THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2 (3-0 against Baltimore and 1-2 against Kansas City), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a win over the Orioles yesterday afternoon...today they will play the second of three in Baltimore...after tomorrow night's series finale, the Twins will travel to Kansas City to play the Royals four times from Thursday-Sunday...the Twins have gone 12-17 at home this season and 10-14 on the road...Twins are 4-1 in their last five road games.
 ☞ Twins have won eight of their last 11 overall and nine of their last 14.

TWINS WIN OVER O'S AGAIN: The Twins beat the Orioles yesterday afternoon at Camden Yards by a score of 3-2 in 10 innings, making the Twins 2-8 in extra frames this season... José Berríos was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on five hits and no walks in a season-high 8.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded seven hits, two from Andrelton Simmons and three from Josh Donaldson, who doubled twice...Jorge Polanco hit a solo homer in the 10th inning, his first career extra-inning home run.

TWINS AND BIRDS: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the fifth of six scheduled meetings this season...since the start of 2018, the Twins are 16-1 vs. the Orioles...their last loss came on Opening Day 2018 as Adam Jones hit a walk-off homer off Fernando Rodney in the 11th inning...since that game, their 16-game winning streak is the longest active streak vs. any opponent...it's the Twins' second-longest winning streak vs. any opponent (see note below).
 ☞ The Twins are 32-12 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span.
 ☞ Since the start of 2018, the Twins have hit 42 home runs in 17 games against Baltimore, including 19 homers in seven games at Camden Yards.

☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .347 (94-for-271) with 21 doubles, 17 home runs, 58 RBI, a .620 slugging percentage and a 1.043 OPS in 73 career games vs. the O's...Cruz spent 2014 with Baltimore, hitting .271 (166-for-613) with 32 doubles, an MLB-best 40 homers and 108 RBI in 159 games...since Cruz landed in Baltimore, he has 270 home runs, best in baseball since that season...additionally, Cruz has 22 career homers in 115 games at Camden Yards.

THE STREAK KEEPS CLIMBING: Here are the Twins' all-time win streaks vs. individual teams:

NOTE: During the streak, the Twins have out-scored the Orioles 105-41 and have hit .279 (154-for-552) with 39 doubles, 42 home runs and an OPS of .911...in this 16-win span, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 14-0, 2.02 ERA (102.2 IP, 23 ER) with Orioles batters hitting .203 (76-for-375).

HOT SAUCE: Mitch Garver has a 10-game on-base streak, tied for the second-longest run of his career, trailing only a 12-game streak (August 16-31, 2018)...he's batting .360 (9-for-25) with five doubles, two home runs, four RBI, eight runs scored, 11 walks, a .556 OBP and a 1.356 OPS in his last 10 games with a plate appearance...his .442 OBP in his last 15 games (since May 11), is sixth best in the American League in that span (min. 50 plate appearances).

AK IS OK: Since April 30, Alex Kirilloff ranks second among major league rookies (min. 40 at-bats) with a .918 OPS (Adolis García - .961) and fifth with a .298 batting average...overall this season, he's batting .484 (15-for-31) with runners on base, second best in the majors (min. 30 AB) and .421 (8-for-19) with runners in scoring position, tied for eighth best among all major league hitters (min. 15 AB).

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 18th time this season, going 6-11 in their previous 17 when a lefty starts...they faced 16 (9-7) lefties all of 2020 and 39 (22-17) in 2019...they are hitting .243 (137-for-563) with a .433 slugging percentage and a .737 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .237 (287-for-1212) with a .413 slugging and a .733 OPS against righties.
 ☞ Kyle Garlick has hit .304 (14-for-46) with six doubles, two home runs, four RBI and an .892 OPS against left-handed pitching this season.
 ☞ Nelson Cruz is hitting .321 (17-for-53) with two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, two walks and an .885 OPS vs. lefties this season.

JAX WINS THE WEEK: Yesterday right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax was named minor league Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week...the 26-year-old did not allow a hit through the first four innings on Friday night at Iowa, before giving up a fifth-inning lead-off fly-ball double down the leftfield line...it was the lone hit allowed by Jax as he tossed 6.0 shutout innings, walking two and striking out a career high 10.

ICYMI: Right-handed pitcher Shaun Anderson was reinstated from the 10-day Injured List (left quad strain) yesterday and optioned to Triple-A St. Paul...Anderson was placed on the Injured List on May 18 and appeared in two games on rehab assignment for the Saints, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings with two walks and one strikeout.

LOU GEHRIG DAY: Tomorrow, the Twins, in partnership with the ALS Association's Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota Chapter, will share the stories of two members of the extended Twins family...the Giovanelli family story and Kent Hrbek's in-game discussion with Twins broadcasters will each be shared across the club's social media platforms, on Bally Sports North, and in-ballpark at Target Field when the Twins return home to host the New York Yankees on June 8...first, the Twins will debut a documentary-style video spotlighting the Giovanelli family of St. Louis Park, Minnesota...when Lynn Giovanelli was diagnosed with ALS, her community rallied around her - especially those associated with St. Louis Park High School, where the youngest of her three sons, Stefano, is a sophomore pitcher on the baseball team; in front of a season-high crowd of more than 250 people at the school's first-ever "Strike Out ALS" night on May 19, Lynn threw out the ceremonial first pitch and shared the Orioles' "Big Dawg" player of the game award with Stefano, who struck out four batters over five innings to earn the win...tomorrow night, Twins Hall-of-Famer Kent Hrbek - the 1991 Lou Gehrig Memorial Award winner - will join the Bally Sports North live television broadcast...since losing his father to ALS at the age of 53 in 1982 (Kent's rookie season), "Hrbie" has passionately worked to raise awareness of the disease and advocate for those afflicted, along with their families; Kent and his wife, Jeanie, helped form the Minnesota chapter of the ALS Association and have raised hundreds of thousands of dollars for the cause.

LAST START: Pineda was activated from the 10-day Injured List on May 26 and started that afternoon at Target Field vs. these same Baltimore Orioles, earning the win as the Twins completed a three-game sweep with a 3-2 victory...worked 6.0 outstanding innings, allowing just three hits (all in the first inning) and one run (on a Trey Mancini solo home run), with two walks and season-high eight strikeouts.

- ☞ Allowed hits to three of his first four batters faced (including Mancini's two-out, solo homer), then retired 16 of his final 18 batters faced over 5.1 innings of no-hit, shutout ball...after Chance Sisco and Cedric Mullins walked to start the third, Pineda set down 12-straight O's to end his outing.
- ☞ Finished with a season-high 101 pitches, and was rewarded with a win after Miguel Sanó's two-out, three-run homer off Baltimore starter Jorge López in the bottom of the sixth gave the Twins a 3-1 lead.

STARTING STRONG: When healthy, "Big Mike" has been among the Twins' most effective and consistent starters thus far in 2021, while fashioning one of the best season-opening stretches of his career...his 2.62 ERA (44.2 IP, 13 ER) through his first eight starts is the third-best mark to begin a season of his career, behind the 2.09 ERA (43.0 IP, 10 ER) during his injury-marred 2014 campaign with the Yankees and the 2.45 mark (51.1 IP, 14 ER) of his 2011 rookie year with Seattle.

- ☞ Pineda has a team-high four quality starts (in 8 outings), but his 4.84 run-support average is lowest among Twins starters.

A LOOK AT THE (MODIFIED) LEADERBOARD: After missing two starts while on the Injured List following the removal of an abscess, Pineda enters tonight's start 8.1 innings shy of qualifying for the league leaders...among American League pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched, Big Mike ranks sixth in WHIP (0.99), eighth in ERA (2.62) and 12th in opponent batting average (.198, 32-for-162).

900-900 CLUB ON THE HORIZON: Pineda enters today's start 2.2 innings and one strikeout short of 900 for his career in both categories...over his first 156 major league starts, Big Mike has worked 897.1 innings and has fanned 899 batters...he would become the 49th active pitcher with at least 900.0 career innings pitched and 900 strikeouts, as well as the 27th Dominican-born pitcher in major league history to reach both of those marks.

MINNESOTA MIKE: Big Mike has made 39 starts in a Minnesota uniform, going 16-7, 3.64 ERA (217.1 IP, 88 ER)...the Twins are 25-14 when he toes the rubber...Pineda has a 4.51 strikeout-to-walk ratio since 2019, along with a 1.13 WHIP...those stats, along with his ERA, are all better than his career numbers (4.41, 1.17 and 3.95)...his 4.1 WAR (per Fangraphs) since 2019 is 16th among AL starters (min 210.0 IP).

- ☞ If he wins tonight, it would be Pineda's 17th victory with the Twins, tied for the sixth most in team history (since 1961) for pitchers in their first 40 games with Minnesota...he would match José Berrios (17-15 in 40 games/39 starts), Carlos Silva (17-10 in 40 starts), Rick Reed (17-13 in 40 starts), Mike Smithson (17-15 in 40 starts) and Mudcat Grant (17-10 in 40 games/37 starts).
- ☞ A total of 16 wins through 40 games would match eight others, including Hall-of-Famer Bert Blyleven, for 11th most in Twins annals.

BIG MIKE, BIG PERFORMANCES: Pineda's ERA as a Twin stood at 5.02 (80.2 IP, 45 ER) through his first 15 starts of the 2019 season (his first campaign back in the majors following Tommy John surgery)...beginning June 29, 2019, Big Mike is 12-3, 2.83 ERA (136.2 IP, 43 ER), 33 walks, 145 strikeouts and a .224/.273/.371 opponent slash line over his last 23 starts (Minnesota is 16-7 in those games).

BIRD TAMER: Pineda will make his second consecutive and 15th career start against Baltimore this evening...is 6-3, 3.68 ERA (78.1 IP, 32 ER) with 17 walks and 95 strikeouts in his first 14 outings.

- ☞ Will be his first start at Camden Yards since September 4, 2016, when he allowed two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings of an eventual 5-2 Yankees win...has not fared well in his career at this ballpark, going 1-2, 6.14 ERA (29.1 IP, 20 ER) in six lifetime starts.

HEADLIGHTS ON THE ROADTRIP: Tonight's start will be just Pineda's second of the 2021 season under the lights, and only his third road start of the campaign.

- ☞ Big Mike's lone previous night start this season came April 30 vs. Kansas City at Target Field...had his night cut short by soreness after being struck on the right (pitching) wrist by a comebacker, but still worked 5.0 innings of three-hit, one-run ball to earn a 9-1 victory.
- ☞ Is 1-1, 2.61 ERA (10.1 IP, 3 ER) in two 2021 road starts, defeating Milwaukee 8-2 on April 4 (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 K) before dropping a 4-2 decision May 13 at Chicago-AL (5.1 IP, 4 H, 3 R/ER, 3 BB, 7 K).

FOR IT'S ONE, TWO STRIKES YOU'RE (MOST LIKELY) OUT: When Big Mike gets to a two-strike count, he is putting hitters away with above-league average efficiency...with two strikes, opponents are 13-for-89 (.146) with a .481 OPS and a 47.5 percent strikeout rate off Pineda...for comparison, American League hitters as an aggregate in 2021 are batting .165 with a .508 OPS and a 44.3 percent strikeout rate.

- ☞ Baltimore batters went 2-for-13 with a homer (Trey Mancini solo) and eight strikeouts in such situations last Wednesday.
- ☞ Pineda has fanned at least five batters in all eight starts this season, including 15 in 11.1 innings over his last two outings...he is averaging 9.47 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, which would be the second-highest single-season mark of his career.

YOU CAN GET ON, BUT YOU'LL HAVE TO STAY THERE: Pineda has been stingy in any situation this year, allowing just 32 hits and 12 walks in 44.2 innings (a 0.99 WHIP that, in a full season, would be second best of his career)...but, he clamps down even more with runners on base, allowing just seven hits (3 doubles and 4 singles) in 47 at-bats, with four walks, for a .149/.212/.213 opponent slash line (by comparison, the AL aggregate with runners on is .249/.325/.407).

FLYING SOLO: The one bugaboo for Pineda thus far has been the home run ball, yielding nine in his 44.2 innings (all solo), after not surrendering a single longball in his 26.2 innings in 2020...extrapolated over a full season, his 1.81 HR/9.0 rate would be the second highest of his career and his 5.11 home run percentage would represent a career worst.
