THE TWINS: Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4, going 1-2 against the Yankees and 1-2 against the Astros...tonight they will begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the Mariners through Wednesday, followed by an off-day Thursday, then a visit to Texas for three against the Rangers over the weekend...the Twins have gone 14-21 at home this season and 13-18 on the road.

SUNDAY NOT SO FUNDAY: The Twins lost to the Astros yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 14-3, allowing 13 runs in the final six innings...Michael Pineda (3-4) was the starter and loser, allowing three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched and exited after 64 pitches, experiencing right forearm tightness...the pitching staff allowed 20 hits, marking their most since September 17, 2019 vs. Chicago-AL (also 20)...the offense recorded seven hits, two from both Trevor Larnach and Nelson Cruz...Cruz hit his 13th home run of the season and 430th of his career...Ryan Jeffers added his third home run, all coming in his last nine games.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have returned infielder/outfielder Luis Arraez and right-handed pitcher Kenta Maeda from their rehab assignments and reinstated them from the 10-day Injured List...Arraez, who missed the last 19 games with a right shoulder strain, played in two games on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul, hitting .250 (2-for-8) with one walk and two RBI...prior to landing on the Injured List, Arraez played in 39 games for the Twins this season, hitting .277 (39-for-141) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, 14 RBI, 20 runs scored, 17 walks and a .691 OPS...Maeda, who missed the last 20 games with a right adductor strain, started one game on rehab assignment for the Saints last Wednesday, allowing one run on a solo homer in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...prior to landing on the Injured List, Maeda made nine starts for the Twins this season, going 2-2 with a 5.27 ERA (42.2 IP, 25 ER), 11 walks and 39 strikeouts...to make room for Arraez and Maeda on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Michael Pineda (right elbow inflammation) and outfielder Rob Refsnyder (left hamstring strain) on the 10-day Injured List.

TWINS AND M's: The Twins and Mariners are playing the fourth of six scheduled meetings in 2021...their last meeting came April 8-11 when the Twins opened up Target Field for the 2021 season and went 1-2, winning the opener and losing the next two...Twins are 6-4 vs. the M's since May 16, 2019, outscoring them 81-51 (+30) in that span and outhitting them 116-92...they have 23 doubles, 23 home runs and have averaged 8.1 runs-per-game in those 10.

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .311 (23-for-74) in 18 career games vs. the Mariners, hitting safely in 11 of his last 12 against them...he is 8-for-18 (.444) in four career games at T-Mobile Park, including a four-hit game his last time here on May 19, 2019.

☞ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .359 (23-for-64) with eight doubles, five walks and a .406 on-base percentage in his last 17 games vs. Seattle.

☞ Nelson Cruz played four seasons for the Mariners from 2015-18, hitting 163 home runs while there...he ranks sixth in their all-time list in home runs...he hit at least 37 home runs in all four seasons and was an AL All-Star three times while there (2015, '17 & '18)...his 83 career homers at T-Mobile Park are tied with Raúl Ibáñez for second most, trailing Kyle Seager (85).

☞ Miguel Sanó has four doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI and a 1.015 OPS in 13 career games at T-Mobile Park.

NELLYVILLE: Nelson Cruz hit his 13th home run of the season yesterday and the third in his last four games...the homer was the 430th of his career, moving one away from tying Cal Ripken Jr. for 49th on MLB's all-time list...below are his ranks on MLB's all-time list (left) and all-time among active Dominican-born players:

OVER THE RIVER UPDATE: Max Kepler played his first game on rehab assignment last night for Triple-A St. Paul, going 0-for-4 as the Saints' designated hitter...Kepler has missed the last 14 games with a left hamstring strain...Byron Buxton played in his third rehab game for the Saints on Saturday, going 1-for-4 while playing all nine innings in centerfield...Buck has gone 5-for-9 with a double, a triple, two home runs, seven RBI and two walks in his three games with the Saints...Buxton was placed on the 10-day Injured List on May 7 with a right hip strain and has missed the Twins' last 35 games.

THE BALLOT BOX: Major League Baseball released its first balloting update for the 2021 All-Star Game...Byron Buxton ranks third among American League outfielders with 383,178 votes, trailing Mike Trout (706,503) and Aaron Judge (538,448)...Nelson Cruz ranks seventh among AL designated hitters with 73,098 votes, Mitch Garver ranks ninth among catchers with 42,996 votes and Josh Donaldson ranks 10th among third basemen with 57,488 votes...the next balloting update will be on Monday, June 21.

DID I CATCH A NINER IN THERE?: Miguel Sanó has hit safely in a season-long nine-straight games, tied with Xander Bogaerts for second-longest active streak in the AL, trailing Isiah Kiner-Falefa (11)...during the streak, Sanó is hitting .297 (11-for-37) with two doubles, four home runs, nine RBI and a .973 OPS...his career-long hitting streak is 11 games, from June 28-July 14, 2019.

THIS LAND IS VARLAND: Minor League Baseball announced today the minor league Players and Pitchers of the Week for each respective league/division for the week of June 7-13...Single-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Louie Varland has been named Low-A Southeast Pitcher of the Week...Varland made one start for the Mighty Mussels last Wednesday at Jupiter, pitching 6.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed, two walks and 11 strikeouts...the St. Paul native was drafted by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of Concordia University in St. Paul...he has gone 3-1, 2.42 ERA (26.0 IP, 7 ER) with 12 walks and 45 strikeouts in six starts this season.

MAUER AND FRIENDS: Joe and Maddie Mauer are hosting the Mauer and Friends Kids Classic tomorrow, benefiting Gillette Children's Specialty Healthcare...athletes will compete in a slow pitch softball style home run derby at Target Field...participants for the event include Joe's former teammates: Brian Dozier, Brian Duensing, Garrett Jones, Jason Kubel, Joe Nathan, Glen Perkins, Trevor Plouffe, Jim Thome, Darin Mastroianni, Justin Morneau and Nick Punto...joining them will be former Viking Chad Greenway, current Wild player Zach Parise and former Wild player Mark Parrish...honorary managers for the event will be longtime skipper Ron Gardenhire and former Twins coach Joe Vavra.

THIS AND THAT:

- ☞ The Twins have hit 95 homers on the season, second-most in baseball, trailing Toronto (99).
- ☞ Twins are hitting .255 with .761 OPS vs. left-handed pitching, compared to .238 with .740 OPS vs. right-handed pitching...their batting average vs. lefties is the eighth best in baseball while their OPS ranks sixth.
- ☞ Josh Donaldson is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with three doubles, five home runs, six RBI, seven walks and a 1.150 OPS in his last 12 games.

REHAB REVIEW: Maeda was returned from rehab and reinstated from the 10-day Injured List today to make the start tonight...missed 20 games with a right adductor strain, his fourth career trip to the IL and first with the Twins...made one rehab start for Triple-A St. Paul on June 9 vs. Omaha, permitting just one run on a solo homer, while striking out five batters and walking one in 4.0 innings of work...threw 54 pitches, 33 for strikes in the appearance...the Storm Chasers scored three runs in the ninth to win 5-2.

LAST TIME OUT: Maeda was not part of the decision on May 22 at Cleveland, his last start prior to his Injured List stint...allowed three runs on three hits (1 HR), with one walk and six strikeouts in 5.0 innings...was removed from the game with the right adductor injury and was placed on the 10-day Injured List the following day...the Twins tied the game in the sixth inning but ultimately fell to the Indians 5-3 in 10 innings.

START PRIOR: Maeda settled for a no-decision on May 16 vs. Oakland...allowed five runs (3 earned) on eight hits, with one walk and two strikeouts in just 4.0 innings...yielded four consecutive hits to start the fifth inning (double, RBI single, single, single) before departing with the bases loaded; three additional runs scored off Tyler Duffey, on a groundout and an interference error called on catcher Ben Rortvedt...has completed fewer than five innings in four of his eight starts this season...his eight hits allowed matched his season high, also done on April 21 at Oakland; last allowed at least eight hits in multiple starts in a single season in 2018 (also twice).

GO WEST: Maeda has never faced the Mariners before in his career...tonight marks his fourth start of the season against an American League West team and is 1-0, 7.30 ERA (12.1 IP, 10 ER) in those three prior starts...took a no-decision on April 21 at Oakland, earned the win May 3 vs. Texas and took another no-decision on May 16 vs. Oakland...is 3-4-1, 5.66 ERA (49.1 IP, 31 ER) in 12 career appearances (10 starts) vs. the AL West, his highest ERA against a single division in his career...has also made at least 10 career starts against all six divisions.

ON THE ROAD: Maeda is making his seventh road start of the season, going 1-1, 6.21 ERA (29.0 IP, 20 ER) in his six prior outings...this compares to his 3.29 ERA (13.2 IP, 5 ER) in three starts at Target Field this season...all nine of the home runs and 15 of the 19 extra-base hits he's allowed so far this season have come on the road.

2021 ARSENAL: Maeda's slider has surpassed his four-seam fastball as his most-used pitch over the last several seasons...he threw them equally in his rookie 2016 campaign and his four-seamer was his most frequent offering from 2017-19...however, his slider has been his top pitch since the start of 2020, followed by his split finger...here's a breakdown of his 2021 offerings and the results:

OPPOSING COUNTS: Opponents are hitting .476 (10-for-24) off Maeda's first offering of an at-bat...his opponent batting average on the first pitch is the eighth highest among all major league pitchers (min. 20 opp. at-bats).

- Opponents are batting .227 (20-for-88) off Maeda with two strikes, far above the .087 (13-for-150) mark he held them to in 2020 and his career mark of .147 (223-for-1515)...the league average mark this season with two strikes is .161.
- When the count goes full, Maeda is holding opposing hitters to just 1-for-20 (.050), the fourth-lowest mark among all major league pitchers (min. 20 opp. at-bats)...however, of the five pitchers ranked above him in batting average in those circumstances, only one has issued fewer full-count walks than Maeda's seven (NYM's Marcus Stroman has a .045 BAA and 5 walks issued in full counts).

FANTASTIC FIRSTS AND TERRIBLE TWOS: Opponents are just 6-for-31 (.194) against Maeda in the first inning...that increases to 21-for-45 (.467) in the second inning and down to 8-for-36 (.222) in the third inning before dropping back to 5-for-28 (.179) in the fourth inning...has run into trouble in the fifth and sixth innings, where opposing hitters are a combined 12-for-34 (.353) against him...18 of his 30 runs allowed this season have occurred in the second and third innings combined.

- Eight of the 19 extra-base hits Maeda has allowed this season have occurred in innings three to five (5 doubles, 3 home runs).

SETTLING IN: Maeda finished April with a 6.56 ERA, his second-highest single-month ERA in his career behind his 6.58 mark in April 2017...he tends to heat up with the weather, owning a 3.68 career ERA in May and 2.83 mark in June...his 2.83 ERA in June is his lowest in a single calendar month in his career; is 6-6 with 36 walks, 110 strikeouts and a .204 opponent batting average (78-for-383) in 20 career games (18 starts) in summer's first month...here are his numbers by month in his career (full months only, excluding March and October).

TOMORROW'S STARTER - LHP J.A. HAPP (2021 SEASON: 3-2, 5.75 ERA // CAREER: 126-94, 4.04 ERA)

Veteran southpaw Happ is due to make the start tomorrow night in Seattle, in the middle game of this three-game set...took a no-decision in his last outing on June 10 vs. New York-AL, allowing four runs on eight hits (2 HR), with one walk and two strikeouts in 5.0 innings...the Twins won the game, 7-5, on Nelson Cruz's two-run walk-off homer in the bottom of the ninth...Happ last faced the Mariners in 2019 and is 6-2, 4.56 ERA (47.1 IP, 24 ER) with 19 walks and 47 strikeouts in nine career starts against Seattle...he's been the victor in each of his last two starts vs. the Mariners, on May 9 and August 26, 2019, posting a 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP, 3 ER) and .094 opponent batting average (3-for-32) across those outings.

CAREER NOTES

- Finished second in the 2020 American League Cy Young Award voting, accruing 92 total votes (Cleveland's Shane Bieber was the unanimous winner).
- Named Joseph W. Haynes Award winner for Twins Pitcher of the Year in 2020, voted on by the Twin Cities Chapter of the BBWAA...also named the starting pitcher on 2020 All-MLB Second Team.
- Pitched 8.0 no-hit innings on August 18, 2020 vs. MIL before bid was broken up in the ninth...longest no-hit bid of career, and set Twins record with eight-straight K's.
- Is the third Japanese-born player in Twins franchise history, after Micheal Nakamura (2003) and Tsuyoshi Nishioka (2011-12).
- Owens the fifth-most strikeouts in MLB history among Japanese-born pitchers.
- His 16 wins in 2016 were the second-most wins ever by a Los Angeles-NL rookie, behind only Rick Sutcliffe (17-10, 1979), and tied for the second-most ever in a single season by a Japanese pitcher.
- In 2016, led qualifying MLB rookie starting pitchers in starts (32), wins (16), opponents' batting average (.229), WHIP (1.14), innings pitched (175.2) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.58).
