**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-1 through four games on their seven-game homestand, taking two of three from the Royals over the weekend followed by a win over the Rangers last night...tonight they will play the second of four with Texas, then game three tomorrow night and the series finale on Thursday afternoon...the Twins are 6-8 at home this season and 5-8 on the road.

**TWINS HOLD OFF RANGERS FOR WIN:** The Twins beat the Rangers last night by a score of 6-5, holding the Rangers scoreless through the first seven innings...Kenta Maeda (2-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.2 shutouts innings with two hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Alex Kirilloff and Jorge Polanco...the Twins did not homer for the first time since April 25, snapping their seven-game homer streak.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have placed Luis Arraez on the 7-day IL with concussion-like symptoms...Arraez suffered the injury in a home plate collision when he scored on a Josh Donaldson double in the third inning of last night's win over the Rangers...he has played in 25 games, hitting .291 (25-for-86) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, 11 RBI, 15 runs scored, 14 walks and a .398 on-base percentage...to replace Arraez on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled infielder Nick Gordon from Triple-A St. Paul...Gordon, 25, was recalled by the Twins on April 23 and spent three days on the roster before being optioned on April 26...he will be in uniform for tonight's game with the Rangers, looking to make his major league debut.

**GETTING OFFENSIVE:** Twins have won four of their last five games, outscoring opponents 41-23 in that span...below are numbers from the last five games vs. the previous 15 games:

**GIBBY AND MINNY:** Rangers starter Kyle Gibson pitched for the Twins from 2013-19 and is one of 10 players that are currently either in the minor leagues, on a Taxi Squad or major league roster that appeared with the Twins in 2013 or prior...below is the complete list:

**NOTE:** Gibson was drafted by the Twins 22nd overall in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft...he, along with Aaron Hicks, are the only former Twins first round picks, drafted 2009-or-earlier, that are still active (Hicks was drafted 14th overall in 2008).

**ALSO ON GIBBY:** Gibson pitched seven seasons with Minnesota, going 67-68, 4.52 ERA (1087.0 IP, 546 ER) with two complete games, 392 walks and 845 strikeouts in 193 games (188 starts)...he ranks seventh on the Twins all-time list (since 1961) in starts, and 10th in innings pitched and strikeouts...he is the leader in wins at Target Field (32), also owns the most starts (94), innings (534.1) and strikeouts (417) in the ballpark's history...Gibby earned the following awards while in Minnesota: 2010 Jim Rantz Award as Minor League Pitcher of the Year, 2015 Joseph W. Haynes Award winner as Twins Pitcher of the Year, 2017 Carl R. Pohlad Award winner for Outstanding Community Service, 2018 Charles O. Johnson Award winner as Most Improved Twin, 2018 and '19 "Media Good Guy" Award winner...also was the 2019 Roberto Clemente Award nominee.

**TWINS AND TEXAS:** Today is the second of seven meetings with the Rangers this season...they will travel to Texas for three games from June 18-20...they enter tonight with a five-game winning streak over the Rangers, their longest since August 26, 2010-June 9, 2011 (also 5)...their last streak longer came July 5-October 2, 1980 when they won seven consecutive over Texas.

- ☞ Nelson Cruz played for the Rangers from 2006-13, hitting .268 (773-for-2886) with 170 doubles, 157 home runs and 489 RBI in 796 games...he still ranks seventh on the Rangers all-time list in home runs...he is hitting .301 (92-for-306) with 17 doubles, 21 home runs, 50 RBI and a .956 OPS in 81 career games vs. his former team.
- ☞ Byron Buxton made his major league debut at Globe Life Park on June 14, 2015, going 0-for-4...he has reached safely in each of his last 11 games vs. the Rangers.
- ☞ Mitch Garver is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with three doubles, one home run, seven RBI and a 1.038 OPS in nine career games vs. the Rangers.
- ☞ Jorge Polanco recorded his first career hit against the Rangers at Globe Life Park in his second career game on June 27, 2014, tripling off Joakim Soria...he became the third player in Twins history to record a triple as first major league hit and the first since Jimmie Hall on April 16, 1963; the first was Bernie Allen on April 10, 1962 vs. the Kansas City A's.

**KIRILLOFF IS ON:** After going 0-for-14 in his first five games, Alex Kirilloff has now hit safely in each of his last six, hitting .321 (9-for-28) with three doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, an .857 slugging percentage and a 1.190 OPS in that span...seven of his nine career hits have gone for extra bases...his seven extra-base hits through his first 12 career games are the most by a Twins hitter in that span since Josmil Pinto in 2013 (7)...Kirilloff's 11 RBI are tied with Kennys Vargas (2014) for the most in Twins history through a player's first 12 career games...is also tied with Vargas for most RBI through a player's first 13 games in Twins history.

☞ His .571 slugging percentage ranks third among all rookies in baseball (minimum 40 plate appearances), trailing Chicago-AL's Yermir Mercedes (.628) and Colorado's Dom Nunez (.611).

**MINOR MATTERS:** Below are the Twins minor league affiliates information as the 2021 Minor League Baseball season begins today:

- ☞ Triple-A St. Paul will make their official minor league debut tonight at Omaha at 6:35 pm (CT) as former Twin Andrew Albers will make the start for the Saints...Randy Dobnak and Ryan Jeffers are the only two players to make both the Twins and Saints Opening Day rosters.
- ☞ Double-A Wichita begins their first season as the Twins' Double-A affiliate...they will play at Springfield at 6:35 pm (CT).
- ☞ Single-A Cedar Rapids advances from the Low-A level to High-A in 2021...Kody Funderburk will get the start vs. Peoria at 6:35 pm (CT).
- ☞ Single-A Fort Myers transfers to Low-A in 2021 after 30 seasons as the club's Single-A Advanced affiliate...they take on Bradenton at 5:05 pm (CT) as Regi Grace Jr. gets the start for the Mighty Mussels.

**MRS. MORSECODE:** The Twins announced today that they have named Meghann Morse of Lakeville as the club's 2021 Honorary Bat Girl, in conjunction with Major League Baseball's league-wide support of the annual "Going To Bat Against Breast Cancer" initiative...all 30 clubs had the opportunity to hand-select their respective honorees, each of whom demonstrated an extraordinary commitment to the battle against breast cancer...Morse and her family will be honored at Target Field on Friday, May 14, prior to the Twins' 7:10 p.m. home game against the Oakland Athletics...Meghann, who this year is celebrating 18 years of marriage to Dustin Morse, the Twins' Senior Director of Communications, was first diagnosed with breast cancer in late 2019 at the age of 41...with an inspiring courage, an indefatigable resolve and an ever-present sense of positivity, Meghann faced four surgeries...now, nearly two years later, she is healthy, cancer-free and determined to raise awareness for the importance of scheduling an annual mammogram - a screening that helped save her life.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Happ started the finale of the Twins' three-game roadtrip to Cleveland last Wednesday...allowed just two runs on four hits, including a solo home run by Amed Rosario in the second, over 7.0 innings...has recorded consecutive outings of at least 7.0 innings for the first time since April 22-27, 2019, while posting a 1.26 ERA (14.1 IP, 2 ER) and .104 opponent batting average (5-for-48) in those starts...the Twins broke their four-game losing streak with a 10-2 win, the second time in two starts Happ has started a game that snapped a four-game skid.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Carried a no-hitter into the eighth inning of his 2-0 victory over Pittsburgh on April 23 at Target Field, the longest no-hit bid of his career and his first win in a Twins uniform...pitched 7.1 hitless innings before allowing a one-out double to Jacob Stallings in the top of the eighth...marked the first time in his career that he allowed only one hit over 7.1 innings...Tyler Duffey (1.0 IP) and Taylor Rogers (0.2 IP) finished the remainder of the game, combining for the 19th one-hitter in Twins' history (second this season)...twins snapped a four-game losing streak with a 2-0 win.

**HOWDY, RANGER:** Today marks Happ's eighth career appearance and start against Texas...is 5-2, 3.19 ERA (42.1 IP, 15 ER) with seven walks and 46 strikeouts...last faced the Rangers on August 9, 2018 at Yankee Stadium, allowing three runs on four hits, with one walk and nine strikeouts over 6.0 innings of a 7-3 New York-AL victory...has won each of his last four starts against the Rangers, dating back to April 28, 2015.

**AL WEST:** Happ has spent 10 seasons of his career in the American League and seven seasons in the National League...is 20-15, 4.26 ERA (253.2 IP, 120 ER) in 46 appearances (44 starts) against the AL West...has recorded 24 quality starts among his 44 starts vs. the division.

**NO HIT ZONE:** Happ has only allowed five runs, 12 hits and 19 base runners over the course of 23.0 innings this season...his five runs allowed are tied with TB's Josh Fleming, HOU's Cristian Javier and NYM's Jacob deGrom for third fewest runs allowed in the majors (min. 20.0 IP), trailing KC's Danny Duffy (4 runs), SF's Johnny Cueto (4 runs) and CWS's Carlos Rodón (3 runs).

- ☞ Happ is averaging just 4.70 hits-per-9.0 IP and ranks second among American League pitchers (min. 20.0 IP) behind Rodón (2.52)...Happ also ranks fifth in MLB in the category.
- ☞ Happ is also averaging just 7.43 base runners-per-9.0 IP, third best in the American League (min. 20.0 IP) behind Rodón (6.84) and NYY's Gerrit Cole (6.69)...he also ranks seventh in MLB.

**RISP AND NO REWARD:** Happ held opposing hitters to a .156 opponent batting average (5-for-32) with runners in scoring position last season...his BAA in scoring situations ranked second among American League starting pitchers (min. 30 opp. at-bats), trailing only TEX's Lance Lynn (.145), and ninth among all major league starting pitchers...yielded just two extra-base hits in scoring situations all season (2B on Sept. 3 at NYM and HR on Sept. 25 vs. MIA).

- ☞ Happ's opponents are just 1-for-10 with four strikeouts with RISP in 2021.

**A DIFFERENT 300 CLUB:** Happ's start on April 13 vs Boston was the 300th of his career...he is one of 11 active pitcher to reach the 300-start plateau, joining: Zack Greinke (465), Justin Verlander (454), Jon Lester (424), Ervin Santana (385), Max Scherzer (374), Clayton Kershaw (360), Adam Wainwright (332), David Price (311), Johnny Cueto (311) and Madison Bumgarner (301).

- ☞ Has made at least 10 starts against 11 of 30 Major League Baseball teams.

**PITCH SELECTION:** This season Happ is rotating four different pitches...here is his 2021 repertoire, according to Baseball Savant:

- ☞ Set season-high in strikeouts on September 8 at Toronto, fanning 10 batters in 6.1 innings...marked his 11th career double-digit strikeout game and sixth on the road...also marked his third career start of at least 10 strikeouts in less than 7.0 innings.
- ☞ Set season high in innings pitched on September 19 at Boston, pitching 8.0 shutout innings with four hits allowed, no walks and nine strikeouts...marked just his third career start with no walks in at least 8.0 innings.
- ☞ Did not allow more than four earned runs in any start.
- ☞ Ranked second on club in innings pitched (49.1) and fourth in strikeouts (42).
- ☞ Led all American League left-handed pitchers with a .208 opponent batting average (minimum 45.0 IP), while ranking second in WHIP (1.05) and sixth in opponent OPS (.655).
- ☞ Appeared in relief in Game 2 of the American League Division series on October 6 vs. Tampa Bay and was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on five hits in 2.2 innings pitched.
- ☞ Signed a one-year deal with Minnesota on January 22, 2021.
