THE TWINS: After completing their five-game roadtrip with a record of 3-2 (1-1 in Anaheim and 2-1 in Cleveland), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with consecutive wins over the Orioles the last two nights...today they will play the series finale with Baltimore...the Twins will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Royals for three over the weekend...the Twins have gone 10-15 at home this season and 9-14 on the road.

☞ Twins have won five of their last six, six of their last nine and seven of their last 12...Twins are looking to win four-straight for the first time since September 19-23, 2020 (also 4).

TWINS MAKE IT THREE STRAIGHT: The Twins beat the Orioles last night by a score of 7-4, matching their season-high with three-straight wins and taking their fifth series (5-9-2) of the season...José Berrios (5-2) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs (1 earned) on seven hits in 5.2 innings pitched...the offense recorded 10 hits as Mitch Garver, Rob Refsnyder and Alex Kirilloff each doubled twice...it tied a Twins/Senators franchise record (since 1901) for most players with multiple doubles in a game — ninth time...Refsnyder hit his second home run of the season and Jorge Polanco hit his fourth.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have reinstated right-handed pitcher Michael Pineda from the 10-day Injured List and placed infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez on the 10-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain (retro May 24)...Pineda, who was placed on the Injured List with an abscess, has started seven games for the Twins this season, going 2-2, 2.79 ERA (38.2 IP, 12 ER), 10 walks, 39 strikeouts, a .204 opponent batting average and a 1.01 WHIP...the right-hander ranks seventh in the AL in WHIP and 12th in opponent batting average (min. 35.0 innings pitched)...Arraez has missed the Twins' last two games after suffering the injury on Saturday in Cleveland, on a headfirst slide into second base in the top of the first inning...he has hit .277 (39-for-141) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 14 RBI, 20 runs scored, 17 walks and a .358 on-base percentage in 39 games this season.

TWINS AND BIRDS: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the third of six scheduled meetings this season as the Twins travel to Baltimore for three next week from May 31-June 2...since the start of 2018, the Twins are 14-1 vs. the Orioles...their last loss came on Opening Day 2018 as Adam Jones hit a walk-off homer off Fernando Rodney in the 11th inning...since that game, their 14-game winning streak is the longest active streak vs. any opponent...it's the Twins' longest ever vs. the Orioles (see note below).

☞ The Twins are 30-12 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams.

☞ Max Kepler has hit safely in 16 of 18 career games against the Orioles, hitting .397 (27-for-68) with seven doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 22 RBI, nine walks, a .462 OBP and a 1.388 OPS.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .355 (94-for-265) with 21 doubles, 17 home runs, 58 RBI, a .634 slugging percentage and a 1.061 OPS in 71 career games vs. the O's.

SWEEPS WEEK: The Twins are looking for their first sweep of the season this afternoon...their last sweep was September 22-23, 2020, taking both games from Detroit at Target Field...their last three-game sweep was September 11-13, 2020 vs. Cleveland at Target Field...the Twins recorded four sweeps in 2020 and 11 in 2019...last sweep of Baltimore came in three games here from April 26-28, 2019.

HOT ROB: Rob Refsnyder is hitting .438 (14-for-32) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks, eight runs scored, a .472 on-base percentage and a 1.191 OPS in 11 games since having his contract selected on May 15, with the Twins going 7-4 in those games in which he has appeared...he has hit safely in each of his last five games, one short of his career-high of six, done September 28, 2015-May 21, 2016 with New York-AL...since May 17, he ranks tied for fourth in the AL in hits.

ROUND TRIPS: Twins have hit 67 home runs this season, fifth most in baseball...they have homered in 11-straight home games, their longest streak since homering in 15 straight at Target Field from July 16-August 7, 2019...since April 21, they are tied with Atlanta for the MLB-lead with 53...on the season, the Twins have the seventh-highest average home run distance at 404 feet.

HAWK THE SKIPPER: Former Twins great and current Bally Sports North analyst, LaTroy Hawkins, has been named Manager for the AL Team in the SiriusXM Futures Game on July 11 at Coors Field...Hawk was a coach for the USA Team in Washington in 2018 for manager Torii Hunter...LaTroy pitched 21 seasons in the majors for the Twins (1995-2003), Cubs (2004-05), Giants (2005), Orioles (2006), Rockies (2007, 2014-15), Yankees (2008), Astros (2008-09), Brewers (2010-11), Angels (2012), Mets (2013) and Blue Jays (2015)...he compiled a career record of 75-94 with 127 saves and a 4.31 ERA over 1,042 games pitched, including 98 starts...Hawkins appeared in at least 60 games in 10 different seasons and his 1,042 career games pitched rank 10th all-time in major league history...in 2015, Hawkins became the 13th pitcher in major league history to record a save against all 30 teams when he closed out a win over the Twins while pitching for Toronto...the native of Gary, Indiana was drafted by Minnesota in the seventh round of the 1991 MLB Draft out of West Side High School.

VAX FACTS: The Twins, in partnership with CUB Pharmacy, are hosting on-site vaccination opportunities at Target Field for fans attending this series vs. the Orioles...additionally, all fans 18-and-over who choose to receive the one-dose, Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine at Target Field will receive a voucher good for one complimentary ticket to a future Twins regular season home game in 2021...the Twins' on-site vaccination opportunity is in support of Governor Tim Walz' "Roll Up Your Sleeves, Minnesota Fans" campaign...vaccinations will be available inside Gate 34 today, beginning when gates open and lasting through the seventh inning.

"BIG MIKE" BACK FROM THE IL: Pineda was activated from the 10-day Injured List today and is making the start this afternoon in the series finale vs. Baltimore...was scratched from his scheduled start on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL after undergoing a procedure to remove an abscess...was then placed on the IL on May 19 (retro to May 16) and missed two starts overall.

LAST START (BEFORE THE IL): Pineda last started on May 13 at Guaranteed Rate Field, in the finale of the Twins' three-game series in Chicago...allowed three runs (including one of two inherited runners that scored after he departed the game) on four hits in 5.1 innings, taking the loss as Lance Lynn and the White Sox completed the sweep with a 4-2 victory.

- Set season-highs with three walks, seven strikeouts and 96 pitches, while allowing two home runs for the third time in 2021 (both solo)...issued back-to-back walks to open the sixth inning, both on full counts.

STARTING STRONG: When healthy, "Big Mike" has been among the Twins' most effective and consistent starters thus far in 2021, while fashioning one of the best season-opening stretches of his career...his 2.79 ERA (38.2 IP, 12 ER) through his first seven starts is the third-best mark to begin a season of his career, behind the 1.95 ERA (37.0 IP, 8 ER) during his injury-marred 2014 campaign with the Yankees and his 2.72 mark (46.1 IP, 14 ER) in 2015.

- His 2.30 ERA (27.1 IP, 7 ER) over five starts in April marked his first month with five-plus starts and a sub-3.00 ERA since June 2016 (2.75 mark over six starts), and just the fifth such month of his career.
- Pineda's three quality starts (in 7 outings) are tied for the team lead, matching Matt Shoemaker (9 starts), but his 4.89 run-support average is lowest among Twins starters.

900-900 CLUB ON THE HORIZON: Pineda enters today's start 8.2 innings and nine strikeouts short of 900 for his career in both categories...over his first 155 major league starts, Big Mike has worked 891.1 innings and has fanned 891 batters...he would become the 48th active pitcher with at least 900.0 career innings pitched and 900 strikeouts, as well as the 26th Dominican-born pitcher in major league history to reach those marks.

MINNESOTA MIKE: Big Mike has made 38 starts in a Minnesota uniform, going 15-7, 3.71 ERA (211.1 IP, 87 ER)...the Twins are 24-14 when he toes the rubber.

- Pineda has a 4.53 strikeout-to-walk ratio since 2019, along with a 1.14 WHIP...those stats, along with his ERA, are all better than his career numbers (4.41, 1.18 and 3.97).
- His 4.0 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 17th among AL starters (min. 200.0 IP).

BIG MIKE, BIG PERFORMANCES: Pineda's ERA as a Twin stood at 5.02 (80.2 IP, 45 ER) through his first 15 starts of the 2019 season (his first campaign back in the majors following Tommy John surgery)...beginning June 29, 2019, Big Mike is 11-3, 2.89 ERA (130.2 IP, 42 ER), 31 walks, 137 strikeouts and a .2271/.275/.372 opponent slash line over his last 23 starts (Minnesota is 16-7 in those games).

BIRD TAMER: Pineda will make his 14th career start against Baltimore today, but his first since April 29, 2017 at Yankee Stadium, when he earned the win as the Bronx Bombers rolled to a 12-4 victory (5.1 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 8 K)...is 5-3, 3.86 ERA (72.1 IP, 31 ER) with 15 walks and 87 strikeouts in his first 13 outings.

- In seven career home starts against the O's (one as a Mariner, six as a Yankee), Pineda is 4-1, 2.30 ERA (43.0 IP, 11 ER) with 10 walks and 57 strikeouts.

HOME COOKING: Pineda will make his sixth home start of the season in this afternoon's game...is 1-1, 2.86 ERA (28.1 IP, 9 ER) over his first five Target Field outings of 2021.

- Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in four of his five home efforts this season, logging a trio of quality starts...opponents are slashing just .202/.239/.404 off Big Mike at Target Field in 2021, going 21-for-104 with three doubles, six home runs, five walks and 27 strikeouts.
- is 5-4, 3.67 ERA (122.2 IP, 50 ER) in 22 career home starts with the Twins, including 4-2, 2.93 (92.0 IP, 30 ER) in his last 16 efforts.

DAYTIME DRAMA: When he takes the ball this afternoon, Pineda will make his seventh day start of the season (of eight outings overall)...during his Twins tenure, Big Mike has actually pitched more under the sun (21 day starts) than under the lights (17 night starts).

- Pineda is 1-2, 2.94 ERA (33.2 IP, 11 ER) in his first seven day starts this year; 7-5, 3.68 (115.0 IP, 47 ER) as a Twin; and 20-18, 3.82 (353.1 IP, 150 ER) in 63 career starts under the sun.
- At night, Big Mike is 1-0, 1.80 ERA (5.0 IP, 1 ER) in 2021; 8-2, 3.74 (96.1 IP, 40 ER) with Minnesota and 35-30, 4.07 (538.0 IP, 243 ER) lifetime (92 starts).

FOR IT'S ONE, TWO STRIKES YOU'RE (MOST LIKELY) OUT: When Big Mike gets to a two-strike count, he is putting hitters away with above-league average efficiency...with two strikes, opponents are 11-for-76 (.145) with a .438 OPS and a 46.4 percent strikeout rate off Pineda...for comparison, American League hitters as an aggregate in 2021 are batting .167 with a .512 OPS and a 43.9 percent strikeout rate.

YOU CAN GET ON, BUT YOU'LL HAVE TO STAY THERE: Pineda has been stingy in any situation this year, allowing just 29 hits and 10 walks in 38.2 innings (a 1.01 WHIP that, in a full season, would be second best of his career)...but, he clamps down even more with runners on base, allowing just seven hits (3 doubles and 4 singles) in 42 at-bats, with three walks, for a .167/.217/.238 opponent slash line (by comparison, the AL aggregate with runners on is .251/.326/.410).

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: The one bugaboo for Pineda thus far has been the home run ball, yielding eight in his 38.1 innings (all solo), after not surrendering a single longball in his 26.2 innings in 2020...extrapolated over a full season, his 1.86 HR/9.0 rate would be the second highest of his career and his 5.19 home run percentage would represent a career worst.

THE "RIGHT" STUFF: Beginning with his first start of the 2020 season (which came September 1), Pineda has held right-handed batters to a .186/.240/.297 slash line (22-for-118 with 4 2B, 3 HR, 8 BB and 31 K).

- Pineda's .179 opponent batting average by right-handed hitters in that span is seventh-best in the American League (min. 120 batters faced).

FRIDAY'S STARTER - RHP RANDY DOBNAK (2021 SEASON: 1-3, 5.75 ERA // CAREER: 9-8, 3.68 ERA)

Dobnak is scheduled to make his second-consecutive start when he takes the mound in Friday night's series opener vs. Kansas city...opened the season in Minnesota's bullpen and struggled, going 0-3, 8.16 ERA (14.1 IP, 13 ER) with one save in seven appearances...was optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 3 to get stretched out...was recalled May 21 and started that night's series opener in Cleveland, tossing 6.0-innings of three-hit, shutout ball to earn the win in a 10-0 Twins victory...allowed just three singles, with two walks and five strikeouts, while pitching in front of family (including his grandfather, who saw him pitch in the majors for the first time)...is 9-5, 3.13 ERA (72.0 IP, 25 ER) in 16 career starts...is a perfect 3-0, 2.87 ERA (15.2 IP, 5 ER) in three lifetime outings (all starts) vs. the Royals.

CAREER NOTES

- Missed last 21 games of 2019, the entire ALDS and the first 36 contests of 2020 due to a 60-game suspension for violating MLB's Joint Drug and Prevention Treatment Program.
- Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...also missed the entire 2012 campaign with New York-AL recovering from right shoulder surgery, and was out of the majors in 2013 while rehabbing.
- Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
