

LAST TIME OUT: Pineda opened the Twins' current homestand with a 9-1 win last Friday night against Kansas City...allowed just three hits (a fourth-inning solo home run by Carlos Santana and two singles), and the one run over 5.0 effective innings, with two walks and five strikeouts.

FIVE AND FLY: "Big Mike" was pushed back one day in the rotation for an extra recovery day after getting hit by the comebacker in his last start...in 57 career starts with five days rest, he is 21-11, 3.29 ERA (341.2 IP, 125 ER).

MICHAEL PINEDA, STOPPER: Looking to snap a two-game losing streak, salvage a split in the series vs. the Rangers and claim their first winning homestand of the 2021 season, the Twins are giving the ball to the right pitcher in Michael Pineda...Big Mike has started 16 times following a Minnesota loss since 2019, with the Twins going 15-1 in those outings...personally, Pineda is 8-1, 2.77 ERA (91.0 IP, 28 ER).
 Minnesota has won nine-straight games started by Pineda immediately following a team loss,

including April 15 vs. Boston (snapping a five-game skid).

AWESOME APRIL: Pineda toes the rubber today for his first start in May, following an April in which he posted his first month with five-plus starts (5) and a sub-3.00 ERA (2.30) since June 2016 (2.75 mark over 6 starts)...in fact, it was just the fifth such month of his career (the full list below, by ERA):

A LOOK AT THE LEADERBOARD: Pineda enters today's start 1.2-innings shy of qualifying for the American League leaderboard...if he qualified, he would rank among the early-season AL best for: WHIP (4th, 0.91), opponent batting average (5th at .190, 19-for-100), ERA (6th, 2.30) and opponent OPS (11th, .604).

PINEDA VS. THE RANGERS: Today's start will be Pineda's ninth career outing vs. Texas, and his third

HOME COOKING: Pineda takes the mound this afternoon for his fifth-straight and 22nd overall start at Target Field as a member of the Twins...over his first 21 outings, he has gone 5-4, 3.70 ERA (116.2 IP, 48 ER), while Minnesota is 13-8. **The Including today**, nine of Pineda's last 11 starts have come here at home (4 of his 5 efforts in the approximate of the distribution).

THE "RIGHT" STUFF: Beginning with his first start of the 2020 season (which came September 1), Pineda has held right-handed batters to a .167/.216/.255 slash line (17-for-102 with 3 2B, 2 HR, 6 BB and 28 K)

Prinda's .167 opponent batting average by right-handed hitters in that span is third-best in the American League (min. 100 batters faced)...only Baltimore's John Means (.155, 30-for-194), and Detroit's Casey Mize (.165, 17-for-103) have been better during that stretch.

MINNESOTA MIKE: Big Mike has made 36 starts in a Minnesota uniform, going 15-6, 3.69 ERA (200.0 IP, 82 ER)...the Twins are 24-12 (.667) when he toes the rubber.

- The Finded has a 4.68 strikeout-to-walk ratio since 2019, along with a 1.13 WHIP...those stats, along with his ERA, are all better than his career numbers (4.44, 1.18 and 3.97).
 His 4.0 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 17th among AL starters (min. 200.0 IP).

BIG MIKE, BIG PERFORMANCES: Pineda's ERA as a Twin stood at 5.02 (80.2 IP, 45 ER) through his first 15 starts of the 2019 season (his first campaign back in the majors following Tommy John Surgery)... beginning June 29, 2019, Big Mike is 11-2, 2.79 ERA (119.1 IP, 37 ER), 27 walks, 125 strikeouts and a .226/.272/.362 opponent slash line over his last 21 starts (Minnesota is 16-5 in those games).

2020 NOTES:

- Reinstated from Restricted List September 1 after missing the Twins' first 36 games, serving his suspension after violating MLB's Joint Drug Prevention and Treatment Program. Held right-handed batters to a .184 batting average (9-for-49); lefties hit .308 (16-for-52).
- Per Fangaphs, Pineda tied for second among AL starters with a 1.1 WAR in September, matching New York-AL's Gerrit Cole and trailing only Kansas City rookie Brady Singer (1.2).
 The Twins went 5-0 in Pineda's starts, as he played a key role in Minnesota going 16-8 over the season's final month, erasing a 2.5-game deficit and valuting from third place to repeat as AL Central Division champions.

- Missed last 21 games of 2019, the entire ALDS and the first 36 contests of 2020 due to a 60-game suspension for violating MLB's Joint Drug and Prevention Treatment Program.
 Spent the entire 2018 season on the Injured List, recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...also missed the entire 2012 campaign with New York-AL recovering from right shoulder surgery, and was out of the majors in 2013 while rehabbing.
 Struck out 207 batters over 175.2 innings pitched in 2016, setting the fifth-lowest innings total for a pitcher who recorded 200+ strikeouts in American League history.
 Was an AL All-Star in 2011 as a member of the Seattle Mariners, posting a 3.03 ERA (113.0 IP, 38 ER) with 113 strikeouts and an opponents average of .198 in the first half, and finished the year fifth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting.

- In 2011, he became one of 27 rookie pitchers in the Expansion Era (1961-present) to throw at least 171.0 innings and strikeout 173 or more batters, and first since Daisuke Matsuzaka (Boston, 2007).
- Was signed by Seattle as a 16-year-old undrafted free agent December 12, 2005...signed by Patrick Guerrero, brother of Fred Guerrero, Twins' Director of Latin American Scouting & U.S.
- He owns a farm in his native Dominican Republic, where he raises chickens in addition to growing a number of crops.

STRIKE ONE: Among all American League pitchers that have worked at least 25.0 IP thus far 2021, Pineda ranks fourth in first-strike percentage (68.2%)...he is 10th in all of MLB

FLAILING AWAY: Pineda has induced hitters to swing at pitches outside the zone 33.3 percent of the time...his overall chase rate ranks in the 90th percentile among all major league pitchers.
