**THE TWINS:** Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2, going 3-0 against Baltimore and 1-2 against Kansas City...today they will begin a seven-game roadtrip with three against the Orioles through Wednesday and four at Kansas City from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 12-17 at home this season and 9-14 on the road.  
 ☞ Twins have won seven of their last 10 and eight of their last 13.

**TWINS DROP RUBBER GAME TO ROYALS:** The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-3...Matt Shoemaker (2-6) was the starter and loser, allowing five runs on six hits in 4.1 innings pitched with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded just five hits, three coming from Alex Kirilloff, all singles...Ben Rortvedt hit his first major league home run, extending the club's homer streak at Target Field to 15-straight games...the Twins also went 2-for-11 with runners in scoring position and left 10 men on base...the attendance was 17,923, the second-highest of the season for Target Field.

**TWINS AND BIRDS:** The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the fourth of six scheduled meetings this season...the Twins are visiting Baltimore for the first time since April 20-21, 2019, sweeping in three games...since the start of 2018, the Twins are 15-1 vs. the Orioles...their last loss came on Opening Day 2018 as Adam Jones hit a walk-off homer off Fernando Rodney in the 11th inning...since that game, their 15-game winning streak is the longest active streak vs. any opponent...it's the Twins' longest ever vs. the Orioles (see note below).

☞ The Twins are 31-12 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.

☞ Since the start of 2018, the Twins have hit 41 home runs in 16 games against Baltimore...in their last series in this ballpark, they hit 11 home runs, eight in game two of a doubleheader on April 20, 2019 (Garver - 2, Cruz - 2, Schoop - 2, Rosario, Cron)...eight home runs tied a club record, done previously August 29, 1963...Cruz, Garver and Schoop's multi-homer games tied a club record for most players with multiple homers in same game (July 12, 2001 at Milwaukee - Jacque Jones, Corey Koskie and Torii Hunter)...Eddie Rosario also had a multi-homer game in game one earlier that day, making the Twins the first team in baseball history with four multi-homer games in one day.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .352 (94-for-267) with 21 doubles, 17 home runs, 58 RBI, a .629 slugging percentage and a 1.057 OPS in 72 career games vs. the O's...Cruz spent 2014 with Baltimore, hitting .271 (166-for-613) with 32 doubles, an MLB-best 40 homers and 108 RBI in 159 games...since Cruz landed in Baltimore, he has 270 home runs, best in baseball since that season...additionally, Cruz has 22 career homers in 114 games at Camden Yards.

**NOTE:** During the streak, the Twins have out-scored the Orioles 102-39 and have hit .285 (147-for-516) with 37 doubles and 41 home runs with an OPS of .934...today's starter, José Berríos, has been the winning pitcher in four of those games...in fact, in that 15-win span, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 14-0, 2.09 ERA (94.2 IP, 22 ER) with Orioles batters hitting .205 (71-for-346).

#### THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT:

☞ Alex Kirilloff is hitting .313 (20-for-64) with five doubles, four home runs, 15 RBI, 12 runs scored and a .926 OPS in his last 16 games...he leads all rookies in baseball in OPS (min. 50 plate appearances) since April 26.

☞ Trevor Larnach has posted a .426 on-base percentage in his last 15 games, recording 11 hits and 10 walks in 54 plate appearances, including an .950 OPS in that span...he has reached safely via hit, walk or HBP in 13 of those 15 games.

**HOT SAUCE:** Mitch Garver has hit safely in eight-straight games, setting a career high, passing his previous high of seven from August 16-23, 2018...during the streak, he is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with five doubles, two home runs, four RBI, eight walks, a .548 on-base percentage, an .870 slugging percentage and a 1.418 OPS...his eight-game streak is tied for second-longest active streak in the AL and tied for sixth in all of baseball...each of Garver's last five hits have gone for extra-bases (4 doubles, 1 home run).

**HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY:** The Twins are 23-31 all-time on Memorial Day...their last Memorial Day game came on May 27, 2019, losing by a score of 5-4 to the Brewers at Target Field...in that game, the Twins held a 4-3 lead entering the eighth inning and allowed two runs in the top of the eighth...their last Memorial Day win came in 2018, beating the Royals in Kansas City by a score of 8-5...Lance Lynn was the winner and Fernando Rodney earned the save...the offense recorded 12 hits as Brian Dozier recorded three hits and Miguel Sanó hit his sixth home run of the season...today marks the seventh time the Twins have played Baltimore on Memorial Day and first time since 1990.

**ALL SAINTS WEEK:** Triple-A St. Paul hit four home runs last night (Riddle - 2, Rooker, Jeffers) and beat Iowa in Des Moines by a score of 7-3, sweeping in six games...the win marked the seventh straight victory for the Saints as they improved to 13-11 on the season.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 1980, Ken Landreaux went 0-for-4 in an 11-1 loss to Baltimore, snapping his hitting streak at 31 consecutive games, which was the longest streak in the American League since Dom DiMaggio hit safely in 34 straight in 1949...Landreaux's 31 games still remains the all-time club record...in 2015, the Twins defeated Toronto 6-5 to win their 20th game in the month of May, their most wins in a month since the 1991 season when they won 22 games in June.

**LAST START:** Was the winner in the Twins 7-4 victory on May 25 vs. Baltimore, opposite Dean Kremer...earned his third win in as many decisions as one more would match his longest streak from last season...allowed two runs in the second inning, both unearned after a fielding error by Andrelton Simmons at second base...third run allowed came on a Pedro Severino double in the fourth inning...struck out seven batters for the second-straight start...threw a season-high 106 pitches (73 strikes).

- ☞ Passed Eric Milton (715) on the Twins' all-time strikeout list and now sits in sole possession of 14th place (since 1961).

**START PRIOR:** Was the winner in the Twins 6-3 victory on May 20 at Los Angeles-AL, opposite Griffin Canning...started game two of the doubleheader, his third game-two doubleheader start this season...was supported with four first-inning runs on a Miguel Sanó grand slam...allowed a run in the first inning on a Jose Rojas solo homer...allowed two runs in the second inning on a Taylor Ward double and a Drew Butera single...struck out seven-plus for the fourth time on the season...threw 84 pitches, 54 for strikes.

**700 CLUB:** This season has surpassed both 700 strikeouts and 700.0 innings pitched for his career...his 700th strikeout came in the fifth inning on May 15 vs. Oakland, fanning Seth Brown...became the 15th Twin to reach 700 strikeouts (full list bottom right) and the 28th Twin to reach 700.0 innings pitched.

**VS. THE BIRDS:** Is 6-0, 3.27 ERA (44.0 IP, 16 ER) with nine walks and 43 strikeouts in seven career starts against the Orioles...his last start came on May 25 at Target Field (see LAST START note)...his current six-game winning streak against Baltimore is tied for the longest of his career vs. one opponent, also having a six-game winning streak vs. the White Sox from August 30, 2017-May 24, 2019...his only career complete-game shutout came against Baltimore at Camden Yards on April 1, 2018.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** Berríos is making his sixth road start this season...has gone 2-1, 2.60 ERA (27.2 IP, 8 ER) with two home runs, eight walks, 28 strikeouts and a .189 opponent batting average in five starts away from Target Field this season...his last road start came on May 20 at Los Angeles-AL (Game 2), earning the win after allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched in a Twins 6-3 victory...is 22-22, 4.63 ERA (360.0 IP, 185 ER) in 66 career road starts.

- ☞ Dating back to September 14, 2020, he has allowed nine earned runs on the road in 38.2 innings pitched for a 2.09 ERA in that span.
- ☞ His two road wins this season came on April 3 at Milwaukee and May 20 at Los Angeles-AL.

**MAY WAYS:** He is 13-4, 4.08 ERA (139.0 IP, 63 ER) with 40 walks, 134 strikeouts and a .241 opponent batting average in 23 career starts in May...the 13 wins are his most for any month, ahead of his nine wins in September...13 May wins since 2016 are tied with Chris Sale for fifth most in baseball in that span, trailing only Stephen Strasburg (17), Clayton Kershaw (15), Kyle Hendricks (14) and Max Scherzer (14).

**RIGHTY TIGHTY:** He has held right-handed hitters to a .167 (18-for-108) average with five doubles, two home runs, seven walks and 35 strikeouts, compared to lefties hitting .306 (30-for-98) with 10 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 10 walks and 28 strikeouts...his right-handed opponent batting average ranks third in the AL (min. 100 opp. AB), trailing only Houston's Cristian Javier (.140) and Chicago-AL's Carlos Rodón (.154).

**TOP OF THE CLASS:** Berríos has 50 wins since the start of 2017, second most in the American League in that span trailing only Justin Verlander (53)...MLB-wide in that span, 50 wins are tied for sixth in the majors with Trevor Bauer and Charlie Morton, trailing Gerrit Cole (60), Zack Greinke (58), Clayton Kershaw (56), Max Scherzer (54) and Verlander (53)...his 667 strikeouts are fourth in the AL in that span, trailing Verlander (816), Cole (793) and Sale (763).

2020 RECAP:

- ☞ Held right-handed hitters to .287 (37-for-129) at the plate, and left-handers to .180 (20-for-111)...among pitchers that faced at least 100 left-handed hitters, his .180 opponent batting average ranked third in the American League and seventh in baseball.
- ☞ Held opponents to a .174 (8-for-46) batting average with runners in scoring position...ranked third in the American League and tied fourth in the majors in that regard (min. 45 opponent AB with RISP).
- ☞ Led club in games started (12), pickoffs (2), and finished second in innings pitched (63.0), quality starts (4) and pitching WAR (1.1)...also tied for the most home wins (3) on the team.
- ☞ Started Game 2 in AL Wild Card September 30 vs. Houston at Target Field, allowing one run on two hits in 5.0 innings pitched with two walks and four strikeouts as the Twins lost 3-1.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP MICHAEL PINEDA (2021 SEASON: 3-2, 2.62 ERA // CAREER: 56-48, 3.95 ERA)**

Pineda is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season tomorrow night in the middle contest of this three-game series in Baltimore...recorded his fourth quality start of the season in his last start on May 26 against the Orioles at Target Field, holding Baltimore to three hits and just one run, on a Trey Mancini solo shot, with two walks and eight strikeouts in 6.0 innings, as the Twins won 3-2 en route to a three-game sweep of the O's...was his first start since missing 13 games on the 10-day Injured List with an abscess...tomorrow will mark Pineda's 15th career start and appearance vs. Baltimore, and will break a tie with Boston, Tampa Bay and Toronto for his most against any single opponent in his career...he's 6-3, 3.68 ERA (78.1 IP, 32 ER) with 17 walks and 95 strikeouts in his career against the Orioles, and his win total is tied with his six vs. Kansas City for his most against any single opponent...Pineda also enters tomorrow with 899 career strikeouts, needing just one to reach the 900-K plateau; he would become the 28th Dominican-born pitcher in major league history to reach 900 career strikeouts, second this season (STL's Carlos Martínez).

CAREER NOTES

- Named to 2018 and 2019 AL All-Star teams, pitching 1.0 inning in both games.
- Started Game 1 of the 2019 ALDS against New York-AL and Game 2 of the 2020 AL Wild Card Series vs. Houston.
- In 2019, teamed with Jake Odorizzi (11 K on March 30 against the Indians) to become just the second pair of pitchers in baseball history (since 1893, when the mound was placed at its current distance to home plate) to start a team's season with consecutive double-digit strikeout totals...the only others to ever do it were Hall-of-Famer Randy Johnson, along with Curt Schilling, for the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks.
- Given the 2018 Joseph W. Haynes Award for Twins Pitcher of the Year, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of BBWAA...also won the Carl R. Pohlad Community Service Award.
- Became 21st pitcher in Twins' history to reach the 200-strikeout mark in a season (202 in 2018).
- Pitched for Team Puerto Rico in the 2017 World Baseball Classic, going 1-0, 8.10 ERA (6.2 IP, 6 ER) with two walks and 10 strikeouts.
- Made MLB debut April 27, 2016 vs. Cleveland.
