377), Clayton Kershaw (364), Adam Wainwright (334), Johnny Cueto (314), David Price (312) and Madison Bumgarner (305).

- ☞ He has made at least 10 starts against 12 of 30 MLB teams.

**PITCH SELECTION:** This season Happ is rotating between five different pitches...he relies heavily on his four-seam fastball, dealing it nearly half of the time...Happ added a curveball pitch to his selection during his most recent outing...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

**FRESH STARTS:** Happ allowed just two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his first five starts to begin this season, the longest such streak to start a campaign in his career...his streak ended two starts ago, on May 12 at Chicago-AL (3.1 IP, 9 H, 9 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB, 3 K).

- ☞ Spent third season with New York-AL, his second full season with the Yankees.
- ☞ Set season-high in strikeouts on September 8 at Toronto, fanning 10 batters in 6.1 innings...marked his 11th career double-digit strikeout game and sixth on the road...also marked his third career start of at least 10 strikeouts in less than 7.0 innings.
- ☞ Set season high in innings pitched on September 19 at Boston, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, no walks and nine strikeouts...marked just his third career start with no walks in at least 8.0 innings.
- ☞ Did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- ☞ Ranked second on club in innings pitched (49.1) and fourth in strikeouts (42).
- ☞ Led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655).
- ☞ Appeared in relief in Game 2 of the American League Division series on October 6 vs. Tampa Bay and dealt the loss, allowing four runs on five hits in 2.2 innings pitched.
- ☞ Signed a one-year deal with Minnesota on January 22, 2021.

## CAREER NOTES

- Ranks fourth among active left-handed pitchers in wins (125), is tied with Madison Bumgarner for fourth in starts (305), while is fifth in innings pitched (1776.2) and seventh in strikeouts (1559).
- Pitched a career best of 7.1 hitless innings on April 23, 2021 vs. Pittsburgh...left the game allowing only one hit over 7.1 innings...combined with Tyler Duffey and Taylor Rogers on the 19th one-hitter in Twins history.
- Made his 300th career start April 13, 2021 vs. Boston.
