THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 2-4 (1-2 against the Yankees and 1-2 against the Astros), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with consecutive losses to the Mariners over the last two nights...tonight they will play the three-game series finale in Seattle, then travel to Texas to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, before playing the Rangers in Texas for three over the weekend...the Twins have gone 14-21 at home this season and 12-20 on the road.

THE WRONG END OF A 10-SPOT: The Twins lost to the Mariners last night by a score of 10-0, dropping game two of the three-game series at T-Mobile Park...J.A. Happ (3-3) was the starter and loser, allowing six runs (5 earned) on nine hits in 4.0 innings pitched...Griffin Jax pitched 4.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded just four hits, two from Alex Kirilloff...the loss marked the Twins' third shutout this season and first by double-digits since an 11-0 defeat by the Astros on April 30, 2019 at Target Field.

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have reinstated left-handed pitcher Caleb Thielbar from the 10-day Injured List...Thielbar, who missed the last 12 games with a left groin strain, has appeared in 20 games this season, posting a 4.29 ERA (21.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven walks, 31 strikeouts and a 13.29 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio...to make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Griffin Jax to Triple-A St. Paul...the 26-year-old appeared in three games for the Twins, posting an 8.64 ERA (8.1 IP, 8 ER) with three walks and ning strikeouts. and nine strikeouts

Additionally, right-handed pitcher Shaun Anderson has been reinstated from the 10-day Injured List (right hand finger blisters) and optioned to Triple-A St. Paul...Anderson has appeared in four games for the Twins this season, posting a 9.35 ERA (8.2 IP, 9 ER) with five walks and eight strikeouts.

TWINS AND M's: The Twins and Mariners are playing the last of six scheduled meetings in 2021...with last night's loss, the Twins have lost the season-series with the M's, their first since going 1-5 in 2018.

□ Jorge Polanco is hitting .305 (25-for-82) in 20 career games vs. the Mariners, hitting safely in 12 of his last 14 against them...he is 10-for-26 (.385) in six career games at T-Mobile Park.

□ Andrelton Simmons is hitting .333 (24-for-72) with eight doubles, five walks and a .377 on-base percentage in his last 19 games vs. Seattle.

□ Nelson Cruz played four seasons for the Mariners from 2015-18, hitting 163 home runs while there...he ranks sixth on their all-time list in home runs, trailing Ken Griffey Jr. (417), Edgar Martinez (309), Jay Buhner (307), Kyle Seager (220) and Alex Rodriguez (189)...he hit at least 37 home runs in all four seasons and was an AL All-Star three times as a Mariner at least 37 home runs in all four seasons and was an AL All-Star three times as a Mariner (2015, '17 & '18)...his 83 career homers at T-Mobile Park are tied with Raúl Ibañez for second most, trailing Kyle Seager (85).

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are facing a left-handed starter for the 24th time this season, going 7-16 in their previous 23 games when a lefty starts...they are hitting .258 (192-for-743) with a .458 slugging percentage and a .772 OPS vs. lefties this season, compared to .235 (354-for-1508) with a .414 slugging and a .727 OPS against righties.

▼ Twins rank second in baseball in slugging percentage vs. lefties, trailing only Chicago-AL (.460)...additionally, their OPS vs. lefties ranks fifth in baseball, trailing Chicago-AL (.810), Houston (.806), Baltimore (.790) and Colorado (.776).

▼ Nelson Cruz is hitting .411 (46-for-112) with six doubles, 10 home runs, 20 RBI and a 1.208 OPS against lefties since the start of 2020...in his last six games vs. lefties, he is hitting .615 (8-for-13) with two doubles, one home run and two walks.

▼ Trevor Larnach is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with one double, two homers, three RBI and a .393 on-base percentage vs. lefties this season.

WINDOWS DOWN AND CRUZ: Nelson Cruz has an 11-game on-base streak, dating back to June 1...he's hitting .417 (15-for-36) with three doubles, three homers, six RBI, eight walks, a .511 on-base percentage and a 1.261 OPS during the streak...his .511 on-base percentage is third in the American League in June (minimum 30 plate appearances), trailing only Baltimore's Cedric Mullins (.531) and Toronto's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.527).

AK, NOT JUST OK: Alex Kirilloff has a hit in each of his last five road games, batting .300 (6-for-20) with one homer, two RBI, one walk and two runs scored in that span...he's also batting .314 (16-for-51) with one double, one triple, one homer, four RBI and three runs scored in his last 15 games since May 30.

SUMMER IS ROOKIE SZN: This month, Nick Gordon is hitting .323 (10-for-31), Trevor Larnach is hitting .311 (14-for-45) and Alex Kirilloff is hitting .310 (13-for-42)...the trio enters today third (Gordon), tied for fourth (Larnach) and sixth (Kirilloff) among all major league rookies in batting average this month (minimum 30 at-bats).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2019, the Twins homered twice in an 8-6 loss to the Royals at Target Field, their 20th consecutive home game with a home run, extending the franchise record...the streak was snapped on June 17.

AIR JORDAN: Jordan Balazovic made his third start for Double-A Wichita last night, tossing a season-long 4.1 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits with one walk and eight strikeouts, en route to a 13-4 Wind Surge victory over Springfield...eight strikeouts marked his most in a start since fanning nine on August 28, 2019 in his final start of the season for then-High-A Fort Myers...in three starts for Wichita this season, the right-hander is 0-0, 3.72 ERA (9.2 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and 16 strikeouts...Balazovic is currently ranked as the fourth-best prospect in the Twins system and the 78th-best in baseball by MLB.com.

LAST START: Ober settled for a no-decision despite setting several career highs in his last start on June 11 vs. Houston...fanned a career-high seven batters over a career-high 5.0 innings, while allowing two runs on a career-high seven hits (1 HR), with one walk...allowed one run on a sacrifice fly in the third and another on a solo homer in the fifth...his 15 career strikeouts through his first three career games are most by a Twins pitcher since José Berríos had 19 strikeouts in his first three in 2016.

START PRIOR: Did not factor into the decision in the Twins 2-1 victory June 6 at Kansas City, opposite Brady Singer...made second career start and helped the Twins even the four-game series at Kauffman Stadium...his one run allowed came on an Andrew Benintendi RBI single that scored Whit Merrifield after his leadoff triple in the fourth inning...retired each of the first six batters he faced in the game... was supported with a 3-6-4 triple play in the third inning, started on a Nicky Lopez bunt attempt... exited with a 1-1 tie as five relievers combined to throw 5.0 scoreless innings.

DEBUT DEBRIEF: Made major league debut on May 18 vs. Chicago-AL at Target Field...allowed four runs on five hits (2 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in a 4.0-inning no-decision; the Twins won, 5-4, on Jorge Polanco's walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth...Ober recorded his first career strikeout in the opening frame, fanning Adam Eaton for the second out of the inning...he worked scoreless second and fourth frames but ran into trouble in the first and third innings, yielding a solo homer to Jake Lamb in the first and three additional runs in the third on a Yoán Moncada double and a Yasmani Grandal two-run homer...four of the five hits he permitted went for extra bases (2 doubles 2 home runs). doubles 2 home runs)

LOW RISP, HIGH REWARD: Through his first three career major league starts, Ober is holding opponents to a .133 batting average (2-for-15) with runners in scoring position as well as a .143 (1-for-7) mark with RISP and two outs...this trend was also true in his four starts for Triple-A St. Paul, as he held opposing hitters to just a .182 (4-for-22) batting average with runners in scoring positions on the word for the Science. position on the year for the Saints.

SAINTLY SUMMARY: Ober has made four starts for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 1-0, 2.81 ERA (16.0 IP, 5 ER), five walks, 21 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average (13-for-60)...two of the starts occurred prior to his call-up on May 18 and two after...made his season debut in the Saints' fifth game of the campaign on May 8 at Omaha, taking a no-decision after working 3.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits, with two walks and three strikeouts; the run crossed home on a fielder's choice in his final frame of work...took the ball again on May 13 vs. lowa, scattering two hits and one walk over 4.0 shutout innings, with a then-season-high five strikeouts in another no-decision... earned his lone victory of the season on May 25 at lowa, working 5.0 innings of one-run ball and allowing just four hits while walking none and fanning five as the Saints exploded for 17 runs en route to a 17-5 rout of the 1-Cubs...his other start came in the finale of that same six-game series in Des Moines, as he struck out a season-high eight batters in 4.0 strong innings as St. Paul won 7-3 and completed a six-game sweep. and completed a six-game sweep.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Ober is one of six players to make his major league debut for the Twins this season and one of two pitchers...the others are: C Ben Rortvedt (April 30), IF Nick Gordon (May 6), OF Trevor Larnach (May 8), OF Gilberto Celestino (June 2) and RHP Griffin Jax (June 8).

WALKING TALL: Standing six feet, nine inches tall, Ober is one of just five players 6-8-or-taller to suit up for the Twins/Senators, as well as just the third pitcher of that height to debut for Minnesota or Washington...additionally, Ober's 15 career strikeouts are 12th most among all pitchers 6-9-or-taller in major league history...the other pitchers 6-8-or-taller to play for the Twins are:

CAREER REDUX: Selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the College of Charleston, the 25-year-old has gone 18-3, 2.41 ERA (197.2 IP, 53 ER) with 26 walks, 244 strikeouts and a .222 opponent batting average (163-for-734) over 38 career minor league appearances (35 starts)...was added to the Twins' 40-man roster on November 20, 2020 and is currently ranked as the 23rd-best prospect in Twins system by MLB.com.

Among all minor leaguers between 2017-21 (min. 180.0 IP), Ober ranks second with a 9.38 strikeout-to-walk ratio, second only to reigning American League Cy Young Award winner Shane Bieber (who posted a 14.06 mark over the 2017-18 seasons).

Over that same time span, Ober ranks fourth by allowing just 8.79 base runners-per-9.0 innings, fourth by walking just 1.18 batters-per-9.0-innings and fifth in WHIP (0.96).

NO RUNS: Ober posted a miniscule 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) in 2019, his most recent full professional season...his mark led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) and he also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961...also marked the second-lowest single-season ERA by any minor league pitcher since 1992 (min. 75.0 IP), trailing only Erasmo Ramírez's 0.51 ERA (88.0 IP, 5 ER) in 2009 for the VSL Mariners.
