THE TWINS: Have gone 3-2 through five games on their seven-game homestand, taking two of three from the Royals over the weekend followed by a split of the first two with the Rangers the last two nights...tonight they will play the third of four with Texas, then play the series finale tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, the Twins will travel to Michigan to begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against Detroit over the weekend, an off-day on Monday, then a three-game series with Chicago-AL from May 11-13...the Twins are 6-9 at home this season and 5-8 on the road.

Twins are 0-6 in extra-inning games, 0-4 in seven-innings games and 11-7 in nine-innings games.

TWINS FALL IN EXTRAS AGAIN: The Twins lost to the Rangers last night by a score of 6-3 in 10 innings, falling to 0-6 in extra-innings this season...the Twins held a 2-1 lead entering the ninth inning but allowed two in the ninth and three in the 10th...J.A. Happ was the starter, allowing one run on four hits in 5.1 innings with one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded four hits, two coming from Mitch Garver...two of the Twins' three runs were from a Byron Buxton two-run homer in the first inning.

To 10 of the 11 runs allowed by the Twins this series have come in the eighth, ninth and 10th innings...Twins are being outscored 17-1 in the ninth inning this season.

RIP, RAY MILLER: Former manager Ray Miller passed away last night at the age of 75...a native of Takoma Park, Maryland, Miller spent over 40 years in the professional ranks as a player and coach...he played 10 seasons in the minor leagues from 1964-73, pitching in the San Francisco, Cleveland and Baltimore systems...he shifted to the coaching ranks in 1974, working in the Orioles' system until 1977...Miller briefly served as the Texas Rangers' pitching coach in 1978 before shifting to the same role with Baltimore, where he led a staff that helped win the American League pennant in 1979 and the World Series in 1983...he also oversaw Cy Young campaigns by Mike Flanagan (1979) and Steve Stone (1980) with Baltimore...Miller earned his first career MLB managerial job with the Twins in 1985 and led the team to a 109-130 record in parts of two seasons at Minnesota's helm...he then spent the next 10 years of his career as the Pittsburgh Pirates' pitching coach, where he was Doug Drabek's coach when he won the 1990 AL Cy Young award...Miller's final MLB managerial stint came with Baltimore from 1998-99 and he posted an overall record of 266-297 as a major league manager...he finished his career with the Orioles as a pitching coach, retiring in 2005, and was inducted into the Orioles' Hall of Fame in 2010.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have recalled Lewis Thorpe from Triple-A St. Paul, placed Alex Kirilloff on the 10-day Injured List (right wrist sprain), optioned Brandon Waddell to St. Paul and reinstated Miguel Sanó from the IL...**Thorpe**, who will be in his third stint with the Twins this season, has appeared in two games (1 start) for Minnesota, posting a 3.60 ERA (5.0 IP, 2 ER) with three hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts...**Kirilloff** is hitting, 214 (9-for-42) with three doubles, four home runs, 11 RBI, eight runs scored and a .799 OPS in 12 games...he hit safely in each of his last seven games, hitting .321 (9-for-28) with a 1.190 OPS in that span...**Waddel**I, who was recalled on Monday, made two appearances. allowing six runs (5 earned) on five hits in 1.0 inning pitched... **Sanó**, who missed the Twins last 12 games with a right hamstring strain, is hitting .111 (5-for-45) with two home runs, two RBI, 13 walks and a .310 on-base percentage in 15 games this season.

BOMBA SQUAD: Twins have homered in 10 of their last 12 games, including multiple homers in seven of those...in those 12 games, which dates back to April 21, the Iwins have hit 24 home runs, the most in baseball since that date, in front of New York-AL (21) and Texas (20).

TWINS AND TEXAS: Today is the third of seven meetings with the Rangers this season...they will travel to Texas for three games from June 18-20...they have won five of their last six games vs. the Rangers and nine of their last 13, dating back to June of 2018.

▼ Nelson Cruz played for the Rangers from 2006-13, hitting .268 (773-for-2886) with 170 doubles, 157 home runs and 489 RBI in 796 games...he still ranks seventh on the Rangers all-time list in home runs.

▼ Byron Buxton has reached safely in each of his last 12 games vs. the Rangers.

▼ Mitch Garver is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with three doubles, one home run, seven RBI and a 1.033 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Rangers.

LEFTY LOOSEY: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 11th time this season, going 3-7 in their previous 10 when a lefty starts...through 28 games this season they are hitting .255 (77-for-302) with 15 doubles, 10 home runs, 23 walks and a .733 OPS against lefties, including a .288 (23-for-80) average with seven home runs and a .967 OPS in their last five.

◆ Nelson Cruz is hitting .379 (11-for-29) with a 1.058 OPS against lefties this season...dating back to the start of 2020, he is hitting .431 (31-for-72) with eight home runs and a 1.298 OPS vs. lefties, leading baseball in average and OPS (minimum 70 at-bats).

SEASON SUMMARY: Thorpe has made two appearances this season, including one start, across two stints with the Twins...both of his outings have come against the teams of the American League West division, a start against the Angels in Anaheim on April 16 and a relief appearance in the first game of the doubleheader on April 20 in Oakland...entered this season having never faced the AL West in his career.

The Worked 3.0 scoreless innings to begin his start on April 16 in Anaheim, retiring 10 of the first 11 batters he faced before issuing a two-out walk to Mike Trout in the fourth, followed by a Justin Upton double and a two-run single off the bat of Jared Walsh that put the Angels ahead 2-0...departed after completing the fourth inning.

STARTER AND RELIEVER: Thorpe has just 22 major league appearances under his belt entering tonight, including four starts...he started the Twins' 10-3 loss to the Angels on April 16, working 4.0 strong innings...his starts have varied in length (5.0 IP, 3.2 IP, 4.0 IP, 4.0 IP), and he's 0-1, 6.48 ERA (16.2 IP, 12 ER), four homers allowed, 11 walks, 18 strikeouts and a .328 opponent batting average (21-for-64) in those four outings.

₱ Thorpe has one relief appearance this season, a scoreless frame in the first game of the April 20 doubleheader in Oakland...his career relief appearances have lasted anywhere between 0.1 and 4.0 innings, and he's 3-2, 5.57 ERA, 10 walks, 26 strikeouts and a .331 opponent batting average (44-for-133) in 17 career appearances out of the bullpen.

TAKING A RISP: Has held opposing hitters to a .250 batting average (11-for-44) with runners in scoring position in his career, far below his career opponent batting average of .330...he's yielded multiple hits with RISP just twice, August 3, 2020 vs. Pittsburgh (2-for-5) and August 29, 2020 at Detroit (2-for-6)...has allowed one hit with RISP this season, an RBI single to LAA's

Jared Walsh on April 16.

With RISP and two outs, Thorpe has held opposing hitters to just 2-for-14 (.143) in his career.

YOU CAN GET ON BASE, BUT YOU'LL HAVE TO STAY THERE: In 2020, posted a 77.5 left on base percent (per Fangraphs), just above league average and well above the 66.2% mark he posted in 2019...for context, Thorpe's 77.5 left on base percent in 2020 matched Twins starter José Berríos's mark and was just below that of Kenta Maeda (80.2%)

PITCH SELECTION: Thorpe has consistently thrown four different offerings to opposing hitters across his time in the majors...here's a look at his 2021 repertoire, per Baseball Savant.

A DEBUT TO REMEMBER: Made his major league debut on June 30, 2019 against the White Sox in Chicago...was dealt the loss after yielding two runs on five hits, with two walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work...became the sixth Twins pitcher to record seven-or-more strikeouts in his debut, joining Boof Bonser (8 in 2006), Yohan Pino (7 in 2014), Darrell Jackson (7 in 1978), Bert Blyleven (7 in 1970) and Devin Smeltzer (7 on May 28, 2019).

Thanks to the efforts of several members of the Twins front office—namely Senior Director,

Team Travel Mike Herman – Thorpe's parents, Ross and Lyn, flew from Melbourne, Australia to Chicago and were in the stands for his debut...the then-24 year-old southpaw was surprised by his family the prior to the game the day before his start.

SPRING RECAP: Made five appearances, including two starts, for the Twins in 2021 Grapefruit League play...went 0-0, 2.35 ERA (7.2 IP, 2 ER) with two walks, eight strikeouts, a 0.78 WHIP and a .148 opponent batting average (4-for-27)...his two starts were both scoreless and came in his first two outings of the spring, March 1 at Tampa Bay (2.0 IP, 1 BB, 1 HB, 2 K) and March 7 kg. Tampa Bay (1.0 IP, 2 K) 7 vs. Tampa Bay (1.0 IP, 3 K).
