LAST TIME OUT: Dobnak was recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on May 21 and started that night in Cleveland, his first start of the season after beginning the year in the bullpen and traversing down to St. Paul to morph back into a starting role... he scattered just five base runners ( 3 hits, 2 walks) across 6.0 shutout innings as the Twins blew out the Indians, $10-0$, in the series opener en route to a series win by the end of the weekend...recorded his third career quality start and first since August 5,2020 at Pittsburgh ( $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 3 \mathrm{H}, 0 \mathrm{R}, 0 \mathrm{BB}, 1 \mathrm{~K}$ )...also marked his seventh career start (out of 16) in which he did not allow an extra-base hit.
$\Phi$ Dobnak hails from the Pittsburgh area, just a few hours' drive to Cleveland, and had several family members in attendance that night...this included his grandfather, who had yet to see him pitch in the majors prior to that night.
SEASON SUMMARY: Dobnak began the season with Minnesota and was named to his second career Opening Day roster in 2021 (both with Minnesota)...he was optioned on May 3 (Brandon Waddell recalled) following a rough start to his campaign ( $0-3,8.16$ ERA, 1 save in 7 relief appearances), and to get stretched out for potential starting opportunities at the major league level... see the note below for how his tenure went with Triple-A St. Paul.
SAINTLY STARTS: Dobnak made three starts this month for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-1, 3.38 ERA (13.1 IP, 5 ER), six walks, 11 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average ( 10 -for-47)...nine of the 10 hits he allowed were singles.
$\Phi$ His first and third starts with the Saints were scoreless-a 4.0-inning, two-hit effort May 6 at Omaha ( $0 \mathrm{BB}, 5 \mathrm{~K}$ ) and a 5.0 -inning, four-hit outing May 16 vs. Iowa ( $1 \mathrm{BB}, 5 \mathrm{~K}$ )...sandwiched in between was a tough start May 11 vs. the l-Cubs in which he tied a career high at any level by issuing five walks in just 4.1 innings ( $4 \mathrm{H}, 5 \mathrm{R} / \mathrm{ER}, 1 \mathrm{~K}$ ).
$\Phi$ Dobnak's pitch count climbed, from 59 in his first outing May 6, to 81 in his second and topping out at 87 in his final Triple-A start on May 16, prior to his recall on May 21.

RANDY VS. THE ROYALS: Dobnak pitched 3.0 innings in relief vs. Kansas City on May 1 at Target Field, yielding two runs on three hits (2 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts...marked his first career relief appearance against the Royals...is 3-0, 2.87 ERA ( 15.2 IP, 5 ER) with four walks, 10 strikeouts and a 246 opponent batting average (14-for-57) in his three career starts vs. Kansas City; the Royals are the only team he's beaten three times in his career.

CENTRAL TIME: Dobnak is 1-0, 4.50 ERA (14.0 IP, 7 ER), four walks and 12 strikeouts in four appearances ( 1 start) against the AL Central this season... 18 of his 27 career appearances, including 12 of his 16 starts, have come against the division...he's 7-4-2, 3.19 ERA (73.1 IP, 26 ER) in his career vs. the AL Central, including 7-4, 2.98 ERA (57.1 IP, 19 ER) as a starter.

WELL GROUNDED: Dobnak's primary pitch is his sinker, which is the ideal tool for inducing groundball contact...since the start of 2019, Dobnak ranks among the major league leaders (min. 400 BF) in ground ball/fly ball ratio (3rd, 3.51), double plays-per-9.0 IP (3rd, 1.51) and ground ball percentage (5th, 58.5).

START ME UP: Dobnak enters tonight's game 9-5, 3.13 ERA (72.0 IP, 25 ER) in 16 career major league starts...was 7-2, 1.81 (49.2 IP, 10 ER) in his first 11 starts (through August 22, 2020), but went 1-3, 8.27 ( $16.1 \mathrm{IP}, 15 \mathrm{ER}$ ) over his final four outings of 2020.

F Has an opponent slash line of $.244 / .311 / .310$ as a starter, with opposing batters going 66-for271 with nine doiubles and just three home runs...has issued 20 walks, while striking out 48.
F Between September 3, 2019 (his first major league start, as an opener) and the end of the 2020 season, Dobnak's .336 opponent slugging percentage in 16 outings (one relief appearance) ranked second in the American League (min. 15 starts), behind only Cleveland's Shane Bieber (.326).

$\Phi$ Is 0-3, 5.40 ERA (23.1 IP, 14 ER ) with two saves, three walks and 18 strikeouts in 11 career relief appearances....he did post a 1.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 1 ER) in four bullpen outings in 2019.
More telling, however, is his lifetime opponent slash line of .317/.337/.505 as a reliever (32-for-101 with 9 extra-base hits)...even in 2019, that stood at $.341 / .341 / .439$ out of the 'pen.
