TWINS FALL AGAIN IN EXTRAS: The Twins lost to the Rangers yesterday afternoon by a score of $4-3$ in 10 innings, falling to $0-7$ in extras this season...Michael Pineda was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched...the marking his first homer of the season and 10th leadoff homer of his career...Nick Gordon made his major league debut, going 1 -for-2 with a walk and two stolen bases, becoming the first Twin and 13th player in baseball history to steal multiple bags in his debut.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed outfielder Byron Buxton on the 10-day Injured List with a right hip strain and selected the contract of outtielder Trevor Larnach...Larnach recently appeared in three games for Triple-A St. Paul and went 3-for-13 (.231) with four RBI, including home runs in each of his last two games in Omaha....he was named 2019 Twins Minor League Player of the Year after hitting a combined. 309 (147-for-476) with 30 doubles, 13 home runs and an 8420 PS in 127 games between Single-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola... Larnach, who is currently ranked as the 69th-best prospect in baseball by MLB.com, was selected by the Twins with the 20th overall pick in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Oregon State University...to make room for Larnach on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated left-handed pitcher Brandon Waddell for release or assignment.
TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins and Tigers are playing the fourth of 19 games in 2021 ...the Twins won the first and third games during their three-game series from April $5-7$ at Comerica Park.... $\Phi$ Nelson Cruz is hitting. 335 ( 79 -for-236) with 10 doubles, 20 home runs 51 RBI, 18 walks and a 1.015 OPS in 59 career games at Comerica Park in his last 27 games here, he is hitting 393 (46-for-117) with 16 home runs, 31 RBI and a 1.263 OPS...in fact, since 2015, he leads all opponents in home runs at Comerica with 16...hit three HR last series vs. Detroit, two on April 5 .
$\Phi$ Jorge Polanco is hitting .366 (26-for-71) with three home runs, 10 RBI and a 919 OPS in his last 17 games vs. the Tigers.
