THE TWINS: Began their seven-game homestand with a 2-1 series win over the Royals this weekend...the Twins won on Friday night, lost on Saturday afternoon then were victorious in the rubber game on Sunday afternoon...the homestand will continue with four against Texas tonight through Thursday...the Twins are 5-8 at home this season and 5-8 on the road.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 13-4, winning their third series (3-5) of the season and first at Target Field...José Berrios (3-2) was the starter and winner, allowing four runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched with one walk and nine strikeouts...the offense recorded 14 hits, eight going for extra-bases...Mitch Garver (5), Alex Kirilloff (4) and Andrelton Simmons (1) each homered...five hitters had multiple hits matching a season high (also, April 21 at Oakland)...the attendance was 9,997, the club's highest single-game attendance this season and eighth sellout of the year...Target Field drew 29,972 over the three-game weekend series with Kansas City.

BOMBA SQUAD: Twins have hit a home run in seven-straight games, marking their longest streak of the season...last time they homered in seven straight was September 5-13 when they homered in eight consecutive...in their last 10 games, dating back to April 21, the Twins have hit 22 home runs, the most in baseball since that date, in front of New York-AL (20) and Cincinnati (18).

IT'S BUCK'S WORLD, WE'RE JUST LIVING IN IT: Byron Buxton has been named recipient of the American League Player of the Month award for April...he becomes the 16th Twins player to win the award and the first since Delmon Young in July 2010...he is also just the third Twin to be named AL Player of the Month for April, joining Kirby Puckett (1986) and Torii Hunter (2002)...Buxton played in 18 games in the season's first month, hitting safely in 16 of the 18 while batting .426 (29-for-68) with eight doubles, eight home runs, 14 RBI, 15 runs scored, a .466 on-base percentage, an .897 slugging percentage and a 1.363 OPS...he led qualified major league hitters in batting average, slugging percentage and OPS, and tied for second in home runs and extra-base hits (16) while ranking third in total bases (61) and fourth in on-base percentage...Buxton set Twins records for March/April in batting average, slugging percentage and OPS (min. 60 plate appearances)...his OPS also set a new Twins record for any month, surpassing Joe Mauer's 1.338 mark in May 2009.

GETTING OFFENSIVE: Twins have won three of their last four games, outscoring opponents 35-18 in that span...below numbers from the last four games vs. the previous 15 games:

TWINS AND TEXAS: Today marks the first of seven meetings with the Rangers this season...they will travel to Texas for three games from June 18-20...they played seven games against the Rangers in 2019, going 6-1 (2-1 at Target Field and 4-0 at Globe Life Park)...in those seven games, the Twins outscored the Rangers 58-33...they enter today with a four-game winning streak over the Rangers.

☞ Nelson Cruz played for the Rangers from 2006-13, hitting .268 (773-for-2886) with 170 doubles, 157 home runs and 489 RBI in 796 games...he still ranks seventh on the Rangers all-time list in home runs...he is hitting .301 (91-for-302) with 17 doubles, 21 home runs, 50 RBI and a .961 OPS in 80 career games vs. his former team.

☞ Byron Buxton made his major league debut at Globe Life Park on June 14, 2015, going 0-for-4...he has reached safely in each of his last 10 games vs. the Rangers.

☞ Mitch Garver is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with three doubles, one home run, seven RBI and a 1.038 OPS in nine career games vs. the Rangers.

WADD UP?: The Twins announced today that they have recalled left-handed pitcher Brandon Waddell from Triple-A St. Paul...Waddell appeared in two games for the Twins in April, pitching 3.0 scoreless innings of relief with five hits allowed and two walks...to make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak to Triple-A St. Paul...Dobnak pitched seven games in relief for the Twins, going 0-3 with an 8.16 ERA (14.1 IP, 13 ER), four home runs allowed, three walks and 11 strikeouts.

KIRILLOFF IS ON: After going 0-for-14 in his first five games, Alex Kirilloff has now hit safely in each of his last six, hitting .292 (7-for-24) with one double, four home runs, 10 RBI, an .833 slugging percentage and a 1.141 OPS in that span...Kirilloff's 10 RBI are the most in Twins history through a player's first 11 career games...most RBI through the first 12 was Kennys Vargas, who had 11 in 2014.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2011, Francisco Liriano threw the fifth no-hitter in Twins history and first no-hitter of the MLB season as the Twins beat the White Sox, 1-0...Jason Kubel's solo homer in the fourth inning off Edwin Jackson was the game's only run...in 2013, Justin Morneau recorded his 800th career RBI in a Twins 7-6 loss at Cleveland...Morneau finished his Twins career with 860 RBI which stands as the sixth most in club history.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ Edwar Colina turns 24 today...the right-hander has spent the season on the 60-day IL with right elbow inflammation.
- ☞ Vs. right-handed pitching: Byron Buxton is hitting .380 (19-for-50) with five doubles and six home runs...Luis Arraez is hitting .350 (21-for-60) with nine walks...Nelson Cruz is hitting .298 (17-for-57) with six home runs and 17 RBI.
- ☞ Twins have an average exit velocity of 89.6 mph, second best in baseball, trailing only New York-AL (89.7).
- ☞ Nelson Cruz needs one home run to tie Hall-of-Famer Billy Williams for 51st on baseball's all-time list...of Cruz's 425 homers, 157 came with Texas and 268 have come since departing the Rangers.
- ☞ The Twins have 11 sacrifice flies in 26 games this season, tied with Philadelphia for second most in the majors, behind Houston (12)...the Twins recorded 14 sac flies in 60 games last season.
- ☞ Twins hitters have a .352 (37-for-105) batting average in the first inning this season, 16 points ahead of the next-closest team (Los Angeles-AL, .336)...on the other side of the inning, Twins pitchers are holding opponents to a .128 (11-for-86) batting average in the opening frame this season, the lowest mark in the majors.

LAST TIME OUT: Took his second loss in his last start on Tuesday, April 27 in Cleveland, working 5.2 innings and allowing five runs on eight hits (3 HR), with no walks and three strikeouts...allowed at least five runs in consecutive starts for the second time in his career (also, July 29-August 4, 2019)...yielded three longballs in consecutive starts for the first time in his career...became the fifth starting pitcher in Twins/Senators history to allow at least three home runs and zero walks in back-to-back starts, first since Michael Pineda did so from May 11-16, 2019.

START PRIOR: Matched his career high in runs allowed (7) and set a season high in home runs allowed (3) while working a season-low 3.0 innings on April 21 in Oakland...did not factor into the decision as the Twins eventually fell 12-13 in extra innings...allowed seven runs in a start for the second time in his career and first since August 31, 2017 at Arizona (also 7)...also permitted three home runs in a start for the first time since March 30, 2019 vs. Arizona (also 3)...became the first Twins starting pitcher to allow at least seven runs while walking none since Héctor Santiago on August 20, 2016 at Kansas City (8 ER, 0 BB).

TEXAS TIME: Owns two career appearances against the Rangers, including one start, going 0-0-1, 4.50 ERA (6.0 IP, 3 ER), five walks, two strikeouts and a .261 opponent batting average (6-for-23) across the two outings, both of which occurred in 2018...started on July 13, 2018 at Dodger Stadium, taking a no-decision after permitting two runs on five hits, with three walks and one strikeout in 5.0 innings as the Dodgers won, 3-2...later that season, worked the final frame of a 3-1 win in Texas on August 29 (1.0 IP, 1 R/ER, 2 BB, 1 K) and earned his second career save.

GO WEST: Tonight marks Maeda's second start of the season against an American League West team...has made 10 career appearances (eight starts) against the AL West, going 2-4-1, 6.30 ERA (40.0 IP, 28 ER), 16 walks and 39 strikeouts...his ERA against the AL West is his highest against any single division in his career.

APRIL SHOWERS: Maeda finished this April with a 6.56 ERA, his second-highest single-month ERA in his career behind his 6.58 mark in April 2017...owns a 4.55 career ERA in April, his highest in any month in his career...Maeda's career ERA drops significantly in May, where he owns a 3.67 mark.

HOMEWARD BOUND: Is making his second home start of the season tonight...went 3-0, 1.91 ERA (33.0 IP, 7 ER), six walks, 42 strikeouts and a .109 BAA (12-for-110) in five home starts in 2020...led the majors in home BAA (min. 100 AB)...did not allow more than three earned runs or more than four hits in any of his five Target Field starts last season.

FANTASTIC FIRSTS AND TERRIBLE TWOS: Opponents are just 3-for-18 (.167) against Maeda in the first inning...that increases to 13-for-27 (.481) in the second inning and to 8-for-23 (.348) in the third inning before dropping back to 4-for-15 (.267) in the fourth inning...has run into trouble in the fifth and sixth innings, where opposing hitters are a combined 8-for-20 (.400) against him...14 of his 19 runs allowed this season have occurred in the second and third innings combined.

- ☞ Eight of the 15 extra-base hits Maeda has allowed this season have occurred in innings three to five (5 doubles, 3 home runs).

2020 NOTES: Acquired by the Twins from Los Angeles-NL on February 10, 2020, Maeda made his mark in his first season in a Twins uniform by finishing second in the American League Cy Young Award balloting, winning the Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year and being named the starting pitcher on the All-MLB Second Team...he also set several Twins single-season records.

- ☞ Began 2020 as Minnesota's No. 3 starter, making his Twins debut on July 26 at Guaranteed Rate Field against the White Sox...earned the win in a 14-2 Twins victory, after throwing 5.0 innings, allowing two earned runs on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts.
- ☞ Picked up 150th career win as a professional in his final regular season start on September 23 vs. Detroit...went 97-67 in Nippon Professional Baseball (2008-2015) and is 54-38 in Major League Baseball (2016-present).
- ☞ At .168 (40-for-238), finished with the lowest single-season opponent batting average as a starting pitcher in team history (min. 10 GS)...led club in strikeouts (80), starter ERA (2.70) and innings pitched (66.2), while ranking second in starts (11).
- ☞ Finished first among qualified American League pitchers in WHIP (0.75), second in opponent batting average and OPS (.508), fifth in ERA and seventh in strikeouts.
- ☞ Set a Twins/Senators franchise record for strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched at 10.80, passing Johan Santana's 2004 mark of 10.46.
- ☞ Started Game 1 of AL Wild Card series vs. Houston September 29, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, three walks and five strikeouts in a Twins 1-4 defeat...his cap from the game was donated to the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum, since he threw the first official pitch of the adjusted playoff format.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP J.A. HAPP (2021 SEASON: 2-0, 1.96 ERA // CAREER: 125-92, 3.95 ERA)

Southpaw J.A. Happ is due to toe the rubber in tomorrow night's game against Texas...last took the mound last Wednesday, April 28 in Cleveland, working 7.0 innings and allowing just two runs on four hits (1 HR), with one walk and three strikeouts in a 10-2 Twins win...has recorded consecutive outings of at least 7.0 innings for the first time since April 22-27, 2019, 2019, while posting a 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER) and .104 opponent batting average (5-for-48) in those starts...received 10 runs of support in a start for the first time since September 28, 2018 at Boston...owns seven career starts against Texas, going 5-2, 3.19 ERA (42.1 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks, 46 strikeouts and a .229 opponent batting average...last faced the Rangers on August 9, 2018 and has won each of his last four starts vs. Texas, with a 2.36 ERA (26.2 IP, 7 ER) in those efforts.

CAREER NOTES

- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owns the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
